And he said, Ye have transgressed: {roll} a great stone unto me this day. roll And there was found at Achmetha, in the palace that [is] in the province of the Medes, a {roll}, and therein [was] a record thus written: roll Moreover the LORD said unto me, Take thee a great {roll}, and write in it with a man's pen concerning Mahershalalhashbaz. roll Take thee a {roll} of a book, and write therein all the words that I have spoken unto thee against Israel, and against Judah, and against all the nations, from the day I spake unto thee, from the days of Josiah, even unto this day. roll Then Jeremiah called Baruch the son of Neriah: and Baruch wrote from the mouth of Jeremiah all the words of the LORD, which he had spoken unto him, upon a {roll} of a book. roll Therefore go thou, and read in the {roll}, which thou hast written from my mouth, the words of the LORD in the ears of the people in the LORD'S house upon the fasting day: and also thou shalt read them in the ears of all Judah that come ou t of their cities. roll Therefore all the princes sent Jehudi the son of Nethaniah, the son of Shelemiah, the son of Cushi, unto Baruch, saying, Take in thine hand the {roll} wherein thou hast read in the ears of the people, and come.
