O LORD: what wilt thou give? give them a miscarrying womb and [dry] breasts. dry Though he be fruitful among [his] brethren, an east wind shall come, the wind of the LORD shall come up from the wildeness, and his spring shall become [dry], and his fountain shall be dried up: he shall spoil the treasure of all pleasant vessels. dry And he said unto them, I [am] an Hebrew; and I fear the LORD, the God of heaven, which hath made the sea and the {dry} [land]. dry And the LORD spake unto the fish, and it vomited out Jonah upon the {dry} [land]. dry He rebuketh the sea, and maketh it {dry}, and drieth up all the rivers: Bashan languisheth, and Carrnel, and the flower of Lebanon languisheth. dry For while [they be] folden together [as] thorns, and while they are drunken [as] drunkards, they shall be devoured as stubble fully {dry}. dry And he will stretch out his hand against the north, and destroy Assyria; and will make Nineveh a desolation, [and] {dry} like a wilderness. dry For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it [is] a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the {dry} [land]; dry And he shall pass through the sea with affliction, and shall smite the waves in the sea, and all the deeps of the river shall {dry} up: and the pride of Assyria shall be brought down, and the sceptre of Egypt shall depart away. dry When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through {dry} places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out. dry For if they do these things in a green tree, what shall be done in the {dry}? dry By faith they passed through the Red sea as by {dry} land]: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.
