co-laborer 4904 - sunergos {soon-er-gos'} ; from a presumed compound of 4862 and the base of 2041 ; a {co-laborer} , i.e. coadjutor : -- companion in labour , (fellow-)helper(-labourer , -worker) , labourer together with , workfellow .

laborer 06001 ## `amel {aw-male'} ; from 05998 ; toiling ; concretely , a {laborer} ; figuratively , sorrowful : -- that laboureth , that is a misery , had taken [labour] , wicked , workman .

{ak-bore'} 05907 ## `Akbowr {{ak-bore'}} ; probably for 05909 ; Akbor , the name of an Idumaeon and of two Israelites : -- Achbor .

{az-noth'taw-bore'} 00243 ## 'Aznowth Tabowr {{az-noth'taw-bore'}} ; from 00238 and 08396 ; flats (i . e . tops) of Tabor (i . e . situated on it) ; Aznoth-Tabor , a place in Palestine : -- Aznoth-tabor .

{bore} 00877 ## bo'r {{bore}} ; from 00874 ; a cistern : -- cistern .
