- 13\_1CH\_10\_01 Now the Philistines fought against Israel; and the men of Israel fled from before the Philistines, and fell down slain in mount Gilboa.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_02 And the Philistines followed hard after Saul, and after his sons; and the Philistines slew Jonathan, and Abinadab, and Malchishua, the sons of Saul.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_03 And the battle went sore against Saul, and the archers hit him, and he was wounded of the archers.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_04 Then said Saul to his armourbearer, Draw thy sword, and thrust me through therewith; lest these uncircumcised come and abuse me. But his armourbearer would not; for he was sore afraid. So Saul took a sword, and fell upon it.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_05 And when his armourbearer saw that Saul was dead, he fell likewise on the sword, and died.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_06 So Saul died, and his three sons, and all his house died together.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_07 And when all the men of Israel that [were] in the valley saw that they fled, and that Saul and his sons were dead, then they forsook their cities, and fled: and the Philistines came and dwelt in them.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_08 And it came to pass on the morrow, when the Philistines came to strip the slain, that they found Saul and his sons fallen in mount Gilboa.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_09 And when they had stripped him, they took his head, and his armour, and sent into the land of the Philistines round about, to carry tidings unto their idols, and to the people.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_10 And they put his armour in the house of their gods, and fastened his head in the temple of Dagon.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_11 And when all Jabeshgilead heard all that the Philistines had done to Saul,
- 13\_1CH\_10\_12 They arose, all the valiant men, and took away the body of Saul, and the bodies of his sons, and brought them to Jabesh, and buried their bones under the oak in Jabesh, and fasted seven days.
- 13\_1CH\_10\_13 So Saul died for his transgression which he committed against the LORD, [even] against the word of the LORD, which he kept not, and also for asking [counsel] of [one that had] a familiar spirit, to inquire [of it];
- 13\_1CH\_10\_14 And inquired not of the LORD: therefore he slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David the son of Jesse.
