49\_EPH\_05\_01 Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children;

49\_EPH\_05\_02 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.

49\_EPH\_05\_03 But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints;

49\_EPH\_05\_04 Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

49\_EPH\_05\_05 For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

49\_EPH\_05\_06 Let no man deceive you with vain words: for because of these things cometh the wrath of God upon the children of disobedience.

49\_EPH\_05\_07 Be not ye therefore partakers with them.

49\_EPH\_05\_08 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now [are ye] light in the Lord: walk as children of light:

49\_EPH\_05\_09 [For the fruit of the Spirit [is] in all goodness and righteousness and truth;]

49\_EPH\_05\_10 Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord.

49\_EPH\_05\_11 And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather reprove [them].

49\_EPH\_05\_12 For it is a shame even to speak of those things which are done of them in secret.

49\_EPH\_05\_13 But all things that are reproved are made manifest by the light: for whatsoever doth make manifest is light.

49\_EPH\_05\_14 Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light.

49\_EPH\_05\_15 See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,

49\_EPH\_05\_16 Redeeming the time, because the days are evil.

49\_EPH\_05\_17 Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord [is].

49\_EPH\_05\_18 And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit;

49\_EPH\_05\_19 Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord;

49\_EPH\_05\_20 Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

49 EPH 05 21 Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

49\_EPH\_05\_22 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.

49\_EPH\_05\_23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

49\_EPH\_05\_24 Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so [let] the wives [be] to their own husbands in every thing.

49\_EPH\_05\_25 Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

49\_EPH\_05\_26 That he might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word,

49\_EPH\_05\_27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.

49\_EPH\_05\_28 So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loveth his wife loveth himself.

49\_EPH\_05\_29 For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourisheth and cherisheth it, even as the Lord the church:

49\_EPH\_05\_30 For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.

49\_EPH\_05\_31 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.

49\_EPH\_05\_32 This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ and the church.

49\_EPH\_05\_33 Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife [see] that she reverence [her] husband.
