

11\_1KI\_04\_01 So king Solomon was king over all Israel.

11\_1KI\_04\_02 And these [were] the princes which he had; Azariah the son of Zadok the priest,

11\_1KI\_04\_03 Elihoreph and Ahiah, the sons of Shisha, scribes; Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the recorder.

11\_1KI\_04\_04 And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada [was] over the host: and Zadok and Abiathar [were] the priests:

11\_1KI\_04\_05 And Azariah the son of Nathan [was] over the officers; and Zabud the son of Nathan [was] principal officer, [and] the king's friend:

11\_1KI\_04\_06 And Ahishar [was] over the household: and Adoniram the son of Abda [was] over the tribute.

11\_1KI\_04\_07 And Solomon had twelve officers over all Israel, which provided victuals for the king and his household: each man his month in a year made provision.

11\_1KI\_04\_08 And these [are] their names: The son of Hur, in mount Ephraim:

11\_1KI\_04\_09 The son of Dekar, in Makaz, and in Shaalbim, and Bethshemesh, and Elonbethanan:

11\_1KI\_04\_10 The son of Heseid, in Aruboth; to him [pertained] Sochoh, and all the land of Hephher:

11\_1KI\_04\_11 The son of Abinadab, in all the region of Dor; which had Taphath the daughter of Solomon to wife:

11\_1KI\_04\_12 Baana the son of Ahilud; [to him pertained] Taanach and Megiddo, and all Bethshean, which [is] by Zartanah beneath Jezreel, from Bethshean to Abelmeholah, [even] unto [the place that is] beyond Jokneam:

11\_1KI\_04\_13 The son of Geber, in Ramothgilead; to him [pertained] the towns of Jair the son of Manasseh, which [are] in Gilead; to him [also pertained] the region of Argob, which [is] in Bashan, threescore great cities with walls and brazen bars:

11\_1KI\_04\_14 Ahinadab the son of Iddo [had] Mahanaim:

11\_1KI\_04\_15 Ahimaaz [was] in Naphtali; he also took Basmath the daughter of Solomon to wife:

11\_1KI\_04\_16 Baanah the son of Hushai [was] in Asher and in Aloth:

11\_1KI\_04\_17 Jehoshaphat the son of Paruah, in Issachar:

11\_1KI\_04\_18 Shimei the son of Elah, in Benjamin:

11\_1KI\_04\_19 Geber the son of Uri [was] in the country of Gilead, [in] the country of Sihon king of the Amorites, and of Og king of Bashan; and [he was] the only officer which [was] in the land.

11\_1KI\_04\_20 Judah and Israel [were] many, as the sand which [is] by the sea in multitude, eating and drinking, and making merry.

11\_1KI\_04\_21 And Solomon reigned over all kingdoms from the river unto the land of the Philistines, and unto the border of Egypt: they brought presents, and served Solomon all the days of his life.

11\_1KI\_04\_22 And Solomon's provision for one day was thirty measures of fine flour, and threescore measures of meal,

11\_1KI\_04\_23 Ten fat oxen, and twenty oxen out of the pastures, and an hundred sheep, beside harts, and roebucks, and fallowdeer, and fatted fowl.

11\_1KI\_04\_24 For he had dominion over all [the region] on this side the river, from Tiphshah even to Azzah, over all the kings on this side the river: and he had peace on all sides round about him.

11\_1KI\_04\_25 And Judah and Israel dwelt safely, every man under his vine and under his fig tree, from Dan even to Beersheba, all the days of Solomon.

11\_1KI\_04\_26 And Solomon had forty thousand stalls of horses for his chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen.

11\_1KI\_04\_27 And those officers provided victual for king Solomon, and for all that came unto king Solomon's table, every man in his month: they lacked nothing.

11\_1KI\_04\_28 Barley also and straw for the horses and dromedaries brought they unto the place where [the officers] were, every man according to his charge.

11\_1KI\_04\_29 And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that [is] on the sea shore.

11\_1KI\_04\_30 And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt.

11\_1KI\_04\_31 For he was wiser than all men; than Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, and Chalcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol: and his fame was in all nations round about.

11\_1KI\_04\_32 And he spake three thousand proverbs: and his songs were a thousand and five.

11\_1KI\_04\_33 And he spake of trees, from the cedar tree that [is] in Lebanon even unto the hyssop that springeth out of the wall: he spake also of beasts, and of fowl, and of creeping things, and of fishes.

11\_1KI\_04\_34 And there came of all people to hear the wisdom of Solomon, from all kings of the earth, which had heard of his wisdom.
