

26\_EZE\_02\_01 And he said unto me, Son of man, stand upon thy feet, and I will speak unto thee.

26\_EZE\_02\_02 And the spirit entered into me when he spake unto me, and set me upon my feet, that I heard him that spake unto me.

26\_EZE\_02\_03 And he said unto me, Son of man, I send thee to the children of Israel, to a rebellious nation that hath rebelled against me: they and their fathers have transgressed against me, [even] unto this very day.

26\_EZE\_02\_04 For [they are] impudent children and stiffhearted. I do send thee unto them; and thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD.

26\_EZE\_02\_05 And they, whether they will hear, or whether they will forbear, [for they [are] a rebellious house,] yet shall know that there hath been a prophet among them.

26\_EZE\_02\_06 And thou, son of man, be not afraid of them, neither be afraid of their words, though briers and thorns [be] with thee, and thou dost dwell among scorpions: be not afraid of their words, nor be dismayed at their looks, though they [be] a rebellious house.

26\_EZE\_02\_07 And thou shalt speak my words unto them, whether they will hear, or whether they will forbear: for they [are] most rebellious.

26\_EZE\_02\_08 But thou, son of man, hear what I say unto thee; Be not thou rebellious like that rebellious house: open thy mouth, and eat that I give thee.

26\_EZE\_02\_09 And when I looked, behold, an hand [was] sent unto me; and, lo, a roll of a book [was] therein;

26\_EZE\_02\_10 And he spread it before me; and it [was] written within and without: and [there was] written therein lamentations, and mourning, and woe.
