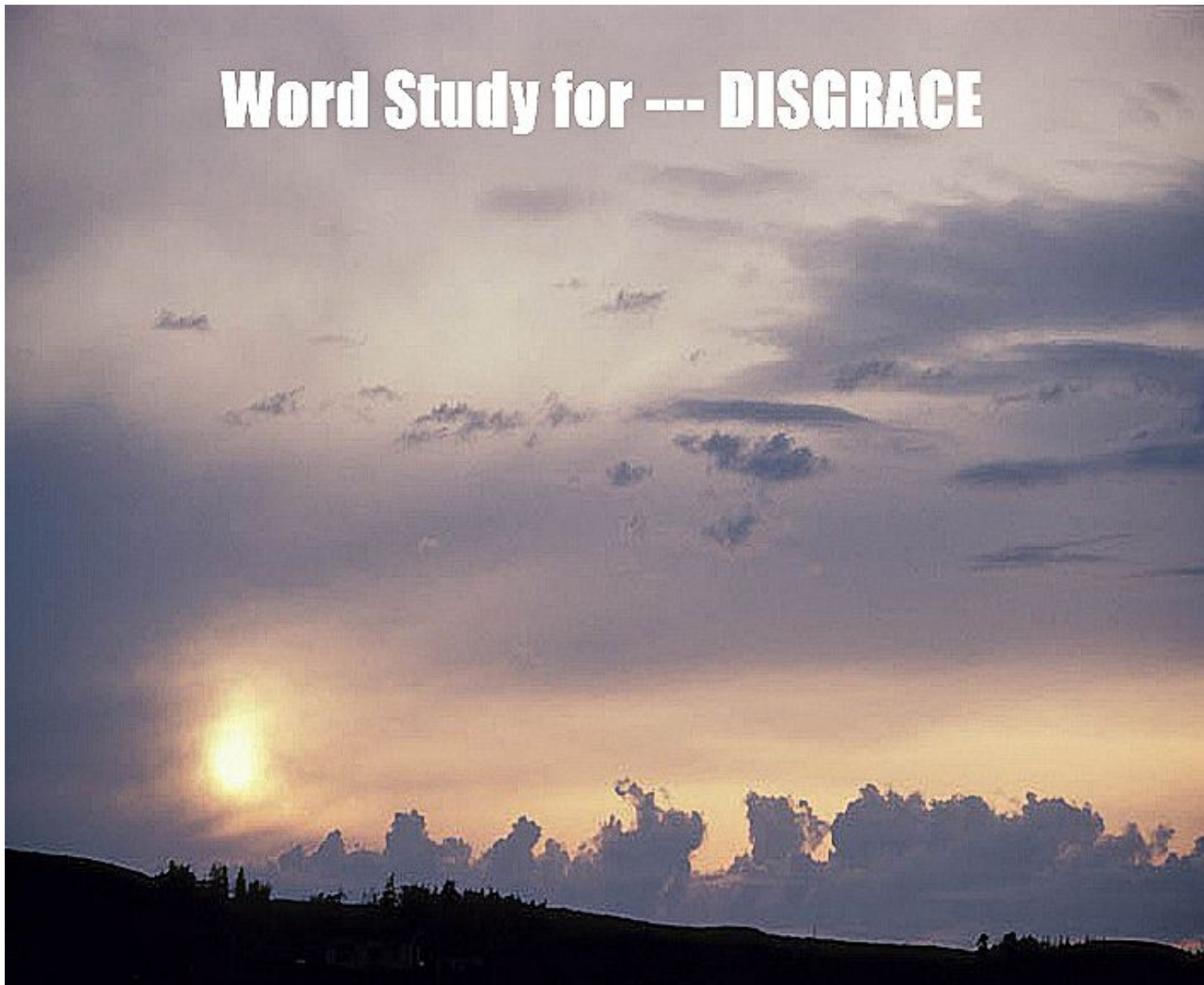

disgrace 4696 - spilos {spee'-los} ; of uncertain derivation ; a stain or blemish, i.e. (figuratively) defect, {disgrace} : -- spot.
