3394 + of uncleanness +/- . miasmos {mee-as-mos'}; from 3392 + defile + is defiled + be defiled + they should be defiled + but unto them that are defiled +/- ; (morally) contamination (properly, the act): --uncleanness .

3435 + is defiled + have not defiled + were not defiled +/- . moluno {mol-oo'-no}; probably from 3189 + black + a black +/- ; to soil (figuratively): --defile .

3436 + filthiness +/- . molusmos {mol-oos-mos'}; from 3435 + is defiled + have not defiled + were not defiled +/- ; a stain; i.e. (figuratively) immorality: --filthiness .
