- 52_1TH_01_01 Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians [which is] in God the Father and [in] the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace [be] unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 52 1TH 01 02 We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers;
- 52_1TH_01_03 Remembering without ceasing your work of faith, and labour of love, and patience of hope in our Lord Jesus Christ, in the sight of God and our Father;
- 52_1TH_01_04 Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God.
- 52_1TH_01_05 For our gospel came not unto you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Ghost, and in much assurance; as ye know what manner of men we were among you for your sake.
- 52_1TH_01_06 And ye became followers of us, and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Ghost:
- 52_1TH_01_07 So that ye were ensamples to all that believe in Macedonia and Achaia.
- 52_1TH_01_08 For from you sounded out the word of the Lord not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place your faith to God ward is spread abroad; so that we need not to speak any thing.
- 52_1TH_01_09 For they themselves show of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God;
- 52_1TH_01_10 And to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead, [even] Jesus, which delivered us from the wrath to come.



- 52_1TH_02_01 For yourselves, brethren, know our entrance in unto you, that it was not in vain:
- 52_1TH_02_02 But even after that we had suffered before, and were shamefully entreated, as ye know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much contention.
- 52 1TH 02 03 For our exhortation [was] not of deceit, nor of uncleanness, nor in guile:
- 52_1TH_02_04 But as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which trieth our hearts.
- 52_1TH_02_05 For neither at any time used we flattering words, as ye know, nor a cloak of covetousness; God [is] witness:
- 52_1TH_02_06 Nor of men sought we glory, neither of you, nor [yet] of others, when we might have been burdensome, as the apostles of Christ.
- 52 1TH 02 07 But we were gentle among you, even as a nurse cherisheth her children:
- 52_1TH_02_08 So being affectionately desirous of you, we were willing to have imparted unto you, not the gospel of God only, but also our own souls, because ye were dear unto us.
- 52_1TH_02_09 For ye remember, brethren, our labour and travail: for labouring night and day, because we would not be chargeable unto any of you, we preached unto you the gospel of God.
- 52_1TH_02_10 Ye [are] witnesses, and God [also], how holily and justly and unblameably we behaved ourselves among you that believe:
- 52_1TH_02_11 As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father [doth] his children,
- 52_1TH_02_12 That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.
- 52_1TH_02_13 For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received [it] not [as] the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.
- 52_1TH_02_14 For ye, brethren, became followers of the churches of God which in Judaea are in Christ Jesus: for ye also have suffered like things of your own countrymen, even as they [have] of the Jews:
- 52_1TH_02_15 Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men:
- 52_1TH_02_16 Forbidding us to speak to the Gentiles that they might be saved, to fill up their sins alway: for the wrath is come upon them to the uttermost.
- 52_1TH_02_17 But we, brethren, being taken from you for a short time in presence, not in heart, endeavoured the more abundantly to see your face with great desire.
- 52 1TH 02 18 Wherefore we would have come unto you, even I Paul, once and again; but Satan hindered us.
- 52_1TH_02_19 For what [is] our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? [Are] not even ye in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at his coming?
- 52_1TH_02_20 For ye are our glory and joy.

- 52_1TH_03_01 Wherefore when we could no longer forbear, we thought it good to be left at Athens alone;
- 52_1TH_03_02 And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellowlabourer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your faith:
- 52_1TH_03_03 That no man should be moved by these afflictions: for yourselves know that we are appointed thereunto.
- 52_1TH_03_04 For verily, when we were with you, we told you before that we should suffer tribulation; even as it came to pass, and ye know.
- 52_1TH_03_05 For this cause, when I could no longer forbear, I sent to know your faith, lest by some means the tempter have tempted you, and our labour be in vain.
- 52_1TH_03_06 But now when Timotheus came from you unto us, and brought us good tidings of your faith and charity, and that ye have good remembrance of us always, desiring greatly to see us, as we also [to see] you:
- 52_1TH_03_07 Therefore, brethren, we were comforted over you in all our affliction and distress by your faith:
- 52_1TH_03_08 For now we live, if ye stand fast in the Lord.
- 52_1TH_03_09 For what thanks can we render to God again for you, for all the joy wherewith we joy for your sakes before our God;
- 52_1TH_03_10 Night and day praying exceedingly that we might see your face, and might perfect that which is lacking in your faith?
- 52_1TH_03_11 Now God himself and our Father, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way unto you.
- 52_1TH_03_12 And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all [men], even as we [do] toward you:
- 52_1TH_03_13 To the end he may stablish your hearts unblameable in holiness before God, even our Father, at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all his saints.

- 52_1TH_04_01 Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort [you] by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, [so] ye would abound more and more.
- 52 1TH 04 02 For ye know what commandments we gave you by the Lord Jesus.
- 52 1TH 04 03 For this is the will of God, [even] your sanctification, that ye should abstain from fornication:
- 52_1TH_04_04 That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honour;
- 52 1TH 04 05 Not in the lust of concupiscence, even as the Gentiles which know not God:
- 52_1TH_04_06 That no [man] go beyond and defraud his brother in [any] matter: because that the Lord [is] the avenger of all such, as we also have forewarned you and testified.
- 52_1TH_04_07 For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness.
- 52 1TH 04 08 He therefore that despiseth, despiseth not man, but God, who hath also given unto us his holy Spirit.
- 52_1TH_04_09 But as touching brotherly love ye need not that I write unto you: for ye yourselves are taught of God to love one another.
- 52_1TH_04_10 And indeed ye do it toward all the brethren which are in all Macedonia: but we beseech you, brethren, that ye increase more and more;
- 52_1TH_04_11 And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you;
- 52_1TH_04_12 That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and [that] ye may have lack of nothing.
- 52_1TH_04_13 But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope.
- 52_1TH_04_14 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.
- 52_1TH_04_15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive [and] remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.
- 52_1TH_04_16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:
- 52_1TH_04_17 Then we which are alive [and] remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord.
- 52 1TH 04 18 Wherefore comfort one another with these words.



- 52_1TH_05_01 But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you.
- 52_1TH_05_02 For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night.
- 52_1TH_05_03 For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction cometh upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape.
- 52_1TH_05_04 But ye, brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief.
- 52 1TH 05 05 Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.
- 52 1TH 05 06 Therefore let us not sleep, as [do] others; but let us watch and be sober.
- 52 1TH 05 07 For they that sleep sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night.
- 52_1TH_05_08 But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; and for an helmet, the hope of salvation.
- 52 1TH 05 09 For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ,
- 52_1TH_05_10 Who died for us, that, whether we wake or sleep, we should live together with him.
- 52_1TH_05_11 Wherefore comfort yourselves together, and edify one another, even as also ye do.
- 52_1TH_05_12 And we be seech you, brethren, to know them which labour among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you;
- 52_1TH_05_13 And to esteem them very highly in love for their work's sake. [And] be at peace among yourselves.
- 52_1TH_05_14 Now we exhort you, brethren, warn them that are unruly, comfort the feebleminded, support the weak, be patient toward all [men].
- 52_1TH_05_15 See that none render evil for evil unto any [man]; but ever follow that which is good, both among yourselves, and to all [men].
- 52 1TH 05 16 Rejoice evermore.
- 52 1TH 05 17 Pray without ceasing.
- 52_1TH_05_18 In every thing give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- 52_1TH_05_19 Quench not the Spirit.
- 52_1TH_05_20 Despise not prophesyings.
- 52_1TH_05_21 Prove all things; hold fast that which is good.
- 52_1TH_05_22 Abstain from all appearance of evil.
- 52_1TH_05_23 And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and [I pray God] your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 52 1TH 05 24 Faithful [is] he that calleth you, who also will do [it].
- 52_1TH_05_25 Brethren, pray for us.
- 52_1TH_05_26 Greet all the brethren with an holy kiss.
- 52_1TH_05_27 I charge you by the Lord that this epistle be read unto all the holy brethren.
- 52_1TH_05_28 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ [be] with you. Amen.
