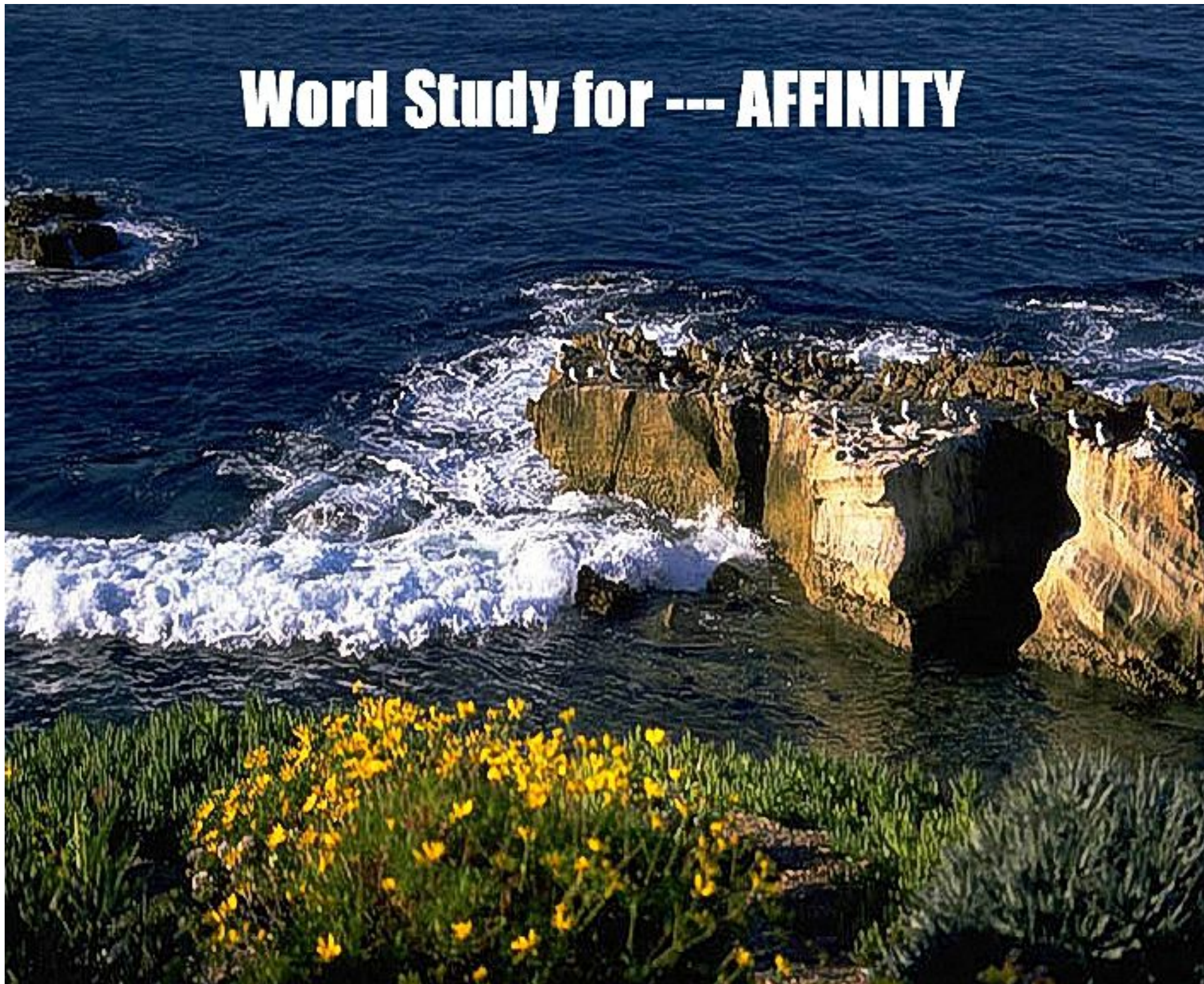

affinity 2316 - theos {theh'-os}; of uncertain {affinity}; a deity, especially (with 3588) the supreme Divinity; figuratively, a magistrate; by Hebraism, very: -- X exceeding, God, god [-ly, -ward].

affinity 2382 - thorax {tho'-rax}; of uncertain {affinity}; the chest (" thorax "), i.e. (by implication) a corslet: -- breast-plate.

affinity 2486 - ichthus {ikh-thoos'}; of uncertain {affinity}; a fish: -- fish.

affinity 2513 - katharos {kath-ar-os'}; of uncertain {affinity}; clean (literally or figuratively): -- clean, clear, pure.

affinity 2570 - kalos {kal-os'}; of uncertain {affinity}; properly, beautiful, but chiefly (figuratively) good (literally or morally), i.e. valuable or virtuous (for appearance or use, and thus distinguished from 0018, which is properly intrinsic): -- X better, fair, good(-ly), honest, meet, well, worthy.

affinity 2586 - kapnos {kap-nos'}; of uncertain {affinity}; smoke: -- smoke.

affinity 2750 - keiria {ki-ree'-ah}; of uncertain {affinity}; a swathe, i.e. winding-sheet: -- graveclothes.

affinity 2771 - kerdos {ker'-dos}; of uncertain {affinity}; gain (pecuniary or genitive case): -- gain, lucre.

affinity 2779 - kepos {kay'-pos}; of uncertain {affinity}; a garden: -- garden.

affinity 2784 - kerusso {kay-roos'-so}; of uncertain {affinity}; to herald (as a public crier), especially divine truth (the gospel): -- preacher(-er), proclaim, publish.

affinity 2788 - kithara {kith-ar'-ah}; of uncertain {affinity}; a lyre: -- harp.

affinity 2799 - klaio {klah'-yo}; of uncertain {affinity}; to sob, i.e. wail aloud (whereas 1145 is rather to cry silently): -- bewail, weep.

affinity 3029 - lian {lee'-an}; of uncertain {affinity}; much (adverbially): -- exceeding, great(-ly), sore, very (+ chiefest).

affinity 3061 - loimos {loy'-mos}; of uncertain {affinity}; a plague (literally, the disease, or figuratively, a pest): -- pestilence(-t).

affinity 3079 - Lusias {loo-see'-as}; of uncertain {affinity}; Lysias, a Roman: -- Lysias.

affinity 3120 - malakos {mal-ak-os'}; of uncertain {affinity}; soft, i.e. fine (clothing); figuratively, a catamite: -- effeminate, soft.

affinity 3133 - maraino {mar-ah'-ee-no}; of uncertain {affinity}; to extinguish (as fire), i.e. (figuratively and passively) to pass away: -- fade away.

affinity 3144 - martus {mar'-toos}; of uncertain {affinity}; a witness (literally [judicially] or figuratively [genitive case]); by analogy, a " martyr " : -- martyr, record, witness.

affinity 3196 - melos {mel'-os}; of uncertain {affinity}; a limb or part of the body: -- member.

affinity 3510 - nephros {nef-ros'}; of uncertain {affinity}; a kidney (plural), i.e. (figuratively) the inmost mind: -- reins.

affinity 3525 - nepho {nay'-fo}; of uncertain {affinity}; to abstain from wine (keep sober), i.e. (figuratively) be discreet: -- be sober, watch.

affinity 3541 - nothos {noth'-os}; of uncertain {affinity}; a spurious or illegitimate son: -- bastard.

affinity 3554 - nosos {nos'-os}; of uncertain {affinity}; a malady (rarely figuratively, of moral disability): -- disease, infirmity, sickness.

affinity 3558 - notos {not'-os}; of uncertain {affinity}; the south(-west) wind; by extension, the southern quarter itself: -- south (wind).

affinity 3577 - notos {no'-tos}; of uncertain {affinity}; the back: -- back.

affinity 3607 - othone {oth-on'-ay}; of uncertain {affinity}; a linen cloth, i.e. (especially) a sail: -- sheet.

affinity 3624 - oikos {oy'-kos}; of uncertain {affinity}; a dwelling (more or less extensive, literal or figurative); by implication a family (more or less related, literal or figuratively): -- home, house(-hold), temple.

affinity 3641 - oligos {ol-ee'-gos}; of uncertain {affinity}; puny (in extent, degree, number, duration or value); especially neuter (adverbial) somewhat: -- + almost, brief [-ly], few, (a) little, + long, a season, short, small, a while.

affinity 3655 - ombros {om'-bros}; of uncertain {affinity}; a thunder storm: -- shower.

affinity 3730 - horme {hor-may'}; of uncertain {affinity}; a violent impulse, i.e. onset: -- assault.

affinity 3737 - orphanos {or-fan-os'}; of uncertain {affinity}; bereaved (" orphan "), i.e. parentless: -- comfortless, fatherless.

affinity 3741 - hosios {hos'-ee-os}; of uncertain {affinity}; properly, right (by intrinsic or divine character; thus distinguished from 1342, which refers rather to human statutes and relations; from 2413, which denotes formal consecration; and from 0040, which relates to purity from defilement), i.e. hallowed (pious, sacred, sure): -- holy, mercy, shalt be.

affinity 3747 - osteon {os-teh'-on}; or contracted ostoun {os-toon'}; of uncertain {affinity}; a bone: -- bone.

affinity 3751 - oshus {os-foos'}; of uncertain {affinity}; the loin (externally), i.e. the hip; intern. (by extension) procreative power: -- loin.

affinity 3989 - pelagos {pel'-ag-os}; of uncertain {affinity}; deep or open sea, i.e. the main: -- depth, sea.

affinity 3995 - penteros {pen-ther-os'}; of uncertain {affinity}; a wife's father: -- father in law.

affinity 4082 - pera {pay'-rah}; of uncertain {affinity}; a wallet or leather pouch for food: -- scrip.

affinity 4083 - pechus {pay'-khoos}; of uncertain {affinity}; the fore-arm, i.e. (as a measure) a cubit: -- cubit.

affinity 4108 - planos {plan'-os}; of uncertain {affinity}; roving (as a tramp), i.e. (by implication) an impostor or misleader; -- deceiver, seducing.
