

- 51_COL_01_01 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timotheus [our] brother,
- 51_COL_01_02 To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace [be] unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 51 COL 01 03 We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, praying always for you,
- 51 COL 01 04 Since we heard of your faith in Christ Jesus, and of the love [which ye have] to all the saints,
- 51_COL_01_05 For the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel;
- 51_COL_01_06 Which is come unto you, as [it is] in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as [it doth] also in you, since the day ye heard [of it], and knew the grace of God in truth:
- 51_COL_01_07 As ye also learned of Epaphras our dear fellowservant, who is for you a faithful minister of Christ;
- 51_COL_01_08 Who also declared unto us your love in the Spirit.
- 51_COL_01_09 For this cause we also, since the day we heard [it], do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;
- 51_COL_01_10 That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;
- 51_COL_01_11 Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;
- 51_COL_01_12 Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:
- 51_COL_01_13 Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated [us] into the kingdom of his dear Son:
- 51_COL_01_14 In whom we have redemption through his blood, [even] the forgiveness of sins:
- 51_COL_01_15 Who is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of every creature:
- 51_COL_01_16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether [they be] thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:
- 51 COL 01 17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist.
- 51_COL_01_18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all [things] he might have the preeminence.
- 51_COL_01_19 For it pleased [the Father] that in him should all fulness dwell;
- 51_COL_01_20 And, having made peace through the blood of his cross, by him to reconcile all things unto himself; by him, [I say], whether [they be] things in earth, or things in heaven.
- 51_COL_01_21 And you, that were sometime alienated and enemies in [your] mind by wicked works, yet now hath he reconciled
- 51_COL_01_22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unreproveable in his sight:
- 51_COL_01_23 If ye continue in the faith grounded and settled, and [be] not moved away from the hope of the gospel, which ye have heard, [and] which was preached to every creature which is under heaven; whereof I Paul am made a minister;
- 51_COL_01_24 Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church:
- 51_COL_01_25 Whereof I am made a minister, according to the dispensation of God which is given to me for you, to fulfil the word of God;
- 51_COL_01_26 [Even] the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints:
- 51_COL_01_27 To whom God would make known what [is] the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory:
- 51_COL_01_28 Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus:
- 51 COL 01 29 Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily.



- 51_COL_02_01 For I would that ye knew what great conflict I have for you, and [for] them at Laodicea, and [for] as many as have not seen my face in the flesh;
- 51_COL_02_02 That their hearts might be comforted, being knit together in love, and unto all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the acknowledgment of the mystery of God, and of the Father, and of Christ;
- 51_COL_02_03 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
- 51_COL_02_04 And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words.
- 51_COL_02_05 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.
- 51 COL 02 06 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, [so] walk ye in him:
- 51_COL_02_07 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanks giving.
- 51_COL_02_08 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.
- 51 COL 02 09 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.
- 51 COL 02 10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:
- 51_COL_02_11 In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:
- 51_COL_02_12 Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with [him] through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.
- 51_COL_02_13 And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;
- 51_COL_02_14 Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross;
- 51_COL_02_15 [And] having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it
- 51_COL_02_16 Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holyday, or of the new moon, or of the sabbath [days]:
- 51 COL 02 17 Which are a shadow of things to come; but the body [is] of Christ.
- 51_COL_02_18 Let no man beguile you of your reward in a voluntary humility and worshipping of angels, intruding into those things which he hath not seen, vainly puffed up by his fleshly mind,
- 51_COL_02_19 And not holding the Head, from which all the body by joints and bands having nourishment ministered, and knit together, increaseth with the increase of God.
- 51_COL_02_20 Wherefore if ye be dead with Christ from the rudiments of the world, why, as though living in the world, are ye subject to ordinances,
- 51_COL_02_21 [Touch not; taste not; handle not;
- 51_COL_02_22 Which all are to perish with the using; after the commandments and doctrines of men?
- 51_COL_02_23 Which things have indeed a show of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honour to the satisfying of the flesh.



- 51_COL_03_01 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.
- 51 COL 03 02 Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.
- 51 COL_03_03 For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.
- 51 COL 03 04 When Christ, [who is] our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.
- 51_COL_03_05 Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:
- 51_COL_03_06 For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:
- 51_COL_03_07 In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them.
- 51_COL_03_08 But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.
- 51 COL 03 09 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;
- 51_COL_03_10 And have put on the new [man], which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:
- 51_COL_03_11 Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond [nor] free: but Christ [is] all, and in all.
- 51_COL_03_12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;
- 51_COL_03_13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also [do] ye.
- 51_COL_03_14 And above all these things [put on] charity, which is the bond of perfectness.
- 51_COL_03_15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.
- 51_COL_03_16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
- 51_COL_03_17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, [do] all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.
- 51 COL 03 18 Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord.
- 51 COL 03 19 Husbands, love [your] wives, and be not bitter against them.
- 51 COL 03 20 Children, obey [your] parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.
- 51 COL 03 21 Fathers, provoke not your children [to anger], lest they be discouraged.
- 51_COL_03_22 Servants, obey in all things [your] masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God:
- 51 COL 03 23 And whatsoever ye do, do [it] heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- 51 COL 03 24 Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.
- 51_COL_03_25 But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.

- 51_COL_04_01 Masters, give unto [your] servants that which is just and equal; knowing that ye also have a Master in heaven.
- 51 COL 04 02 Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving;
- 51_COL_04_03 Withal praying also for us, that God would open unto us a door of utterance, to speak the mystery of Christ, for which I am also in bonds:
- 51 COL 04 04 That I may make it manifest, as I ought to speak.
- 51 COL 04 05 Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time.
- 51_COL_04_06 Let your speech [be] alway with grace, seasoned with salt, that ye may know how ye ought to answer every man.
- 51_COL_04_07 All my state shall Tychicus declare unto you, [who is] a beloved brother, and a faithful minister and fellowservant in the Lord:
- 51_COL_04_08 Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that he might know your estate, and comfort your hearts:
- 51_COL_04_09 With Onesimus, a faithful and beloved brother, who is [one] of you. They shall make known unto you all things which [are done] here.
- 51_COL_04_10 Aristarchus my fellowprisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, [touching whom ye received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;]
- 51_COL_04_11 And Jesus, which is called Justus, who are of the circumcision. These only [are my] fellowworkers unto the kingdom of God, which have been a comfort unto me.
- 51_COL_04_12 Epaphras, who is [one] of you, a servant of Christ, saluteth you, always labouring fervently for you in prayers, that ye may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.
- 51_COL_04_13 For I bear him record, that he hath a great zeal for you, and them [that are] in Laodicea and them in Hierapolis.
- 51_COL_04_14 Luke, the beloved physician, and Demas, greet you.
- 51 COL 04 15 Salute the brethren which are in Laodicea, and Nymphas, and the church which is in his house.
- 51_COL_04_16 And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the [epistle] from Laodicea.
- 51_COL_04_17 And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it.
- 51 COL 04 18 The salutation by the hand of me Paul. Remember my bonds. Grace [be] with you. Amen.
