possible But Jesus beheld [them], and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are {possible}. possible For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; insomuch that, if [it were] {possible}, they shall deceive the very elect. possible And he went a little farther, and fell on his face, and prayed, saying, O my Father, if it be {possible}, let this cup pass from me: nevertheless not as I will, but as thou [wilt]. possible Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are] {possible} to him that believeth. possible And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men it is] impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are {possible}. possible For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall show signs and wonders, to seduce, if it were] {possible}, even the elect. possible And he went forward a little, and fell on the ground, and prayed that, if it were {possible}, the hour might pass from him. possible And he said, Abba, Father, all things are] {possible} unto thee; take away this cup from me: nevertheless not what I will, but what thou wilt. possible And he said, The things which are impossible with men are {possible} with God. possible Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not {possible} that he should be holden of it. possible For Paul had determined to sail by Ephesus, because he would not spend the time in Asia: for he hasted, if it were {possible} for him, to be at Jerusalem the day of Pentecost. possible And when it was day, they knew not the land: but they discovered a certain creek with a shore, into the which they were minded, if it were {possible}, to thrust in the ship. possible If it be {possible}, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men. possible Where is then the blessedness ye spake of? for I bear you record, that, if it had been] {possible}, ye would have plucked out your own eyes, and have given them to me. possible For it is not {possible} that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins.
