

wilt thou be altogether unto me as a liar, [and as] waters [that] fail? perpetual To make their land desolate, [and] a {perpetual} hissing; every one that passeth thereby shall be astonished, and wag his head. perpetual And I will bring an everlasting reproach upon you, and a {perpetual} shame, which shall not be forgotten. perpetual Behold, I will send and take all the families of the north, saith the LORD, and Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon, my servant, and will bring them against this land, and against the inhabitants thereof, and against all these nations round about, and will utterly destroy them, and make them an astonishment, and an hissing, and {perpetual} desolations. perpetual And it shall come to pass, when seventy years are accomplished, [that] I will punish the king of Babylon, and that nation, saith the LORD, for their iniquity, and the land of the Chaldeans, and will make it {perpetual} desolations. perpetual For I have sworn by myself, saith the LORD, that Bozrah shall become a desolation, a reproach, a waste, and a curse; and all the cities thereof shall be {perpetual} wastes. perpetual They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, [saying], Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a {perpetual} covenant [that] shall not be forgotten. perpetual In their heat I will make their feasts, and I will make them drunken, that they may rejoice, and sleep a {perpetual} sleep, and not wake, saith the LORD. perpetual And I will make drunk her princes, and her wise [men], her captains, and her rulers, and her mighty men: and they shall sleep a {perpetual} sleep, and not wake, saith the King, whose name [is] the LORD of hosts. perpetual Because thou hast had a {perpetual} hatred, and hast shed [the blood of] the children of Israel by the force of the sword in the time of their calamity, in the time [that their] iniquity [had] an end: perpetual I will make thee {perpetual} desolations, and thy cities shall not return: and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD. perpetual And thou shalt prepare a meat offering for it every morning, the sixth part of an ephah, and the third part of an hin of oil, to temper with the fine flour; a meat offering continually by a {perpetual} ordinance unto the LORD. perpetual He stood, and measured the earth: he beheld, and drove asunder the nations; and the everlasting mountains were scattered, the {perpetual} hills did bow: his ways [are] everlasting. perpetual Therefore [as] I live, saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Surely Moab shall be as Sodom, and the children of Ammon as Gomorrah, [even] the breeding of nettles, and saltpits, and a {perpetual} desolation: the residue of my people shall spoil them, and the remnant of my people shall possess them.
