The king answered and said, The thing [is] true, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not. p etition Then answered they and said before the king, That Daniel, which [is] of the children of the captivity of Judah, regardeth not thee, O king, nor the decree that thou hast signed, but maketh his {petition} three times a day.
