- 36_ZEP_01_01 The word of the LORD which came unto Zephaniah the son of Cushi, the son of Gedaliah, the son of Amariah, the son of Hizkiah, in the days of Josiah the son of Amon, king of Judah.
- 36 ZEP 01 02 I will utterly consume all [things] from off the land, saith the LORD.
- 36_ZEP_01_03 I will consume man and beast; I will consume the fowls of the heaven, and the fishes of the sea, and the stumblingblocks with the wicked; and I will cut off man from off the land, saith the LORD.
- 36_ZEP_01_04 I will also stretch out mine hand upon Judah, and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and I will cut off the remnant of Baal from this place, [and] the name of the Chemarims with the priests;
- 36_ZEP_01_05 And them that worship the host of heaven upon the housetops; and them that worship [and] that swear by the LORD, and that swear by Malcham;
- 36_ZEP_01_06 And them that are turned back from the LORD; and [those] that have not sought the LORD, nor inquired for him.
- 36_ZEP_01_07 Hold thy peace at the presence of the Lord GOD: for the day of the LORD [is] at hand: for the LORD hath prepared a sacrifice, he hath bid his guests.

- 36_ZEP_02_01 Gather yourselves together, yea, gather together, O nation not desired;
- 36_ZEP_02_02 Before the decree bring forth, [before] the day pass as the chaff, before the fierce anger of the LORD come upon you, before the day of the LORD'S anger come upon you.
- 36_ZEP_02_03 Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.
- 36_ZEP_02_04 For Gaza shall be forsaken, and Ashkelon a desolation: they shall drive out Ashdod at the noon day, and Ekron shall be rooted up.
- 36_ZEP_02_05 Woe unto the inhabitants of the sea coast, the nation of the Cherethites! the word of the LORD [is] against you; O Canaan, the land of the Philistines, I will even destroy thee, that there shall be no inhabitant.

- 36 ZEP 03 01 Woe to her that is filthy and polluted, to the oppressing city!
- 36_ZEP_03_02 She obeyed not the voice; she received not correction; she trusted not in the LORD; she drew not near to her God.
- 36_ZEP_03_03 Her princes within her [are] roaring lions; her judges [are] evening wolves; they gnaw not the bones till the morrow.
- 36_ZEP_03_04 Her prophets [are] light [and] treacherous persons: her priests have polluted the sanctuary, they have done violence to the law.
- 36_ZEP_03_05 The just LORD [is] in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning doth he bring his judgment to light, he faileth not; but the unjust knoweth no shame.
- 36_ZEP_03_06 I have cut off the nations: their towers are desolate; I made their streets waste, that none passeth by: their cities are destroyed, so that there is no man, that there is none inhabitant.
