

## **Complete KJV Holy Bible**

- 50\_PHP\_03\_01 Finally, my brethren, rejoice in the Lord. To write the same things to you, to me indeed [is] not grievous, but for you [it is] safe.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_02 Beware of dogs, beware of evil workers, beware of the concision.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_03 For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_04 Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. If any other man thinketh that he hath whereof he might trust in the flesh, I more:
- 50\_PHP\_03\_05 Circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, [of] the tribe of Benjamin, an Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee;
- 50 PHP 03 06 Concerning zeal, persecuting the church; touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.
- 50 PHP 03 07 But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_08 Yea doubtless, and I count all things [but] loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them [but] dung, that I may win Christ,
- 50\_PHP\_03\_09 And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith:
- 50\_PHP\_03\_10 That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death;
- 50 PHP 03 11 If by any means I might attain unto the resurrection of the dead.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_12 Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_13 Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but [this] one thing [I do], forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before,
- 50\_PHP\_03\_14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_15 Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, God shall reveal even this unto you.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_16 Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us mind the same thing.
- 50 PHP 03 17 Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.
- 50\_PHP\_03\_18 [For many walk, of whom I have told you often, and now tell you even weeping, [that they are] the enemies of the cross of Christ:
- 50\_PHP\_03\_19 Whose end [is] destruction, whose God [is their] belly, and [whose] glory [is] in their shame, who mind earthly things.]
- 50 PHP 03 20 For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ:
- 50\_PHP\_03\_21 Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.
