

43\_JOH\_06\_01 After these things Jesus went over the sea of Galilee, which is [the sea] of Tiberias.

43\_JOH\_06\_02 And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.

43\_JOH\_06\_03 And Jesus went up into a mountain, and there he sat with his disciples.

43\_JOH\_06\_04 And the passover, a feast of the Jews, was nigh.

43\_JOH\_06\_05 When Jesus then lifted up [his] eyes, and saw a great company come unto him, he saith unto Philip, Whence shall we buy bread, that these may eat?

43\_JOH\_06\_06 And this he said to prove him: for he himself knew what he would do.

43\_JOH\_06\_07 Philip answered him, Two hundred pennyworth of bread is not sufficient for them, that every one of them may take a little.

43\_JOH\_06\_08 One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,

43\_JOH\_06\_09 There is a lad here, which hath five barley loaves, and two small fishes: but what are they among so many?

43\_JOH\_06\_10 And Jesus said, Make the men sit down. Now there was much grass in the place. So the men sat down, in number about five thousand.

43\_JOH\_06\_11 And Jesus took the loaves; and when he had given thanks, he distributed to the disciples, and the disciples to them that were set down; and likewise of the fishes as much as they would.

43\_JOH\_06\_12 When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost.

43\_JOH\_06\_13 Therefore they gathered [them] together, and filled twelve baskets with the fragments of the five barley loaves, which remained over and above unto them that had eaten.

43\_JOH\_06\_14 Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

43\_JOH\_06\_15 When Jesus therefore perceived that they would come and take him by force, to make him a king, he departed again into a mountain himself alone.

43\_JOH\_06\_16 And when even was [now] come, his disciples went down unto the sea,

43\_JOH\_06\_17 And entered into a ship, and went over the sea toward Capernaum. And it was now dark, and Jesus was not come to them.

43\_JOH\_06\_18 And the sea arose by reason of a great wind that blew.

43\_JOH\_06\_19 So when they had rowed about five and twenty or thirty furlongs, they see Jesus walking on the sea, and drawing nigh unto the ship: and they were afraid.

43\_JOH\_06\_20 But he saith unto them, It is I; be not afraid.

43\_JOH\_06\_21 Then they willingly received him into the ship: and immediately the ship was at the land whither they went.

43\_JOH\_06\_22 The day following, when the people which stood on the other side of the sea saw that there was none other boat there, save that one whereinto his disciples were entered, and that Jesus went not with his disciples into the boat, but [that] his disciples were gone away alone;

43\_JOH\_06\_23 [Howbeit there came other boats from Tiberias nigh unto the place where they did eat bread, after that the Lord had given thanks:]

43\_JOH\_06\_24 When the people therefore saw that Jesus was not there, neither his disciples, they also took shipping, and came to Capernaum, seeking for Jesus.

43\_JOH\_06\_25 And when they had found him on the other side of the sea, they said unto him, Rabbi, when camest thou hither?

43\_JOH\_06\_26 Jesus answered them and said, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Ye seek me, not because ye saw the miracles, but because ye did eat of the loaves, and were filled.

43\_JOH\_06\_27 Labour not for the meat which perisheth, but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.

43\_JOH\_06\_28 Then said they unto him, What shall we do, that we might work the works of God?

43\_JOH\_06\_29 Jesus answered and said unto them, This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.

43\_JOH\_06\_30 They said therefore unto him, What sign showest thou then, that we may see, and believe thee? what dost thou work?

43\_JOH\_06\_31 Our fathers did eat manna in the desert; as it is written, He gave them bread from heaven to eat.

43\_JOH\_06\_32 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Moses gave you not that bread from heaven; but my Father giveth you the true bread from heaven.

43\_JOH\_06\_33 For the bread of God is he which cometh down from heaven, and giveth life unto the world.

43\_JOH\_06\_34 Then said they unto him, Lord, evermore give us this bread.

43\_JOH\_06\_35 And Jesus said unto them, I am the bread of life: he that cometh to me shall never hunger; and he that believeth on me shall never thirst.

43\_JOH\_06\_36 But I said unto you, That ye also have seen me, and believe not.

43\_JOH\_06\_37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out.

43\_JOH\_06\_38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.

43\_JOH\_06\_39 And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

43\_JOH\_06\_40 And this is the will of him that sent me, that every one which seeth the Son, and believeth on him, may have everlasting life: and I will raise him up at the last day.

43\_JOH\_06\_41 The Jews then murmured at him, because he said, I am the bread which came down from heaven.

43\_JOH\_06\_42 And they said, Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know? how is it

then that he saith, I came down from heaven?

43\_JOH\_06\_43 Jesus therefore answered and said unto them, Murmur not among yourselves.

43\_JOH\_06\_44 No man can come to me, except the Father which hath sent me draw him: and I will raise him up at the last day.

43\_JOH\_06\_45 It is written in the prophets, And they shall be all taught of God. Every man therefore that hath heard, and hath learned of the Father, cometh unto me.

43\_JOH\_06\_46 Not that any man hath seen the Father, save he which is of God, he hath seen the Father.

43\_JOH\_06\_47 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me hath everlasting life.

43\_JOH\_06\_48 I am that bread of life.

43\_JOH\_06\_49 Your fathers did eat manna in the wilderness, and are dead.

43\_JOH\_06\_50 This is the bread which cometh down from heaven, that a man may eat thereof, and not die.

43\_JOH\_06\_51 I am the living bread which came down from heaven: if any man eat of this bread, he shall live for ever: and the bread that I will give is my flesh, which I will give for the life of the world.

43\_JOH\_06\_52 The Jews therefore strove among themselves, saying, How can this man give us [his] flesh to eat?

43\_JOH\_06\_53 Then Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except ye eat the flesh of the Son of man, and drink his blood, ye have no life in you.

43\_JOH\_06\_54 Whoso eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, hath eternal life; and I will raise him up at the last day.

43\_JOH\_06\_55 For my flesh is meat indeed, and my blood is drink indeed.

43\_JOH\_06\_56 He that eateth my flesh, and drinketh my blood, dwelleth in me, and I in him.

43\_JOH\_06\_57 As the living Father hath sent me, and I live by the Father: so he that eateth me, even he shall live by me.

43\_JOH\_06\_58 This is that bread which came down from heaven: not as your fathers did eat manna, and are dead: he that eateth of this bread shall live for ever.

43\_JOH\_06\_59 These things said he in the synagogue, as he taught in Capernaum.

43\_JOH\_06\_60 Many therefore of his disciples, when they had heard [this], said, This is an hard saying; who can hear it?

43\_JOH\_06\_61 When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you?

43\_JOH\_06\_62 [What] and if ye shall see the Son of man ascend up where he was before?

43\_JOH\_06\_63 It is the spirit that quickeneth; the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, [they] are spirit, and [they] are life.

43\_JOH\_06\_64 But there are some of you that believe not. For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were that

believed not, and who should betray him.

43\_JOH\_06\_65 And he said, Therefore said I unto you, that no man can come unto me, except it were given unto him of my Father.

43\_JOH\_06\_66 From that [time] many of his disciples went back, and walked no more with him.

43\_JOH\_06\_67 Then said Jesus unto the twelve, Will ye also go away?

43\_JOH\_06\_68 Then Simon Peter answered him, Lord, to whom shall we go? thou hast the words of eternal life.

43\_JOH\_06\_69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the Son of the living God.

43\_JOH\_06\_70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?

43\_JOH\_06\_71 He spake of Judas Iscariot [the son] of Simon: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve.
