## Daily Devotional 1 Year Bible

**GEN\_8:11** And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth [was] an olive leaf plucked off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.

**GEN\_8:12** And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again unto him any more.

**GEN\_8:13** And it came to pass in the six hundredth and first year, in the first [month], the first [day] of the month, the waters were dried up from off the earth: and Noah removed the covering of the ark, and looked, and, behold, the face of the ground was dry.

**GEN\_8:14** And in the second month, on the seven and twentieth day of the month, was the earth dried.

**GEN\_8:15** And God spake unto Noah, saying,

**GEN\_8:16** Go forth of the ark, thou, and thy wife, and thy sons, and thy sons' wives with thee.

**GEN\_8:17** Bring forth with thee every living thing that [is] with thee, of all flesh, [both] of fowl, and of cattle, and of every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth; that they may breed abundantly in the earth, and be fruitful, and multiply upon the earth.

**GEN\_8:18** And Noah went forth, and his sons, and his wife, and his sons' wives with him:

**GEN\_8:19** Every beast, every creeping thing, and every fowl, [and] whatsoever creepeth upon the earth, after their kinds, went forth out of the ark.

**GEN\_8:20** And Noah builded an altar unto the LORD; and took of every clean beast, and of every clean fowl, and offered burnt offerings on the altar.

**GEN\_8:21** And the LORD smelled a sweet savour; and the LORD said in his heart, I will not again curse the ground any more for man's sake; for the imagination of man's heart [is] evil from his youth; neither will I again smite any more every thing living, as I have done.

**GEN\_8:22** While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.

**GEN\_9:1** And God blessed Noah and his sons, and said unto them, Be fruitful, and multiply, and replenish the earth.

**GEN\_9:2** And the fear of you and the dread of you shall be upon every beast of the earth, and upon every fowl of the air, upon all that moveth [upon] the earth, and upon all the fishes of the sea; into your hand are they delivered.

**GEN\_9:3 Every moving thing that liveth shall be meat for you; even as the green herb have I given you all things.**

**GEN\_9:4 But flesh with the life thereof, [which is] the blood thereof, shall ye not eat.**

**GEN\_9:5 And surely your blood of your lives will I require; at the hand of every beast will I require it, and at the hand of man; at the hand of every man's brother will I require the life of man.**

**GEN\_9:6 Whoso sheddeth man's blood, by man shall his blood be shed: for in the image of God made he man.**

**GEN\_9:7 And you, be ye fruitful, and multiply; bring forth abundantly in the earth, and multiply therein.**

**GEN\_9:8 And God spake unto Noah, and to his sons with him, saying,**

**GEN\_9:9 And I, behold, I establish my covenant with you, and with your seed after you;**

**GEN\_9:10 And with every living creature that [is] with you, of the fowl, of the cattle, and of every beast of the earth with you; from all that go out of the ark, to every beast of the earth.**

**GEN\_9:11 And I will establish my covenant with you; neither shall all flesh be cut off any more by the waters of a flood; neither shall there any more be a flood to destroy the earth.**

**GEN\_9:12 And God said, This [is] the token of the covenant which I make between me and you and every living creature that [is] with you, for perpetual generations:**

**GEN\_9:13 I do set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a token of a covenant between me and the earth.**

**GEN\_9:14 And it shall come to pass, when I bring a cloud over the earth, that the bow shall be seen in the cloud:**

**GEN\_9:15 And I will remember my covenant, which [is] between me and you and every living creature of all flesh; and the waters shall no more become a flood to destroy all flesh.**

**GEN\_9:16 And the bow shall be in the cloud; and I will look upon it, that I may remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that [is] upon the earth.**

**GEN\_9:17 And God said unto Noah, This [is] the token of the covenant, which I have established between me and all flesh that [is] upon the earth.**

**GEN\_9:18 And the sons of Noah, that went forth of the ark, were Shem, and Ham, and Japheth: and Ham [is] the father of Canaan.**

**GEN\_9:19 These [are] the three sons of Noah: and of them was the whole earth overspread.**

**GEN\_9:20 And Noah began [to be] an husbandman, and he planted a vineyard:**

**GEN\_9:21 And he drank of the wine, and was drunken; and he was uncovered within his tent.**

**GEN\_9:22 And Ham, the father of Canaan, saw the nakedness of his father, and told his two brethren without.**

**GEN\_9:23 And Shem and Japheth took a garment, and laid [it] upon both their shoulders, and went backward, and covered the nakedness of their father; and their faces [were] backward, and they saw not**

**their father's nakedness.**

**GEN\_9:24 And Noah awoke from his wine, and knew what his younger son had done unto him.**

**GEN\_9:25 And he said, Cursed [be] Canaan; a servant of servants shall he be unto his brethren.**

**GEN\_9:26 And he said, Blessed [be] the LORD God of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.**

**GEN\_9:27 God shall enlarge Japheth, and he shall dwell in the tents of Shem; and Canaan shall be his servant.**

**GEN\_9:28 And Noah lived after the flood three hundred and fifty years.**

**GEN\_9:29 And all the days of Noah were nine hundred and fifty years: and he died.**

**GEN\_10:1 Now these [are] the generations of the sons of Noah, Shem, Ham, and Japheth: and unto them were sons born after the flood.**

**GEN\_10:2 The sons of Japheth; Gomer, and Magog, and Madai, and Javan, and Tubal, and Meshech, and Tiras.**

**GEN\_10:3 And the sons of Gomer; Ashkenaz, and Riphath, and Togarmah.**

**GEN\_10:4 And the sons of Javan; Elishah, and Tarshish, Kittim, and Dodanim.**

**GEN\_10:5 By these were the isles of the Gentiles divided in their lands; every one after his tongue, after their families, in their nations.**

**GEN\_10:6 And the sons of Ham; Cush, and Mizraim, and Phut, and Canaan.**

**GEN\_10:7 And the sons of Cush; Seba, and Havilah, and Sabtah, and Raamah, and Sabtechah: and the sons of Raamah; Sheba, and Dedan.**

**GEN\_10:8 And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth.**

**GEN\_10:9 He was a mighty hunter before the LORD: wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the LORD.**

**GEN\_10:10 And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.**

**GEN\_10:11 Out of that land went forth Asshur, and builded Nineveh, and the city Rehoboth, and Calah,**

**GEN\_10:12 And Resen between Nineveh and Calah: the same [is] a great city.**

**GEN\_10:13 And Mizraim begat Ludim, and Anamim, and Lehabim, and Naphtuhim,**

**GEN\_10:14 And Pathrusim, and Casluhim, (out of whom came Philistim,) and Caphtorim.**

**GEN\_10:15 And Canaan begat Sidon his firstborn, and Heth,**

**GEN\_10:16 And the Jebusite, and the Amorite, and the Girgasite,**

**GEN\_10:17 And the Hivite, and the Arkite, and the Sinite,**

**GEN\_10:18** And the Arvadite, and the Zemarite, and the Hamathite: and afterward were the families of the Canaanites spread abroad.

**GEN\_10:19** And the border of the Canaanites was from Sidon, as thou comest to Gerar, unto Gaza; as thou goest, unto Sodom, and Gomorrah, and Admah, and Zeboim, even unto Lasha.

**GEN\_10:20** These [are] the sons of Ham, after their families, after their tongues, in their countries, [and] in their nations.

**GEN\_10:21** Unto Shem also, the father of all the children of Eber, the brother of Japheth the elder, even to him were [children] born.

**GEN\_10:22** The children of Shem; Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram.

**GEN\_10:23** And the children of Aram; Uz, and Hul, and Gether, and Mash.

**GEN\_10:24** And Arphaxad begat Salah; and Salah begat Eber.

**GEN\_10:25** And unto Eber were born two sons: the name of one [was] Peleg; for in his days was the earth divided; and his brother's name [was] Joktan.

**GEN\_10:26** And Joktan begat Almodad, and Sheleph, and Hazarmaveth, and Jerah,

**GEN\_10:27** And Hadoram, and Uzal, and Diklah,

**GEN\_10:28** And Obal, and Abimael, and Sheba,

**GEN\_10:29** And Ophir, and Havilah, and Jobab: all these [were] the sons of Joktan.

**GEN\_10:30** And their dwelling was from Mesha, as thou goest unto Sephar a mount of the east.

**GEN\_10:31** These [are] the sons of Shem, after their families, after their tongues, in their lands, after their nations.

**GEN\_10:32** These [are] the families of the sons of Noah, after their generations, in their nations: and by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood.

**MAT\_3:16** And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

**MAT\_3:17** And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

**MAT\_4:1** Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

**MAT\_4:2** And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungered.

**MAT\_4:3** And when the tempter came to him, he said, If thou be the Son of God, command that these stones be made bread.

**MAT\_4:4** But he answered and said, It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God.

**MAT\_4:5** Then the devil taketh him up into the holy city, and setteth him on a pinnacle of the temple,

**MAT\_4:6** And saith unto him, If thou be the Son of God, cast thyself down: for it is written, He shall give

**his angels charge concerning thee: and in [their] hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone.**

**MAT\_4:7 Jesus said unto him, It is written again, Thou shalt not tempt the Lord thy God.**

**MAT\_4:8 Again, the devil taketh him up into an exceeding high mountain, and sheweth him all the kingdoms of the world, and the glory of them;**

**MAT\_4:9 And saith unto him, All these things will I give thee, if thou wilt fall down and worship me.**

**MAT\_4:10 Then saith Jesus unto him, Get thee hence, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.**

**MAT\_4:11 Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.**

**MAT\_4:12 Now when Jesus had heard that John was cast into prison, he departed into Galilee;**

**MAT\_4:13 And leaving Nazareth, he came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is upon the sea coast, in the borders of Zabulon and Nephthalim:**

**MAT\_4:14 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying,**

**MAT\_4:15 The land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephthalim, [by] the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles;**

**MAT\_4:16 The people which sat in darkness saw great light; and to them which sat in the region and shadow of death light is sprung up.**

**MAT\_4:17 From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**

**MAT\_4:18 And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.**

**MAT\_4:19 And he saith unto them, Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men.**

**MAT\_4:20 And they straightway left [their] nets, and followed him.**

**MAT\_4:21 And going on from thence, he saw other two brethren, James [the son] of Zebedee, and John his brother, in a ship with Zebedee their father, mending their nets; and he called them.**

**PSA\_3:4 I cried unto the LORD with my voice, and he heard me out of his holy hill. Selah.**

**PSA\_3:5 I laid me down and slept; I awaked; for the LORD sustained me.**

**PSA\_3:6 I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people, that have set [themselves] against me round about.**

**PSA\_3:7 Arise, O LORD; save me, O my God: for thou hast smitten all mine enemies [upon] the cheek bone; thou hast broken the teeth of the ungodly.**

**PSA\_3:8 Salvation [belongeth] unto the LORD: thy blessing [is] upon thy people. Selah.**

**PSA\_4:1 To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm of David. Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me [when I was] in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.**

**PRO\_1:8 My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother:**

**PRO\_1:9 For they [shall be] an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck.**

**PRO\_1:10 My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not.**

**MATJ\_5:17 Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.**

**MATJ\_5:18 For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled.**

**MATJ\_5:19 Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach [them], the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.**

**MATJ\_5:20 For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed [the righteousness] of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.**
