10\_2SA\_23\_01 Now these [be] the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man [who was] raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,

10\_2SA\_23\_02 The spirit of the LORD spake by me, and his word [was] in my tongue.

10\_2SA\_23\_03 The God of Israel said, the Rock of Israel spake to me, He that ruleth over men [must be] just, ruling in the fear of God.

10\_2SA\_23\_04 And [he shall be] as the light of the morning, [when] the sun riseth, [even] a morning without clouds; [as] the tender grass [springing] out of the earth by clear shining after rain.

10\_2SA\_23\_05 Although my house [be] not so with God; yet he hath made with me an everlasting covenant, ordered in all [things], and sure: for [this is] all my salvation, and all [my] desire, although he make [it] not to grow.

10\_2SA\_23\_06 But [the sons] of Belial [shall be] all of them as thorns thrust away, because they cannot be taken with hands:

10\_2SA\_23\_07 But the man [that] shall touch them must be fenced with iron and the staff of a spear; and they shall be utterly burned with fire in the [same] place

10\_2SA\_23\_08 These [be] the names of the mighty men whom David had: The Tachmonite that sat in the seat, chief among the captains; the same [was] Adino the Eznite: [he lift up his spear] against eight hundred, whom he slew at one time.

10\_2SA\_23\_09 And after him [was] Eleazar the son of Dodo the Ahohite, [one] of the three mighty men with David, when they defied the Philistines [that] were there gathered together to battle, and the men of Israel were gone away:

10\_2SA\_23\_10 He arose, and smote the Philistines until his hand was weary, and his hand clave unto the sword: and the LORD wrought a great victory that day; and the people returned after him only to spoil.

10\_2SA\_23\_11 And after him [was] Shammah the son of Agee the Hararite. And the Philistines were gathered together into a troop, where was a piece of ground full of lentiles: and the people fled from the Philistines.

10\_2SA\_23\_12 But he stood in the midst of the ground, and defended it, and slew the Philistines: and the LORD wrought a great victory.

10\_2SA\_23\_13 And three of the thirty chief went down, and came to David in the harvest time unto the cave of Adullam: and the troop of the Philistines pitched in the valley of Rephaim

10\_2SA\_23\_14 And David [was] then in an hold, and the garrison of the Philistines [was] then [in] Bethlehem

10\_2SA\_23\_15 And David longed, and said, Oh that one would give me drink of the water of the well of Bethlehem, which [is] by the gate!

10\_2SA\_23\_16 And the three mighty men brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: nevertheless he would not drink thereof, but poured it out unto the LORD.

10\_2SA\_23\_17 And he said, Be it far from me, O LORD, that I should do this: [is not this] the blood of the men that went in jeopardy of their lives? therefore he would not drink it. These things did these three mighty men.

10\_2SA\_23\_18 And Abishai, the brother of Joab, the son of Zeruiah, was chief among three. And he lifted up his spear against three hundred, [and] slew [them], and had the name among three.

10 2SA 23 19 Was he not most honourable of three? therefore he was their captain; howbeit he attained not unto the [first] three.

10\_2SA\_23\_20 And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, the son of a valiant man, of Kabzeel, who had done many acts, he slew two lionlike men of Moab: he went down also and slew a lion in the midst of a pit in time of snow:

10\_2SA\_23\_21 And he slew an Egyptian, a goodly man: and the Egyptian had a spear in his hand; but he went down to him with a staff, and plucked the spear out of the Egyptian's hand, and slew him with his own spear.

10\_2SA\_23\_22 These [things] did Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and had the name among three mighty men.

10\_2SA\_23\_23 He was more honourable than the thirty, but he attained not to the [first] three. And David set him over his guard.

10\_2SA\_23\_24 Asahel the brother of Joab [was] one of the thirty; Elhanan the son of Dodo of Bethlehem,

10 2SA 23 25 Shammah the Harodite, Elika the Harodite,

10\_2SA\_23\_26 Helez the Paltite, Ira the son of Ikkesh the Tekoite,

10\_2SA\_23\_27 Abiezer the Anethothite, Mebunnai the Hushathite,

10\_2SA\_23\_28 Zalmon the Ahohite, Maharai the Netophathite,

10 2SA 23 29 Heleb the son of Baanah, a Netophathite, Ittai the son of Ribai out of Gibeah of the children of Benjamin,

10 2SA 23 30 Benaiah the Pirathonite. Hiddai of the brooks of Gaash.

10\_2SA\_23\_31 Abialbon the Arbathite, Azmaveth the Barhumite,

10 2SA 23 32 Eliabba the Shaalbonite, of the sons of Jashen, Jonathan,

10\_2SA\_23\_33 Shammah the Hararite, Ahiam the son of Sharar the Hararite,

10\_2SA\_23\_34 Eliphelet the son of Ahasbai, the son of the Maachathite, Eliam the son of Ahithophel the Gilonite,

10 2SA 23 35 Hezrai the Carmelite, Paarai the Arbite,

10 2SA 23 36 Igal the son of Nathan of Zobah. Bani the Gadite.

10\_2SA\_23\_37 Zelek the Ammonite, Nahari the Beerothite, armourbearer to Joab the son of Zeruiah,

10\_2SA\_23\_38 Ira an Ithrite, Gareb an Ithrite,

10\_2SA\_23\_39 Uriah the Hittite: thirty and seven in all.
