

- 27\_DAN\_01\_01 In the third year of the reign of Jehoiakim king of Judah came Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon unto Jerusalem, and besieged it.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_02 And the Lord gave Jehoiakim king of Judah into his hand, with part of the vessels of the house of God: which he carried into the land of Shinar to the house of his god; and he brought the vessels into the treasure house of his god.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_03 And the king spake unto Ashpenaz the master of his eunuchs, that he should bring [certain] of the children of Israel, and of the king's seed, and of the princes;
- 27\_DAN\_01\_04 Children in whom [was] no blemish, but well favoured, and skilful in all wisdom, and cunning in knowledge, and understanding science, and such as [had] ability in them to stand in the king's palace, and whom they might teach the learning and the tongue of the Chaldeans.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_05 And the king appointed them a daily provision of the king's meat, and of the wine which he drank: so nourishing them three years, that at the end thereof they might stand before the king.
- 27 DAN 01 06 Now among these were of the children of Judah, Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah:
- 27\_DAN\_01\_07 Unto whom the prince of the eunuchs gave names: for he gave unto Daniel [the name] of Belteshazzar; and to Hananiah, of Shadrach; and to Mishael, of Meshach; and to Azariah, of Abednego.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_08 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's meat, nor with the wine which he drank: therefore he requested of the prince of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_09 Now God had brought Daniel into favour and tender love with the prince of the eunuchs.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_10 And the prince of the eunuchs said unto Daniel, I fear my lord the king, who hath appointed your meat and your drink: for why should he see your faces worse liking than the children which [are] of your sort? then shall ye make [me] endanger my head to the king.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_11 Then said Daniel to Melzar, whom the prince of the eunuchs had set over Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah,
- 27 DAN 01 12 Prove thy servants, I beseech thee, ten days; and let them give us pulse to eat, and water to drink.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_13 Then let our countenances be looked upon before thee, and the countenance of the children that eat of the portion of the king's meat: and as thou seest, deal with thy servants.
- 27 DAN 01 14 So he consented to them in this matter, and proved them ten days.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_15 And at the end of ten days their countenances appeared fairer and fatter in flesh than all the children which did eat the portion of the king's meat.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_16 Thus Melzar took away the portion of their meat, and the wine that they should drink; and gave them pulse.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_17 As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_18 Now at the end of the days that the king had said he should bring them in, then the prince of the eunuchs brought them in before Nebuchadnezzar.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_19 And the king communed with them; and among them all was found none like Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah: therefore stood they before the king.
- 27\_DAN\_01\_20 And in all matters of wisdom [and] understanding, that the king inquired of them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians [and] astrologers that [were] in all his realm.
- 27 DAN 01 21 And Daniel continued [even] unto the first year of king Cyrus.



- 27\_DAN\_02\_01 And in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams, wherewith his spirit was troubled, and his sleep brake from him.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_02 Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to show the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_03 And the king said unto them, I have dreamed a dream, and my spirit was troubled to know the dream.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_04 Then spake the Chaldeans to the king in Syriack, O king, live for ever: tell thy servants the dream, and we will show the interpretation.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_05 The king answered and said to the Chaldeans, The thing is gone from me: if ye will not make known unto me the dream, with the interpretation thereof, ye shall be cut in pieces, and your houses shall be made a dunghill.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_06 But if ye show the dream, and the interpretation thereof, ye shall receive of me gifts and rewards and great honour: therefore show me the dream, and the interpretation thereof.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_07 They answered again and said, Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will show the interpretation of it.
- thing is gone from me.

  27\_DAN\_02\_09 But if ye will not make known unto me the dream, [there is but] one decree for you: for ye have

prepared lying and corrupt words to speak before me, till the time be changed: therefore tell me the dream, and I

27 DAN 02 08 The king answered and said, I know of certainty that ye would gain the time, because ye see the

- shall know that ye can show me the interpretation thereof.

  27\_DAN\_02\_10 The Chaldeans answered before the king, and said, There is not a man upon the earth that can show the king's matter: therefore [there is] no king, lord, nor ruler, [that] asked such things at any magician, or astrologer,
- 27\_DAN\_02\_11 And [it is] a rare thing that the king requireth, and there is none other that can show it before the king, except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh.

- 27\_DAN\_02\_12 For this cause the king was angry and very furious, and commanded to destroy all the wise [men] of Babylon.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_13 And the decree went forth that the wise [men] should be slain; and they sought Daniel and his fellows to be slain.

27\_DAN\_02\_14 Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was

- gone forth to slay the wise [men] of Babylon:
- Then Arioch made the thing known to Daniel.

27\_DAN\_02\_15 He answered and said to Arioch the king's captain, Why [is] the decree [so] hasty from the king?

27\_DAN\_02\_16 Then Daniel went in, and desired of the king that he would give him time, and that he would show the king the interpretation.

27 DAN 02 17 Then Daniel went to his house, and made the thing known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah, his

- companions:

  27 DAN 02 18 That they would desire mercies of the God of heaven concerning this secret; that Daniel and his
- fellows should not perish with the rest of the wise [men] of Babylon.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_19 Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven.

27\_DAN\_02\_20 Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are

- 27 DAN 02 21 And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth
- 27 DAN 02 22 He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what [is] in the darkness, and the light dwelleth

wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:

27 DAN 02 23 I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and

hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast [now] made known unto us the king's matter.

- 27\_DAN\_02\_24 Therefore Daniel went in unto Arioch, whom the king had ordained to destroy the wise [men] of Babylon: he went and said thus unto him; Destroy not the wise [men] of Babylon: bring me in before the king, and I
- 27\_DAN\_02\_25 Then Arioch brought in Daniel before the king in haste, and said thus unto him, I have found a man of the captives of Judah, that will make known unto the king the interpretation.
- unto me the dream which I have seen, and the interpretation thereof?

27 DAN 02 26 The king answered and said to Daniel, whose name [was] Belteshazzar, Art thou able to make known

27\_DAN\_02\_28 But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets, and maketh known to the king Nebuchadnezzar what shall be in the latter days. Thy dream, and the visions of thy head upon thy bed, are these;

27 DAN 02 27 Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king hath demanded

cannot the wise [men], the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, show unto the king;

27\_DAN\_02\_29 As for thee, O king, thy thoughts came [into thy mind] upon thy bed, what should come to pass hereafter: and he that revealeth secrets maketh known to thee what shall come to pass.

27 DAN 02 30 But as for me, this secret is not revealed to me for [any] wisdom that I have more than any living, but

- for [their] sakes that shall make known the interpretation to the king, and that thou mightest know the thoughts of thy heart.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_31 Thou, O king, sawest, and behold a great image. This great image, whose brightness [was] excellent, stood before thee; and the form thereof [was] terrible.

27 DAN 02 32 This image's head [was] of fine gold, his breast and his arms of silver, his belly and his thighs of

- 27\_DAN\_02\_33 His legs of iron, his feet part of iron and part of clay.27 DAN 02 34 Thou sawest till that a stone was cut out without hands, which smote the image upon his feet [that
- 27\_DAN\_02\_35 Then was the iron, the clay, the brass, the silver, and the gold, broken to pieces together, and

27 DAN 02 36 This [is] the dream; and we will tell the interpretation thereof before the king.

- became like the chaff of the summer threshingfloors; and the wind carried them away, that no place was found for them: and the stone that smote the image became a great mountain, and filled the whole earth.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_37 Thou, O king, [art] a king of kings: for the God of heaven hath given thee a kingdom, power, and strength, and glory.

27 DAN 02 38 And wheresoever the children of men dwell, the beasts of the field and the fowls of the heaven hath

27\_DAN\_02\_39 And after thee shall arise another kingdom inferior to thee, and another third kingdom of brass, which shall bear rule over all the earth.

he given into thine hand, and hath made thee ruler over them all. Thou [art] this head of gold.

all [things]: and as iron that breaketh all these, shall it break in pieces and bruise.

27 DAN 02 40 And the fourth kingdom shall be strong as iron: forasmuch as iron breaketh in pieces and subdueth

27\_DAN\_02\_41 And whereas thou sawest the feet and toes, part of potter's clay, and part of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; but there shall be in it of the strength of the iron, forasmuch as thou sawest the iron mixed with miry clay.

- 27 DAN 02 42 And [as] the toes of the feet [were] part of iron, and part of clay, [so] the kingdom shall be partly
- 27\_DAN\_02\_43 And whereas thou sawest iron mixed with miry clay, they shall mingle themselves with the seed of men: but they shall not cleave one to another, even as iron is not mixed with clay.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_44 And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, [but] it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_45 Forasmuch as thou sawest that the stone was cut out of the mountain without hands, and that it brake in pieces the iron, the brass, the clay, the silver, and the gold; the great God hath made known to the king what shall come to pass hereafter: and the dream [is] certain, and the interpretation thereof sure.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_46 Then the king Nebuchadnezzar fell upon his face, and worshipped Daniel, and commanded that they should offer an oblation and sweet odours unto him.
- 27\_DAN\_02\_47 The king answered unto Daniel, and said, Of a truth [it is], that your God [is] a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldest reveal this secret.
- whole province of Babylon, and chief of the governors over all the wise [men] of Babylon.

  27 DAN 02 49 Then Daniel requested of the king, and he set Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, over the affairs of

the province of Babylon: but Daniel [sat] in the gate of the king.

27 DAN 02 48 Then the king made Daniel a great man, and gave him many great gifts, and made him ruler over the



- 27\_DAN\_03\_01 Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold, whose height [was] threescore cubits, [and] the breadth thereof six cubits: he set it up in the plain of Dura, in the province of Babylon.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_02 Then Nebuchadnezzar the king sent to gather together the princes, the governors, and the captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, to come to the dedication of the image which Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_03 Then the princes, the governors, and captains, the judges, the treasurers, the counsellors, the sheriffs, and all the rulers of the provinces, were gathered together unto the dedication of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up; and they stood before the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_04 Then an herald cried aloud, To you it is commanded, O people, nations, and languages,
- 27\_DAN\_03\_05 [That] at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king hath set up:
- 27\_DAN\_03\_06 And whose falleth not down and wershippeth shall the same hour be cast into the midst of a burning fiery furnace.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_07 Therefore at that time, when all the people heard the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and all kinds of music, all the people, the nations, and the languages, fell down [and] worshipped the golden image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_08 Wherefore at that time certain Chaldeans came near, and accused the Jews.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_09 They spake and said to the king Nebuchadnezzar, O king, live for ever.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_10 Thou, O king, hast made a decree, that every man that shall hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of music, shall fall down and worship the golden image:
- 27\_DAN\_03\_11 And whose falleth not down and wershippeth, [that] he should be cast into the midst of a burning fiery furnace.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_12 There are certain Jews whom thou hast set over the affairs of the province of Babylon, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego; these men, O king, have not regarded thee: they serve not thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_13 Then Nebuchadnezzar in [his] rage and fury commanded to bring Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego. Then they brought these men before the king.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_14 Nebuchadnezzar spake and said unto them, [Is it] true, O Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, do not ye serve my gods, nor worship the golden image which I have set up?
- 27\_DAN\_03\_15 Now if ye be ready that at what time ye hear the sound of the cornet, flute, harp, sackbut, psaltery, and dulcimer, and all kinds of music, ye fall down and worship the image which I have made; [well]: but if ye worship not, ye shall be cast the same hour into the midst of a burning fiery furnace; and who [is] that God that shall deliver you out of my hands?
- 27\_DAN\_03\_16 Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, answered and said to the king, O Nebuchadnezzar, we [are] not careful to answer thee in this matter.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_17 If it be [so], our God whom we serve is able to deliver us from the burning fiery furnace, and he will deliver [us] out of thine hand, O king.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_18 But if not, be it known unto thee, O king, that we will not serve thy gods, nor worship the golden image which thou hast set up.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_19 Then was Nebuchadnezzar full of fury, and the form of his visage was changed against Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego: [therefore] he spake, and commanded that they should heat the furnace one seven times more than it was wont to be heated.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_20 And he commanded the most mighty men that [were] in his army to bind Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, [and] to cast [them] into the burning fiery furnace.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_21 Then these men were bound in their coats, their hosen, and their hats, and their [other] garments, and were cast into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_22 Therefore because the king's commandment was urgent, and the furnace exceeding hot, the flame of the fire slew those men that took up Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_23 And these three men, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, fell down bound into the midst of the burning fiery furnace.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_24 Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonied, and rose up in haste, [and] spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_26 Then Nebuchadnezzar came near to the mouth of the burning fiery furnace, [and] spake, and said, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, ye servants of the most high God, come forth, and come [hither]. Then Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, came forth of the midst of the fire.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_27 And the princes, governors, and captains, and the king's counsellors, being gathered together, saw these men, upon whose bodies the fire had no power, nor was an hair of their head singed, neither were their coats changed, nor the smell of fire had passed on them.
- 27\_DAN\_03\_28 [Then] Nebuchadnezzar spake, and said, Blessed [be] the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who hath sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, and have changed the king's word,
- and yielded their bodies, that they might not serve nor worship any god, except their own God.

  27\_DAN\_03\_29 Therefore I make a decree, That every people, nation, and language, which speak any thing amiss
- dunghill: because there is no other God that can deliver after this sort.

27 DAN 03 30 Then the king promoted Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, in the province of Babylon.



- 27\_DAN\_04\_01 Nebuchadnezzar the king, unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you.
- 27 DAN 04 02 I thought it good to show the signs and wonders that the high God hath wrought toward me.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_03 How great [are] his signs! and how mighty [are] his wonders! his kingdom [is] an everlasting kingdom, and his dominion [is] from generation to generation.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_04 I Nebuchadnezzar was at rest in mine house, and flourishing in my palace:
- 27\_DAN\_04\_05 I saw a dream which made me afraid, and the thoughts upon my bed and the visions of my head troubled me.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_06 Therefore made I a decree to bring in all the wise [men] of Babylon before me, that they might make known unto me the interpretation of the dream.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_07 Then came in the magicians, the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers: and I told the dream before them; but they did not make known unto me the interpretation thereof.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_08 But at the last Daniel came in before me, whose name [was] Belteshazzar, according to the name of my god, and in whom [is] the spirit of the holy gods: and before him I told the dream, [saying],
- and no secret troubleth thee, tell me the visions of my dream that I have seen, and the interpretation thereof.

27 DAN 04 09 O Belteshazzar, master of the magicians, because I know that the spirit of the holy gods [is] in thee,

- 27\_DAN\_04\_10 Thus [were] the visions of mine head in my bed; I saw, and behold, a tree in the midst of the earth, and the height thereof [was] great.
- the end of all the earth:

27 DAN 04 11 The tree grew, and was strong, and the height thereof reached unto heaven, and the sight thereof to

- 27\_DAN\_04\_12 The leaves thereof [were] fair, and the fruit thereof much, and in it [was] meat for all: the beasts of the field had shadow under it, and the fowls of the heaven dwelt in the boughs thereof, and all flesh was fed of it.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_13 I saw in the visions of my head upon my bed, and, behold, a watcher and an holy one came down from heaven;
- 27\_DAN\_04\_14 He cried aloud, and said thus, Hew down the tree, and cut off his branches, shake off his leaves, and scatter his fruit: let the beasts get away from under it, and the fowls from his branches:
- 27\_DAN\_04\_15 Nevertheless leave the stump of his roots in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and [let] his portion [be] with the beasts in the grass of the earth:
- 27\_DAN\_04\_16 Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given unto him: and let seven times pass over him.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_17 This matter [is] by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_18 This dream I king Nebuchadnezzar have seen. Now thou, O Belteshazzar, declare the interpretation thereof, forasmuch as all the wise [men] of my kingdom are not able to make known unto me the interpretation: but thou [art] able; for the spirit of the holy gods [is] in thee.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_19 Then Daniel, whose name [was] Belteshazzar, was astonied for one hour, and his thoughts troubled him. The king spake, and said, Belteshazzar, let not the dream, or the interpretation thereof, trouble thee. Belteshazzar answered and said, My lord, the dream [be] to them that hate thee, and the interpretation thereof to thine enemies.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_20 The tree that thou sawest, which grew, and was strong, whose height reached unto the heaven, and the sight thereof to all the earth;
- 27\_DAN\_04\_21 Whose leaves [were] fair, and the fruit thereof much, and in it [was] meat for all; under which the

beasts of the field dwelt, and upon whose branches the fowls of the heaven had their habitation:

- 27\_DAN\_04\_22 It [is] thou, O king, that art grown and become strong: for thy greatness is grown, and reacheth unto
- 27\_DAN\_04\_23 And whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying, Hew the tree down, and destroy it; yet leave the stump of the roots thereof in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and [let] his portion [be] with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him;
- 27\_DAN\_04\_24 This [is] the interpretation, O king, and this [is] the decree of the most High, which is come upon my lord the king:
- 27\_DAN\_04\_25 That they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field, and they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and they shall wet thee with the dew of heaven, and seven times shall pass over thee, till thou know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will.
- thee, after that thou shalt have known that the heavens do rule.

27 DAN 04 26 And whereas they commanded to leave the stump of the tree roots; thy kingdom shall be sure unto

- 27\_DAN\_04\_27 Wherefore, O king, let my counsel be acceptable unto thee, and break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by showing mercy to the poor; if it may be a lengthening of thy tranquillity.
- 27 DAN 04 20 At the and of two live months he welled in the

- 27\_DAN\_04\_29 At the end of twelve months he walked in the palace of the kingdom of Babylon.

  27\_DAN\_04\_31 While the word [was] in the king's mouth, there fell a voice from heaven, [saying], O king

27 DAN 04 32 And they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling [shall be] with the beasts of the field: they shall

27\_DAN\_04\_30 The king spake, and said, Is not this great Babylon, that I have built for the house of the kingdom by

- Nebuchadnezzar, to thee it is spoken; The kingdom is departed from thee.
- make thee to eat grass as oxen, and seven times shall pass over thee, until thou know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_33 The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' [feathers], and his nails like birds' [claws].
- 27\_DAN\_04\_34 And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up mine eyes unto heaven, and mine understanding returned unto me, and I blessed the most High, and I praised and honoured him that liveth for ever, whose dominion [is] an everlasting dominion, and his kingdom [is] from generation to generation:
- 27\_DAN\_04\_35 And all the inhabitants of the earth [are] reputed as nothing: and he doeth according to his will in the army of heaven, and [among] the inhabitants of the earth: and none can stay his hand, or say unto him, What doest
- 27\_DAN\_04\_36 At the same time my reason returned unto me; and for the glory of my kingdom, mine honour and brightness returned unto me; and my counsellors and my lords sought unto me; and I was established in my kingdom, and excellent majesty was added unto me.
- 27\_DAN\_04\_37 Now I Nebuchadnezzar praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all whose works [are] truth,

and his ways judgment: and those that walk in pride he is able to abase.



- 27\_DAN\_05\_01 Belshazzar the king made a great feast to a thousand of his lords, and drank wine before the thousand.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_02 Belshazzar, whiles he tasted the wine, commanded to bring the golden and silver vessels which his father Nebuchadnezzar had taken out of the temple which [was] in Jerusalem; that the king, and his princes, his wives, and his concubines, might drink therein.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_03 Then they brought the golden vessels that were taken out of the temple of the house of God which [was] at Jerusalem; and the king, and his princes, his wives, and his concubines, drank in them.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_04 They drank wine, and praised the gods of gold, and of silver, of brass, of iron, of wood, and of stone.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_05 In the same hour came forth fingers of a man's hand, and wrote over against the candlestick upon the plaster of the wall of the king's palace: and the king saw the part of the hand that wrote.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_06 Then the king's countenance was changed, and his thoughts troubled him, so that the joints of his loins were loosed, and his knees smote one against another.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_07 The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. [And] the king spake, and said to the wise [men] of Babylon, Whosoever shall read this writing, and show me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about his neck, and shall be the third ruler in the kingdom.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_08 Then came in all the king's wise [men]: but they could not read the writing, nor make known to the king the interpretation thereof.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_09 Then was king Belshazzar greatly troubled, and his countenance was changed in him, and his lords were astonied.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_10 [Now] the queen by reason of the words of the king and his lords came into the banquet house: [and] the queen spake and said, O king, live for ever: let not thy thoughts trouble thee, nor let thy countenance be changed:
- 27\_DAN\_05\_11 There is a man in thy kingdom, in whom [is] the spirit of the holy gods; and in the days of thy father light and understanding and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar thy father, the king, [I say], thy father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, [and] soothsayers;
- 27\_DAN\_05\_12 Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and knowledge, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and showing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar: now let Daniel be called, and he will show the interpretation.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_13 Then was Daniel brought in before the king. [And] the king spake and said unto Daniel, [Art] thou that Daniel, which [art] of the children of the captivity of Judah, whom the king my father brought out of Jewry?
- 27\_DAN\_05\_14 I have even heard of thee, that the spirit of the gods [is] in thee, and [that] light and understanding and excellent wisdom is found in thee.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_15 And now the wise [men], the astrologers, have been brought in before me, that they should read this writing, and make known unto me the interpretation thereof: but they could not show the interpretation of the thing:
- 27\_DAN\_05\_16 And I have heard of thee, that thou canst make interpretations, and dissolve doubts: now if thou canst read the writing, and make known to me the interpretation thereof, thou shalt be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about thy neck, and shalt be the third ruler in the kingdom.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_17 Then Daniel answered and said before the king, Let thy gifts be to thyself, and give thy rewards to another; yet I will read the writing unto the king, and make known to him the interpretation.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_18 O thou king, the most high God gave Nebuchadnezzar thy father a kingdom, and majesty, and glory, and honour:
- 27\_DAN\_05\_19 And for the majesty that he gave him, all people, nations, and languages, trembled and feared before him: whom he would he slew; and whom he would he kept alive; and whom he would he set up; and whom he would he put down.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_20 But when his heart was lifted up, and his mind hardened in pride, he was deposed from his kingly throne, and they took his glory from him:
- 27\_DAN\_05\_21 And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling [was] with the wild asses: they fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven; till he knew that the most high God ruled in the kingdom of men, and [that] he appointed over it whomsoever he will.
- 27 DAN 05 22 And thou his son, O Belshazzar, hast not humbled thine heart, though thou knewest all this;
- 27\_DAN\_05\_23 But hast lifted up thyself against the Lord of heaven; and they have brought the vessels of his house before thee, and thou, and thy lords, thy wives, and thy concubines, have drunk wine in them; and thou hast praised the gods of silver, and gold, of brass, iron, wood, and stone, which see not, nor hear, nor know: and the God in whose hand thy breath [is], and whose [are] all thy ways, hast thou not glorified:
- 27\_DAN\_05\_24 Then was the part of the hand sent from him; and this writing was written.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_25 And this [is] the writing that was written, MENE, MENE, TEKEL, UPHARSIN.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_26 This [is] the interpretation of the thing: MENE; God hath numbered thy kingdom, and finished it.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_27 TEKEL; Thou art weighed in the balances, and art found wanting.
- 27 DAN 05 28 PERES; Thy kingdom is divided, and given to the Medes and Persians.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_29 Then commanded Belshazzar, and they clothed Daniel with scarlet, and [put] a chain of gold about his neck, and made a proclamation concerning him, that he should be the third ruler in the kingdom.
- 27 DAN 05 30 In that night was Belshazzar the king of the Chaldeans slain.
- 27\_DAN\_05\_31 And Darius the Median took the kingdom, [being] about threescore and two years old.



- 27\_DAN\_06\_01 It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom an hundred and twenty princes, which should be over the whole kingdom;
- 27\_DAN\_06\_02 And over these three presidents; of whom Daniel [was] first: that the princes might give accounts unto them, and the king should have no damage.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_03 Then this Daniel was preferred above the presidents and princes, because an excellent spirit [was] in him; and the king thought to set him over the whole realm.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_04 Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he [was] faithful, neither was there any error or fault found in him.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_05 Then said these men, We shall not find any occasion against this Daniel, except we find [it] against him concerning the law of his God.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_06 Then these presidents and princes assembled together to the king, and said thus unto him, King Darius, live for ever.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_07 All the presidents of the kingdom, the governors, and the princes, the counsellors, and the captains, have consulted together to establish a royal statute, and to make a firm decree, that whosoever shall ask a petition of any God or man for thirty days, save of thee, O king, he shall be cast into the den of lions.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_08 Now, O king, establish the decree, and sign the writing, that it be not changed, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_09 Wherefore king Darius signed the writing and the decree.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.
- 27 DAN 06 11 Then these men assembled, and found Daniel praying and making supplication before his God.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_12 Then they came near, and spake before the king concerning the king's decree; Hast thou not signed a decree, that every man that shall ask [a petition] of any God or man within thirty days, save of thee, O king, shall be cast into the den of lions? The king answered and said, The thing [is] true, according to the law of the Medes and Persians, which altereth not.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_13 Then answered they and said before the king, That Daniel, which [is] of the children of the captivity of Judah, regardeth not thee, O king, nor the decree that thou hast signed, but maketh his petition three times a day.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_14 Then the king, when he heard [these] words, was sore displeased with himself, and set [his] heart on Daniel to deliver him: and he laboured till the going down of the sun to deliver him.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_15 Then these men assembled unto the king, and said unto the king, Know, O king, that the law of the Medes and Persians [is], That no decree nor statute which the king establisheth may be changed.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_16 Then the king commanded, and they brought Daniel, and cast [him] into the den of lions. [Now] the king spake and said unto Daniel, Thy God whom thou servest continually, he will deliver thee.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_17 And a stone was brought, and laid upon the mouth of the den; and the king sealed it with his own signet, and with the signet of his lords; that the purpose might not be changed concerning Daniel.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_18 Then the king went to his palace, and passed the night fasting: neither were instruments of music brought before him: and his sleep went from him.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_19 Then the king arose very early in the morning, and went in haste unto the den of lions.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_20 And when he came to the den, he cried with a lamentable voice unto Daniel: [and] the king spake and said to Daniel, O Daniel, servant of the living God, is thy God, whom thou servest continually, able to deliver thee from the lions?
- 27\_DAN\_06\_21 Then said Daniel unto the king, O king, live for ever.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_22 My God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocency was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_23 Then was the king exceeding glad for him, and commanded that they should take Daniel up out of the den. So Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he believed in his God.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_24 And the king commanded, and they brought those men which had accused Daniel, and they cast [them] into the den of lions, them, their children, and their wives; and the lions had the mastery of them, and brake all their bones in pieces or ever they came at the bottom of the den.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_25 Then king Darius wrote unto all people, nations, and languages, that dwell in all the earth; Peace be multiplied unto you.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_26 I make a decree, That in every dominion of my kingdom men tremble and fear before the God of Daniel: for he [is] the living God, and stedfast for ever, and his kingdom [that] which shall not be destroyed, and his dominion [shall be even] unto the end.
- 27\_DAN\_06\_27 He delivereth and rescueth, and he worketh signs and wonders in heaven and in earth, who hath delivered Daniel from the power of the lions.
- 27 DAN 06 28 So this Daniel prospered in the reign of Darius, and in the reign of Cyrus the Persian.



- 27\_DAN\_07\_01 In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon Daniel had a dream and visions of his head upon his bed: then he wrote the dream, [and] told the sum of the matters.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_02 Daniel spake and said, I saw in my vision by night, and, behold, the four winds of the heaven strove upon the great sea.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_03 And four great beasts came up from the sea, diverse one from another.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_04 The first [was] like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_05 And behold another beast, a second, like to a bear, and it raised up itself on one side, and [it had] three ribs in the mouth of it between the teeth of it: and they said thus unto it, Arise, devour much flesh.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_06 After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had also four heads; and dominion was given to it.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_07 After this I saw in the night visions, and behold a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, and strong exceedingly; and it had great iron teeth: it devoured and brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with the feet of it: and it [was] diverse from all the beasts that [were] before it; and it had ten horns.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_08 I considered the horns, and, behold, there came up among them another little horn, before whom there were three of the first horns plucked up by the roots: and, behold, in this horn [were] eyes like the eyes of man, and a mouth speaking great things.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_09 I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment [was] white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne [was like] the fiery flame, [and] his wheels [as] burning fire.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_10 A fiery stream issued and came forth from before him: thousand thousands ministered unto him, and ten thousand times ten thousand stood before him: the judgment was set, and the books were opened.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_11 I beheld then because of the voice of the great words which the horn spake: I beheld [even] till the beast was slain, and his body destroyed, and given to the burning flame.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_12 As concerning the rest of the beasts, they had their dominion taken away: yet their lives were prolonged for a season and time.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_13 I saw in the night visions, and, behold, [one] like the Son of man came with the clouds of heaven, and came to the Ancient of days, and they brought him near before him.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_14 And there was given him dominion, and glory, and a kingdom, that all people, nations, and languages, should serve him: his dominion [is] an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and his kingdom [that] which shall not be destroyed.
- 27 DAN 07 15 I Daniel was grieved in my spirit in the midst of [my] body, and the visions of my head troubled me.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_16 I came near unto one of them that stood by, and asked him the truth of all this. So he told me, and made me know the interpretation of the things.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_17 These great beasts, which are four, [are] four kings, [which] shall arise out of the earth.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_18 But the saints of the most High shall take the kingdom, and possess the kingdom for ever, even for ever and ever.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_19 Then I would know the truth of the fourth beast, which was diverse from all the others, exceeding dreadful, whose teeth [were of] iron, and his nails [of] brass; [which] devoured, brake in pieces, and stamped the residue with his feet;
- 27\_DAN\_07\_20 And of the ten horns that [were] in his head, and [of] the other which came up, and before whom three fell; even [of] that horn that had eyes, and a mouth that spake very great things, whose look [was] more stout than his fellows.
- 27 DAN 07 21 I beheld, and the same horn made war with the saints, and prevailed against them;
- 27\_DAN\_07\_22 Until the Ancient of days came, and judgment was given to the saints of the most High; and the time came that the saints possessed the kingdom.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_23 Thus he said, The fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth, which shall be diverse from all kingdoms, and shall devour the whole earth, and shall tread it down, and break it in pieces.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_24 And the ten horns out of this kingdom [are] ten kings [that] shall arise: and another shall rise after them; and he shall be diverse from the first, and he shall subdue three kings.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_25 And he shall speak [great] words against the most High, and shall wear out the saints of the most High, and think to change times and laws: and they shall be given into his hand until a time and times and the dividing of time.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_26 But the judgment shall sit, and they shall take away his dominion, to consume and to destroy [it] unto the end.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_27 And the kingdom and dominion, and the greatness of the kingdom under the whole heaven, shall be given to the people of the saints of the most High, whose kingdom [is] an everlasting kingdom, and all dominions shall serve and obey him.
- 27\_DAN\_07\_28 Hitherto [is] the end of the matter. As for me Daniel, my cogitations much troubled me, and my countenance changed in me: but I kept the matter in my heart.



- 27\_DAN\_08\_01 In the third year of the reign of king Belshazzar a vision appeared unto me, [even unto] me Daniel, after that which appeared unto me at the first.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_02 And I saw in a vision; and it came to pass, when I saw, that I [was] at Shushan [in] the palace, which [is] in the province of Elam; and I saw in a vision, and I was by the river of Ulai.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_03 Then I lifted up mine eyes, and saw, and, behold, there stood before the river a ram which had [two] horns: and the [two] horns [were] high; but one [was] higher than the other, and the higher came up last.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_04 I saw the ram pushing westward, and northward, and southward; so that no beasts might stand before him, neither [was there any] that could deliver out of his hand; but he did according to his will, and became great.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_05 And as I was considering, behold, an he goat came from the west on the face of the whole earth, and touched not the ground: and the goat [had] a notable horn between his eyes.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_06 And he came to the ram that had [two] horns, which I had seen standing before the river, and ran unto him in the fury of his power.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_07 And I saw him come close unto the ram, and he was moved with choler against him, and smote the ram, and brake his two horns: and there was no power in the ram to stand before him, but he cast him down to the ground, and stamped upon him: and there was none that could deliver the ram out of his hand.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_08 Therefore the he goat waxed very great: and when he was strong, the great horn was broken; and for it came up four notable ones toward the four winds of heaven.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_09 And out of one of them came forth a little horn, which waxed exceeding great, toward the south, and toward the east, and toward the pleasant [land].
- 27\_DAN\_08\_10 And it waxed great, [even] to the host of heaven; and it cast down [some] of the host and of the stars to the ground, and stamped upon them.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_11 Yea, he magnified [himself] even to the prince of the host, and by him the daily [sacrifice] was taken away, and the place of his sanctuary was cast down.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_12 And an host was given [him] against the daily [sacrifice] by reason of transgression, and it cast down the truth to the ground; and it practiced, and prospered.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_13 Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain [saint] which spake, How long [shall be] the vision [concerning] the daily [sacrifice], and the transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot?
- 27\_DAN\_08\_14 And he said unto me, Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_15 And it came to pass, when I, [even] I Daniel, had seen the vision, and sought for the meaning, then, behold, there stood before me as the appearance of a man.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_16 And I heard a man's voice between [the banks of] Ulai, which called, and said, Gabriel, make this [man] to understand the vision.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_17 So he came near where I stood: and when he came, I was afraid, and fell upon my face: but he said unto me, Understand, O son of man: for at the time of the end [shall be] the vision.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_18 Now as he was speaking with me, I was in a deep sleep on my face toward the ground: but he touched me, and set me upright.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_19 And he said, Behold, I will make thee know what shall be in the last end of the indignation: for at the time appointed the end [shall be].
- 27\_DAN\_08\_20 The ram which thou sawest having [two] horns [are] the kings of Media and Persia.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_21 And the rough goat [is] the king of Grecia: and the great horn that [is] between his eyes [is] the first king.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_22 Now that being broken, whereas four stood up for it, four kingdoms shall stand up out of the nation, but not in his power.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_23 And in the latter time of their kingdom, when the transgressors are come to the full, a king of fierce countenance, and understanding dark sentences, shall stand up.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_24 And his power shall be mighty, but not by his own power: and he shall destroy wonderfully, and shall prosper, and practice, and shall destroy the mighty and the holy people.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_25 And through his policy also he shall cause craft to prosper in his hand; and he shall magnify [himself] in his heart, and by peace shall destroy many: he shall also stand up against the Prince of princes; but he shall be broken without hand.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_26 And the vision of the evening and the morning which was told [is] true: wherefore shut thou up the vision; for it [shall be] for many days.
- 27\_DAN\_08\_27 And I Daniel fainted, and was sick [certain] days; afterward I rose up, and did the king's business; and I was astonished at the vision, but none understood [it].



- 27\_DAN\_09\_01 In the first year of Darius the son of Ahasuerus, of the seed of the Medes, which was made king over the realm of the Chaldeans;
- 27\_DAN\_09\_02 In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the LORD came to Jeremiah the prophet, that he would accomplish seventy years in the desolations of Jerusalem.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_03 And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:
- 27\_DAN\_09\_04 And I prayed unto the LORD my God, and made my confession, and said, O Lord, the great and dreadful God, keeping the covenant and mercy to them that love him, and to them that keep his commandments;
- 27\_DAN\_09\_05 We have sinned, and have committed iniquity, and have done wickedly, and have rebelled, even by departing from thy precepts and from thy judgments:
- 27\_DAN\_09\_06 Neither have we hearkened unto thy servants the prophets, which spake in thy name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_07 O Lord, righteousness [belongeth] unto thee, but unto us confusion of faces, as at this day; to the men of Judah, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and unto all Israel, [that are] near, and [that are] far off, through all the countries whither thou hast driven them, because of their trespass that they have trespassed against thee.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_08 O Lord, to us [belongeth] confusion of face, to our kings, to our princes, and to our fathers, because we have sinned against thee.
- 27 DAN 09 09 To the Lord our God [belong] mercies and forgivenesses, though we have rebelled against him;
- 27\_DAN\_09\_10 Neither have we obeyed the voice of the LORD our God, to walk in his laws, which he set before us by his servants the prophets.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_11 Yea, all Israel have transgressed thy law, even by departing, that they might not obey thy voice; therefore the curse is poured upon us, and the oath that [is] written in the law of Moses the servant of God, because we have sinned against him.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_12 And he hath confirmed his words, which he spake against us, and against our judges that judged us, by bringing upon us a great evil: for under the whole heaven hath not been done as hath been done upon Jerusalem.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_13 As [it is] written in the law of Moses, all this evil is come upon us: yet made we not our prayer before the LORD our God, that we might turn from our iniquities, and understand thy truth.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_14 Therefore hath the LORD watched upon the evil, and brought it upon us: for the LORD our God [is] righteous in all his works which he doeth: for we obeyed not his voice.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_15 And now, O Lord our God, that hast brought thy people forth out of the land of Egypt with a mighty hand, and hast gotten thee renown, as at this day; we have sinned, we have done wickedly.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_16 O Lord, according to all thy righteousness, I beseech thee, let thine anger and thy fury be turned away from thy city Jerusalem, thy holy mountain: because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and thy people [are become] a reproach to all [that are] about us.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_17 Now therefore, O our God, hear the prayer of thy servant, and his supplications, and cause thy face to shine upon thy sanctuary that is desolate, for the Lord's sake.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_18 O my God, incline thine ear, and hear; open thine eyes, and behold our desolations, and the city which is called by thy name: for we do not present our supplications before thee for our righteousnesses, but for thy great mercies.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_19 O Lord, hear; O Lord, forgive; O Lord, hearken and do; defer not, for thine own sake, O my God: for thy city and thy people are called by thy name.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_20 And whiles I [was] speaking, and praying, and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel, and presenting my supplication before the LORD my God for the holy mountain of my God;
- 27\_DAN\_09\_21 Yea, whiles I [was] speaking in prayer, even the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, touched me about the time of the evening oblation.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_22 And he informed [me], and talked with me, and said, O Daniel, I am now come forth to give thee skill and understanding.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_23 At the beginning of thy supplications the commandment came forth, and I am come to show [thee]; for thou [art] greatly beloved: therefore understand the matter, and consider the vision.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_24 Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon thy holy city, to finish the transgression, and to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most Holy.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_25 Know therefore and understand, [that] from the going forth of the commandment to restore and to build Jerusalem unto the Messiah the Prince [shall be] seven weeks, and threescore and two weeks: the street shall be built again, and the wall, even in troublous times.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_26 And after threescore and two weeks shall Messiah be cut off, but not for himself: and the people of the prince that shall come shall destroy the city and the sanctuary; and the end thereof [shall be] with a flood, and unto the end of the war desolations are determined.
- 27\_DAN\_09\_27 And he shall confirm the covenant with many for one week: and in the midst of the week he shall cause the sacrifice and the oblation to cease, and for the overspreading of abominations he shall make [it] desolate, even until the consummation, and that determined shall be poured upon the desolate.



- 27\_DAN\_10\_01 In the third year of Cyrus king of Persia a thing was revealed unto Daniel, whose name was called Belteshazzar; and the thing [was] true, but the time appointed [was] long: and he understood the thing, and had understanding of the vision.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_02 In those days I Daniel was mourning three full weeks.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_03 I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_04 And in the four and twentieth day of the first month, as I was by the side of the great river, which [is] Hiddekel;
- 27\_DAN\_10\_05 Then I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed in linen, whose loins [were] girded with fine gold of Uphaz:
- 27\_DAN\_10\_06 His body also [was] like the beryl, and his face as the appearance of lightning, and his eyes as lamps of fire, and his arms and his feet like in colour to polished brass, and the voice of his words like the voice of a multitude.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_07 And I Daniel alone saw the vision: for the men that were with me saw not the vision; but a great quaking fell upon them, so that they fled to hide themselves.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_08 Therefore I was left alone, and saw this great vision, and there remained no strength in me: for my comeliness was turned in me into corruption, and I retained no strength.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_09 Yet heard I the voice of his words: and when I heard the voice of his words, then was I in a deep sleep on my face, and my face toward the ground.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_10 And, behold, an hand touched me, which set me upon my knees and [upon] the palms of my hands.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_11 And he said unto me, O Daniel, a man greatly beloved, understand the words that I speak unto thee, and stand upright: for unto thee am I now sent. And when he had spoken this word unto me, I stood trembling.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_12 Then said he unto me, Fear not, Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_13 But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_14 Now I am come to make thee understand what shall be fall thy people in the latter days: for yet the vision [is] for [many] days.
- 27 DAN 10 15 And when he had spoken such words unto me, I set my face toward the ground, and I became dumb.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_16 And, behold, [one] like the similitude of the sons of men touched my lips: then I opened my mouth, and spake, and said unto him that stood before me, O my lord, by the vision my sorrows are turned upon me, and I have retained no strength.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_17 For how can the servant of this my lord talk with this my lord? for as for me, straightway there remained no strength in me, neither is there breath left in me.
- 27 DAN 10 18 Then there came again and touched me [one] like the appearance of a man, and he strengthened me,
- 27\_DAN\_10\_19 And said, O man greatly beloved, fear not: peace [be] unto thee, be strong, yea, be strong. And when he had spoken unto me, I was strengthened, and said, Let my lord speak; for thou hast strengthened me.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_20 Then said he, Knowest thou wherefore I come unto thee? and now will I return to fight with the prince of Persia: and when I am gone forth, lo, the prince of Grecia shall come.
- 27\_DAN\_10\_21 But I will show thee that which is noted in the scripture of truth: and [there is] none that holdeth with me in these things, but Michael your prince.



- 27\_DAN\_11\_01 Also I in the first year of Darius the Mede, [even] I, stood to confirm and to strengthen him.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_02 And now will I show thee the truth. Behold, there shall stand up yet three kings in Persia; and the fourth shall be far richer than [they] all: and by his strength through his riches he shall stir up all against the realm of Grecia.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_03 And a mighty king shall stand up, that shall rule with great dominion, and do according to his will.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_04 And when he shall stand up, his kingdom shall be broken, and shall be divided toward the four winds of heaven; and not to his posterity, nor according to his dominion which he ruled: for his kingdom shall be plucked up, even for others beside those.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_05 And the king of the south shall be strong, and [one] of his princes; and he shall be strong above him, and have dominion; his dominion [shall be] a great dominion.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_06 And in the end of years they shall join themselves together; for the king's daughter of the south shall come to the king of the north to make an agreement: but she shall not retain the power of the arm; neither shall he stand, nor his arm: but she shall be given up, and they that brought her, and he that begat her, and he that strengthened her in [these] times.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_07 But out of a branch of her roots shall [one] stand up in his estate, which shall come with an army, and shall enter into the fortress of the king of the north, and shall deal against them, and shall prevail:
- 27\_DAN\_11\_08 And shall also carry captives into Egypt their gods, with their princes, [and] with their precious vessels of silver and of gold; and he shall continue [more] years than the king of the north.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_09 So the king of the south shall come into [his] kingdom, and shall return into his own land.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_10 But his sons shall be stirred up, and shall assemble a multitude of great forces: and [one] shall certainly come, and overflow, and pass through: then shall he return, and be stirred up, [even] to his fortress.
- with the king of the north: and he shall set forth a great multitude; but the multitude shall be given into his hand.

27\_DAN\_11\_11 And the king of the south shall be moved with choler, and shall come forth and fight with him, [even]

- 27\_DAN\_11\_12 [And] when he hath taken away the multitude, his heart shall be lifted up; and he shall cast down [many] ten thousands: but he shall not be strengthened [by it].
- 27\_DAN\_11\_13 For the king of the north shall return, and shall set forth a multitude greater than the former, and shall certainly come after certain years with a great army and with much riches.
- 27\_DAN\_11\_14 And in those times there shall many stand up against the king of the south: also the robbers of thy people shall exalt themselves to establish the vision; but they shall fall.
- arms of the south shall not withstand, neither his chosen people, neither [shall there be any] strength to withstand.

  27 DAN 11 16 But he that cometh against him shall do according to his own will, and none shall stand before him:

27 DAN 11 15 So the king of the north shall come, and cast up a mount, and take the most fenced cities: and the

- 27\_DAN\_11\_17 He shall also set his face to enter with the strength of his whole kingdom, and upright ones with him; thus shall he do: and he shall give him the daughter of women, corrupting her: but she shall not stand [on his side], neither be for him.

- 27 DAN 11 27 And both these kings' hearts [shall be] to do mischief, and they shall speak lies at one table; but it
- 27\_DAN\_11\_28 Then shall he return into his land with great riches; and his heart [shall be] against the holy
- 27\_DAN\_11\_29 At the time appointed he shall return, and come toward the south; but it shall not be as the former, or as the latter.

- 27\_DAN\_11\_40 And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the
- countries, and shall overflow and pass over.

  27\_DAN\_11\_41 He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many [countries] shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, [even] Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon.
- 27 DAN 11 42 He shall stretch forth his hand also upon the countries: and the land of Egypt shall not escape.
- 27 DAN 11 43 But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of
- 27 DAN 11 44 But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with
- 27 DAN 11 45 And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain; yet

- 27\_DAN\_12\_07 And I heard the man clothed in linen, which [was] upon the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and sware by him that liveth for ever that [it shall be] for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these [things] shall be finished.
- 27\_DAN\_12\_08 And I heard, but I understood not: then said I, O my Lord, what [shall be] the end of these [things]?
- 27\_DAN\_12\_09 And he said, Go thy way, Daniel: for the words [are] closed up and sealed till the time of the end.
- 27\_DAN\_12\_10 Many shall be purified, and made white, and tried; but the wicked shall do wickedly: and none of the wicked shall understand; but the wise shall understand.
- 27\_DAN\_12\_11 And from the time [that] the daily [sacrifice] shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, [there shall be] a thousand two hundred and ninety days.
- 27\_DAN\_12\_12 Blessed [is] he that waiteth, and cometh to the thousand three hundred and five and thirty days.
- 27\_DAN\_12\_13 But go thou thy way till the end [be]: for thou shalt rest, and stand in thy lot at the end of the days.
