

14\_2CH\_04\_01 Moreover he made an altar of brass, twenty cubits the length thereof, and twenty cubits the breadth thereof, and ten cubits the height thereof.

14\_2CH\_04\_02 Also he made a molten sea of ten cubits from brim to brim, round in compass, and five cubits the height thereof; and a line of thirty cubits did compass it round about.

14\_2CH\_04\_03 And under it [was] the similitude of oxen, which did compass it round about: ten in a cubit, compassing the sea round about. Two rows of oxen [were] cast, when it was cast.

14\_2CH\_04\_04 It stood upon twelve oxen, three looking toward the north, and three looking toward the west, and three looking toward the south, and three looking toward the east: and the sea [was set] above upon them, and all their hinder parts [were] inward.

14\_2CH\_04\_05 And the thickness of it [was] an handbreadth, and the brim of it like the work of the brim of a cup, with flowers of lilies; [and] it received and held three thousand baths.

14\_2CH\_04\_06 He made also ten lavers, and put five on the right hand, and five on the left, to wash in them: such things as they offered for the burnt offering they washed in them; but the sea [was] for the priests to wash in.

14\_2CH\_04\_07 And he made ten candlesticks of gold according to their form, and set [them] in the temple, five on the right hand, and five on the left.

14\_2CH\_04\_08 He made also ten tables, and placed [them] in the temple, five on the right side, and five on the left. And he made an hundred basins of gold.

14\_2CH\_04\_09 Furthermore he made the court of the priests, and the great court, and doors for the court, and overlaid the doors of them with brass.

14\_2CH\_04\_10 And he set the sea on the right side of the east end, over against the south.

14\_2CH\_04\_11 And Hiram made the pots, and the shovels, and the basins. And Hiram finished the work that he was to make for king Solomon for the house of God;

14\_2CH\_04\_12 [To wit], the two pillars, and the pommels, and the chapiters [which were] on the top of the two pillars, and the two wreaths to cover the two pommels of the chapiters which [were] on the top of the pillars;

14\_2CH\_04\_13 And four hundred pomegranates on the two wreaths; two rows of pomegranates on each wreath, to cover the two pommels of the chapiters which [were] upon the pillars.

14\_2CH\_04\_14 He made also bases, and lavers made he upon the bases;

14\_2CH\_04\_15 One sea, and twelve oxen under it.

14\_2CH\_04\_16 The pots also, and the shovels, and the fleshhooks, and all their instruments, did Hiram his father make to king Solomon for the house of the LORD of bright brass.

14\_2CH\_04\_17 In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zeredathah.

14\_2CH\_04\_18 Thus Solomon made all these vessels in great abundance: for the weight of the brass could not be found out.

14\_2CH\_04\_19 And Solomon made all the vessels that [were for] the house of God, the golden altar also, and the tables whereon the showbread [was set];

14\_2CH\_04\_20 Moreover the candlesticks with their lamps, that they should burn after the manner before the oracle, of pure gold;

14\_2CH\_04\_21 And the flowers, and the lamps, and the tongs, [made he of] gold, [and] that perfect gold;

14\_2CH\_04\_22 And the snuffers, and the basins, and the spoons, and the censers, [of] pure gold: and the entry of the house, the inner doors thereof for the most holy [place], and the doors of the house of the temple, [were of] gold.
