Daily Devotional 1 Year Bible

GEN_5:26 And Methuselah lived after he begat Lamech seven hundred eighty and two years, and begat sons and daughters:

GEN_5:27 And all the days of Methuselah were nine hundred sixty and nine years: and he died.

GEN_5:28 And Lamech lived an hundred eighty and two years, and begat a son:

GEN_5:29 And he called his name Noah, saying, This [same] shall comfort us concerning our work and toil of our hands, because of the ground which the LORD hath cursed.

GEN_5:30 And Lamech lived after he begat Noah five hundred ninety and five years, and begat sons and daughters:

GEN_5:31 And all the days of Lamech were seven hundred seventy and seven years: and he died.

GEN_5:32 And Noah was five hundred years old: and Noah begat Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

GEN_6:1 And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them,

GEN_6:2 That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they [were] fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose.

GEN_6:3 And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also [is] flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years.

GEN_6:4 There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare [children] to them, the same [became] mighty men which [were] of old, men of renown.

GEN_6:5 And God saw that the wickedness of man [was] great in the earth, and [that] every imagination of the thoughts of his heart [was] only evil continually.

GEN_6:6 And it repented the LORD that he had made man on the earth, and it grieved him at his heart.

GEN_6:7 And the LORD said, I will destroy man whom I have created from the face of the earth; both man, and beast, and the creeping thing, and the fowls of the air; for it repenteth me that I have made them.

GEN_6:8 But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD.

GEN_6:9 These [are] the generations of Noah: Noah was a just man [and] perfect in his generations, [and]

Noah walked with God.

GEN_6:10 And Noah begat three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth.

GEN_6:11 The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

GEN_6:12 And God looked upon the earth, and, behold, it was corrupt; for all flesh had corrupted his way upon the earth.

GEN_6:13 And God said unto Noah, The end of all flesh is come before me; for the earth is filled with violence through them; and, behold, I will destroy them with the earth.

GEN_6:14 Make thee an ark of gopher wood; rooms shalt thou make in the ark, and shalt pitch it within and without with pitch.

GEN_6:15 And this [is the fashion] which thou shalt make it [of]: The length of the ark [shall be] three hundred cubits, the breadth of it fifty cubits, and the height of it thirty cubits.

GEN_6:16 A window shalt thou make to the ark, and in a cubit shalt thou finish it above; and the door of the ark shalt thou set in the side thereof; [with] lower, second, and third [stories] shalt thou make it.

GEN_6:17 And, behold, I, even I, do bring a flood of waters upon the earth, to destroy all flesh, wherein [is] the breath of life, from under heaven; [and] every thing that [is] in the earth shall die.

GEN_6:18 But with thee will I establish my covenant; and thou shalt come into the ark, thou, and thy sons, and thy wife, and thy sons' wives with thee.

GEN_6:19 And of every living thing of all flesh, two of every [sort] shalt thou bring into the ark, to keep [them] alive with thee; they shall be male and female.

GEN_6:20 Of fowls after their kind, and of cattle after their kind, of every creeping thing of the earth after his kind, two of every [sort] shall come unto thee, to keep [them] alive.

GEN_6:21 And take thou unto thee of all food that is eaten, and thou shalt gather [it] to thee; and it shall be for food for thee, and for them.

GEN_6:22 Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he.

GEN_7:1 And the LORD said unto Noah, Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before me in this generation.

GEN_7:2 Of every clean beast thou shalt take to thee by sevens, the male and his female: and of beasts that [are] not clean by two, the male and his female.

GEN_7:3 Of fowls also of the air by sevens, the male and the female; to keep seed alive upon the face of all the earth.

GEN_7:4 For yet seven days, and I will cause it to rain upon the earth forty days and forty nights; and every living substance that I have made will I destroy from off the face of the earth.

GEN_7:5 And Noah did according unto all that the LORD commanded him.

GEN_7:6 And Noah [was] six hundred years old when the flood of waters was upon the earth.

GEN_7:7 And Noah went in, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him, into the ark, because

of the waters of the flood.

GEN_7:8 Of clean beasts, and of beasts that [are] not clean, and of fowls, and of every thing that creepeth upon the earth,

GEN_7:9 There went in two and two unto Noah into the ark, the male and the female, as God had commanded Noah.

GEN_7:10 And it came to pass after seven days, that the waters of the flood were upon the earth.

GEN_7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

GEN_7:12 And the rain was upon the earth forty days and forty nights.

GEN_7:13 In the selfsame day entered Noah, and Shem, and Ham, and Japheth, the sons of Noah, and Noah's wife, and the three wives of his sons with them, into the ark;

GEN_7:14 They, and every beast after his kind, and all the cattle after their kind, and every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth after his kind, and every fowl after his kind, every bird of every sort.

GEN_7:15 And they went in unto Noah into the ark, two and two of all flesh, wherein [is] the breath of life.

GEN_7:16 And they that went in, went in male and female of all flesh, as God had commanded him: and the LORD shut him in.

GEN_7:17 And the flood was forty days upon the earth; and the waters increased, and bare up the ark, and it was lift up above the earth.

GEN_7:18 And the waters prevailed, and were increased greatly upon the earth; and the ark went upon the face of the waters.

GEN_7:19 And the waters prevailed exceedingly upon the earth; and all the high hills, that [were] under the whole heaven, were covered.

GEN_7:20 Fifteen cubits upward did the waters prevail; and the mountains were covered.

GEN_7:21 And all flesh died that moved upon the earth, both of fowl, and of cattle, and of beast, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth, and every man:

GEN_7:22 All in whose nostrils [was] the breath of life, of all that [was] in the dry [land], died.

GEN_7:23 And every living substance was destroyed which was upon the face of the ground, both man, and cattle, and the creeping things, and the fowl of the heaven; and they were destroyed from the earth: and Noah only remained [alive], and they that [were] with him in the ark.

GEN_7:24 And the waters prevailed upon the earth an hundred and fifty days.

GEN_8:1 And God remembered Noah, and every living thing, and all the cattle that [was] with him in the ark: and God made a wind to pass over the earth, and the waters asswaged;

GEN_8:2 The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained;

GEN_8:3 And the waters returned from off the earth continually: and after the end of the hundred and

fifty days the waters were abated.

GEN_8:4 And the ark rested in the seventh month, on the seventeenth day of the month, upon the mountains of Ararat.

GEN_8:5 And the waters decreased continually until the tenth month: in the tenth [month], on the first [day] of the month, were the tops of the mountains seen.

GEN_8:6 And it came to pass at the end of forty days, that Noah opened the window of the ark which he had made:

GEN_8:7 And he sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth.

GEN_8:8 Also he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground;

GEN_8:9 But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters [were] on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

GEN_8:10 And he stayed yet other seven days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark;

MAT_2:18 In Rama was there a voice heard, lamentation, and weeping, and great mourning, Rachel weeping [for] her children, and would not be comforted, because they are not.

MAT_2:19 But when Herod was dead, behold, an angel of the Lord appeareth in a dream to Joseph in Egypt,

MAT_2:20 Saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and go into the land of Israel: for they are dead which sought the young child's life.

MAT_2:21 And he arose, and took the young child and his mother, and came into the land of Israel.

MAT_2:22 But when he heard that Archelaus did reign in Judaea in the room of his father Herod, he was afraid to go thither: notwithstanding, being warned of God in a dream, he turned aside into the parts of Galilee:

MAT_2:23 And he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets, He shall be called a Nazarene.

MAT_3:1 In those days came John the Baptist, preaching in the wilderness of Judaea,

MAT_3:2 And saying, Repent ye: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.

MAT_3:3 For this is he that was spoken of by the prophet Esaias, saying, The voice of one crying in the wilderness, Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight.

MAT_3:4 And the same John had his raiment of camel's hair, and a leathern girdle about his loins; and his meat was locusts and wild honey.

MAT_3:5 Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan,

MAT_3:6 And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins.

MAT_3:7 But when he saw many of the Pharisees and Sadducees come to his baptism, he said unto them, O generation of vipers, who hath warned you to flee from the wrath to come?

MAT_3:8 Bring forth therefore fruits meet for repentance:

MAT_3:9 And think not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to [our] father: for I say unto you, that God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham.

MAT_3:10 And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

MAT_3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and [with] fire:

MAT_3:12 Whose fan [is] in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

MAT_3:13 Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him.

MAT_3:14 But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?

MAT_3:15 And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer [it to be so] now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him.

PSA_2:9 Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel.

PSA_2:10 Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed, ye judges of the earth.

PSA_2:11 Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling.

PSA_2:12 Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish [from] the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed [are] all they that put their trust in him.

PSA_3:1 A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son. LORD, how are they increased that trouble me! many [are] they that rise up against me.

PSA_3:2 Many [there be] which say of my soul, [There is] no help for him in God. Selah.

PSA_3:3 But thou, O LORD, [art] a shield for me; my glory, and the lifter up of mine head.

PRO_1:6 To understand a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings.

PRO_1:7 The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of knowledge: [but] fools despise wisdom and instruction.

MATJ_5:12 Rejoice, and be exceeding glad: for great [is] your reward in heaven: for so persecuted they the prophets which were before you.

MATJ_5:13 Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.

MATJ_5:14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid.

MATJ_5:15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house.

MATJ_5:16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
