- 53\_2TH\_01\_01 Paul, and Silvanus, and Timotheus, unto the church of the Thessalonians in God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:
- 53\_2TH\_01\_02 Grace unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.
- 53\_2TH\_01\_03 We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is meet, because that your faith groweth exceedingly, and the charity of every one of you all toward each other aboundeth;
- 53\_2TH\_01\_04 So that we ourselves glory in you in the churches of God for your patience and faith in all your persecutions and tribulations that ye endure:
- 53\_2TH\_01\_05 [Which is] a manifest token of the righteous judgment of God, that ye may be counted worthy of the kingdom of God, for which ye also suffer:
- 53\_2TH\_01\_06 Seeing [it is] a righteous thing with God to recompense tribulation to them that trouble you;
- 53\_2TH\_01\_07 And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels,
- 53\_2TH\_01\_08 In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ:
- 53\_2TH\_01\_09 Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power;
- 53\_2TH\_01\_10 When he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe [because our testimony among you was believed] in that day.
- 53\_2TH\_01\_11 Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of [this] calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of [his] goodness, and the work of faith with power:

- 53\_2TH\_02\_01 Now we be seech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and [by] our gathering together unto him,
- 53\_2TH\_02\_02 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.
- 53\_2TH\_02\_03 Let no man deceive you by any means: for [that day shall not come], except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;
- 53\_2TH\_02\_04 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

- 53\_2TH\_02\_13 But we are bound to give thanks alway to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God hath from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth:
- 53 2TH 02 14 Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 53\_2TH\_02\_15 Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle.

- 53\_2TH\_03\_01 Finally, brethren, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may have [free] course, and be glorified, even as [it is] with you:
- 53 2TH 03 02 And that we may be delivered from unreasonable and wicked men: for all [men] have not faith.
- 53 2TH 03 03 But the Lord is faithful, who shall stablish you, and keep [you] from evil.
- 53\_2TH\_03\_04 And we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that ye both do and will do the things which we command you.
