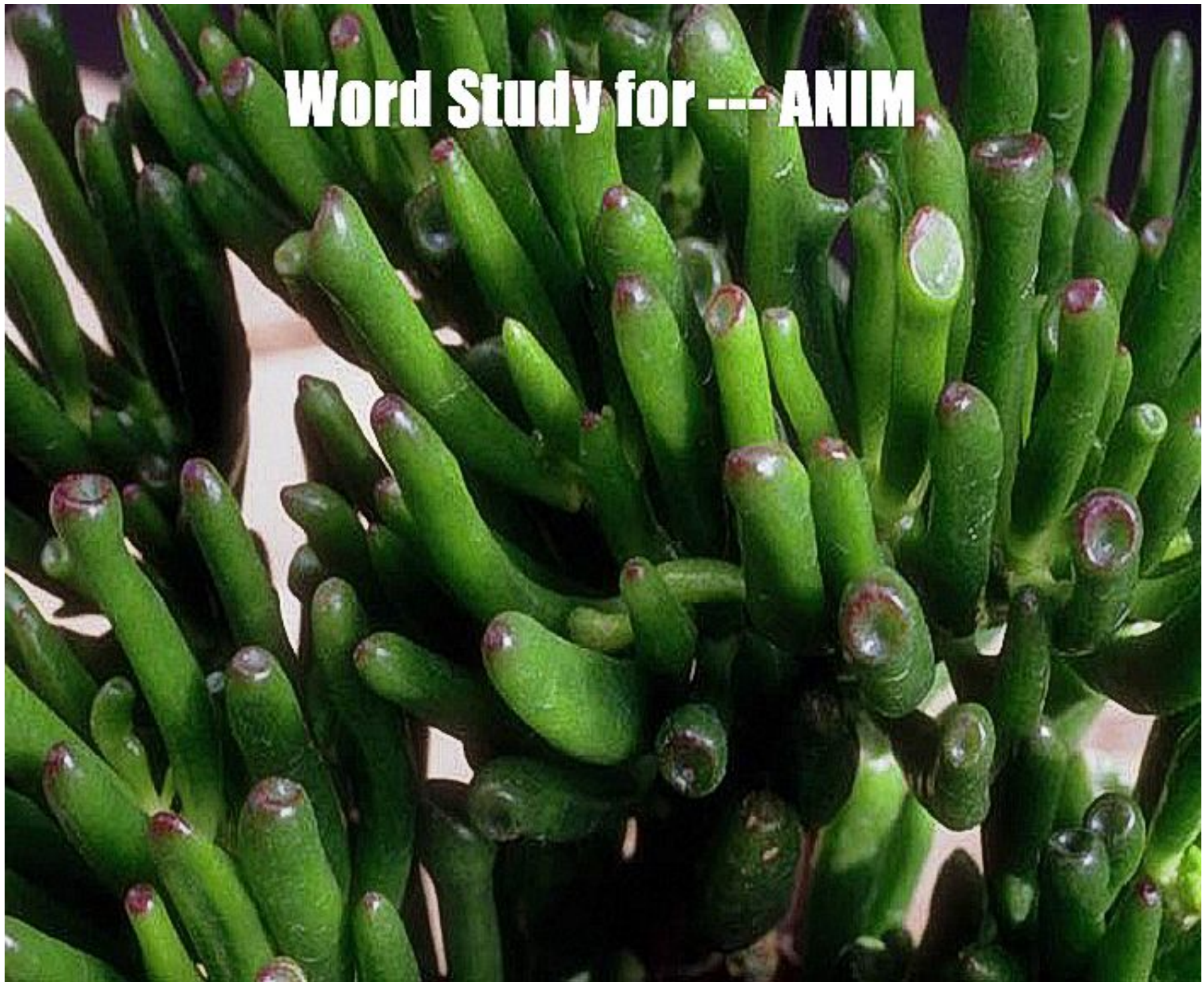

animal 08476 ## tachash {takh'- ash} ; probably of foreign derivation ; a (clean) {animal} with fur , probably a species of antelope : -- badger .

animal 08565 ## tan {tan} ; from an unused root probably meaning to elongate ; a monster (as preternaturally formed) , i . e . a sea-serpent (or other huge marine {animal}) ; also a jackal (or other hideous land animal) : -- dragon , whale . Compare 08577 .

animal 1016 - bous {booce} ; probably from the base of 1006 ; an ox (as grazing) , i.e. an {animal} of that species (" beef ") : -- ox.

animal 1913 - epibibazo {ep-ee-bee-bad'-zo} ; from 1909 and a redupl. deriv. of the base of 0939 [compare 0307] ; to cause to mount (an {animal}) : -- set on.

animal 2062 - herpeton {her-pet-on'} ; neuter of a derivative of herpo (to creep) ; a reptile , i.e. (by Hebraism [compare 7431]) a small {animal} : -- creeping thing , serpent.

animal 2226 - zoon {dzo'-on} ; neuter of a derivative of 2198 ; a live thing , i.e. an {animal} : -- beast.

animal 2339 - therā {thay'-rah} ; from ther (a wild {animal} , as game) ; hunting , i.e. (figuratively) destruction : -- trap.

animal 2340 - thereuo {thay-ryoo'-o} ; from 2339 ; to hunt (an {animal}) , i.e. (figuratively) to carp at : -- catch.

animal 2342 - therion {thay-ree'-on} ; diminutive from the same as 2339 ; a dangerous {animal} : -- (venomous , wild) beast.

animal 2934 - ktenos {ktay'-nos} ; from 2932 ; property , i.e. (specially) a domestic {animal} : -- beast.

animal 4071 - peteinon {pet-i-non'} ; neuter of a derivative of 4072 ; a flying {animal} , i.e. bird : -- bird , fowl.

animal 4156 - pniktos {pnik-tos'} ; from 4155 ; throttled , i.e. (neuter concretely) an {animal} choked to death (not bled) : -- strangled.

animal 4559 - sarkikos {sar-kee-kos'} ; from 4561 ; pertaining to flesh , i.e. (by extension) bodily , temporal , or (by implication) {animal} , unregenerate : -- carnal , fleshly.

animal 4561 - sarx {sarx} ; probably from the base of 4563 ; flesh (as stripped of the skin) , i.e. (strictly) the meat of an {animal} (as food) , or (by extension) the body (as opposed to the soul [or spirit] , or as the symbol

of what is external, or as the means of kindred), or (by implication) human nature (with its frailties [physically or morally] and passions), or (specifically) a human being (as such): -- carnal(-ly, + -ly minded), flesh([-ly]).

animals 02138 ## zakuwr {zaw-koor'} ; properly , passive participle of 02142 , but used for 02145 ; a male (of man or {animals}) : -- males , men-children .

animals 02145 ## zakar {zaw-kawr'} ; from 02142 ; properly , remembered , i . e . a male (of man or {animals} , as being the most noteworthy sex) : -- X him , male , man (child ,-- kind) .

animals 02220 ## z@rowa` {zer-o'- ah} ; or (shortened) z@roa` {zer-o'- ah} ; and (feminine) z@row` ah {zer-o-aw'} ; or z@ro` ah {zer-o-aw'} ; from 02232 ; the arm (as stretched out) , or (of {animals}) the foreleg ; figuratively , force : -- arm , + help , mighty , power , shoulder , strength .

animals 02873 ## tabach {taw-bakh'} ; a primitive root ; to slaughter ({animals} or men) : -- kill , (make) slaughter , slay .

animals 04685 ## matsowd {maw-tsode'} ; or (feminine) m@tsovdah {mets-o-daw'} ; or m@tsodah {mets-o-daw'} ; from 06679 ; a net (for capturing {animals} or fishes) :-also (by interchange for 04679) a fastness or (beseiging) tower : -- bulwark , hold , munition , net , snare .

animals 04829 ## mir`eh {meer-eh'} ; from 07462 in the sense of feeding ; pasture (the place or the act) ; also the haunt of wild {animals} : -- feeding place , pasture .

animals 04908 ## mishkan {mish-kawn'} ; from 07931 ; a residence (including a shepherd's hut , the lair of {animals} , figuratively , the grave ; also the Temple) ; specifically , the Tabernacle (properly , its wooden walls) : -- dwelleth , dwelling (place) , habitation , tabernacle , tent .

animals 05739 ## `eder {ay'- der} ; from 05737 ; an arrangement , i . e . muster (of {animals}) : -- drove , flock , herd .

animals 06354 ## pachath {pakh'- ath} ; probably from an unused root apparently meaning to dig ; a pit , especially for catching {animals} : -- hole , pit , snare .

animals 07409 ## rekesh {reh'- kesh} ; from 07408 ; a relay of {animals} on a post-route (as stored up for that purpose) ; by implication , a courser : -- dromedary , mule , swift beast .

animals 07568 ## resheth {reh'- sheth} ; from 03423 ; a net (as catching {animals}) : -- net [-work] .
