**20\_PRO\_05\_01 My son, attend unto my wisdom, [and] bow thine ear to my understanding:**

**20\_PRO\_05\_02 That thou mayest regard discretion, and [that] thy lips may keep knowledge.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_03 For the lips of a strange woman drop [as] an honeycomb, and her mouth [is] smoother than oil:**

**20\_PRO\_05\_04 But her end is bitter as wormwood, sharp as a twoedged sword.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_05 Her feet go down to death; her steps take hold on hell.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_10 Lest strangers be filled with thy wealth; and thy labours [be] in the house of a stranger;**

**20\_PRO\_05\_11 And thou mourn at the last, when thy flesh and thy body are consumed,**

**20\_PRO\_05\_12 And say, How have I hated instruction, and my heart despised reproof;**

**20\_PRO\_05\_13 And have not obeyed the voice of my teachers, nor inclined mine ear to them that instructed me!**

**20\_PRO\_05\_14 I was almost in all evil in the midst of the congregation and assembly.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_15 Drink waters out of thine own cistern, and running waters out of thine own well.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_16 Let thy fountains be dispersed abroad, [and] rivers of waters in the streets.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_17 Let them be only thine own, and not strangers' with thee.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_18 Let thy fountain be blessed: and rejoice with the wife of thy youth.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_19 [Let her be as] the loving hind and pleasant roe; let her breasts satisfy thee at all times; and be thou ravished always with her love.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_20 And why wilt thou, my son, be ravished with a strange woman, and embrace the bosom of a stranger?**

**20\_PRO\_05\_21 For the ways of man [are] before the eyes of the LORD, and he pondereth all his goings.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_22 His own iniquities shall take the wicked himself, and he shall be holden with the cords of his sins.**

**20\_PRO\_05\_23 He shall die without instruction; and in the greatness of his folly he shall go astray.**
