entreat And he communed with them, saying, If it be your mind that I should bury my dead out of my sight; hear me, and {entreat} for me to Ephron the son of Zohar, entreat Then Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron, and said, {Entreat} the LORD, that he may take away the frogs from me, and from my people; and I will let the people go, that they may do sacrifice unto the LORD, entreat And Moses said unto Pharaoh, Glory over me: when shall I {entreat} for thee, and for thy servants, and for thy people, to destroy the frogs from thee and thy houses, [that] they may remain in the river only? entreat And Pharaoh said, I will let you go, that ye may sacrifice to the LORD your God in the wilderness; only ye shall not go very far away: {entreat} for me. entreat And Moses said, Behold, I go out from thee, and I will {entreat} the LORD that the swarms [of flies] may depart from Pharaoh, from his servants, and from his people, to morrow: but let not Pharaoh deal deceitfully any more in not lettin g the people go to sacrifice to the LORD. entreat {Entreat} the LORD (for [it is] enough) that there be no [more] mighty thunderings and hail; and I will let you go, and ye shall stay no longer. entreat Now therefore forgive, I pray thee, my sin only this once, and {entreat} the LORD your God, that he may take away from me this death only. entreat And Ruth said, {Entreat} me not to leave thee, [or] to return from following after thee: for whither thou goest, I will go; and where thou lodgest, I will lodge: thy people [shall be] my people, and thy God my God: entreat <1SA2 -25> If one man sin against another, the judge shall judge him: but if a man sin against the LORD, who shall {entreat} for him? Notwithstanding they hearkened not unto the voice of their father, because the LORD would slay them. entreat <1KI13 -6> And the king answered and said unto the man of God, {Entreat} now the face of the LORD thy God, and pray for me, that my hand may be restored me again. And the man of God besought the LORD, and the king's hand was restored him again, and became as [it was] before entreat And the daughter of Tyre [shall be there] with a gift; [even] the rich among the people shall {entreat} thy favour. entreat Many will {entreat} the favour of the prince: and every man [is] a friend to him that giveth gifts. entreat The LORD said, Verily it shall be well with thy remnant; verily I will cause the enemy to {entreat} thee [well] in the time of evil and in the time of affliction. entreat And God spake on this wise, That his seed should sojourn in a strange land; and that they should bring them into bondage, and {entreat} them] evil four hundred years. entreat <1CO4 -13> Being defamed, we {entreat}: we are made as the filth of the world, and are] the offscouring of all things unto this day, entreat And I {entreat} thee also, true yokefellow, help those women which laboured with me in the gospel, with Clement also, and with] other my fellowlabourers, whose names are] in the book of life. entreat <1TI5 -1> Rebuke not an elder, but {entreat} him] as a father; and] the younger men as brethren;
