## **Daily Devotional 1 Year Bible**

- GEN\_45:3 And Joseph said unto his brethren, I [am] Joseph; doth my father yet live? And his brethren could not answer him; for they were troubled at his presence.
- GEN\_45:4 And Joseph said unto his brethren, Come near to me, I pray you. And they came near. And he said, I [am] Joseph your brother, whom ye sold into Egypt.
- GEN\_45:5 Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life.
- GEN\_45:6 For these two years [hath] the famine [been] in the land: and yet [there are] five years, in the which [there shall] neither [be] earing nor harvest.
- GEN\_45:7 And God sent me before you to preserve you a posterity in the earth, and to save your lives by a great deliverance.
- GEN\_45:8 So now [it was] not you [that] sent me hither, but God: and he hath made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house, and a ruler throughout all the land of Egypt.
- GEN\_45:9 Haste ye, and go up to my father, and say unto him, Thus saith thy son Joseph, God hath made me lord of all Egypt: come down unto me, tarry not:
- GEN\_45:10 And thou shalt dwell in the land of Goshen, and thou shalt be near unto me, thou, and thy children, and thy children, and thy flocks, and thy herds, and all that thou hast:
- GEN\_45:11 And there will I nourish thee; for yet [there are] five years of famine; lest thou, and thy household, and all that thou hast, come to poverty.
- GEN\_45:12 And, behold, your eyes see, and the eyes of my brother Benjamin, that [it is] my mouth that speaketh unto you.
- GEN\_45:13 And ye shall tell my father of all my glory in Egypt, and of all that ye have seen; and ye shall haste and bring down my father hither.
- GEN\_45:14 And he fell upon his brother Benjamin's neck, and wept; and Benjamin wept upon his neck.
- GEN\_45:15 Moreover he kissed all his brethren, and wept upon them: and after that his brethren talked with him.
- GEN\_45:16 And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

- GEN\_45:17 And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Say unto thy brethren, This do ye; lade your beasts, and go, get you unto the land of Canaan;
- GEN\_45:18 And take your father and your households, and come unto me: and I will give you the good of the land of Egypt, and ye shall eat the fat of the land.
- GEN\_45:19 Now thou art commanded, this do ye; take you wagons out of the land of Egypt for your little ones, and for your wives, and bring your father, and come.
- GEN\_45:20 Also regard not your stuff; for the good of all the land of Egypt [is] yours.
- GEN\_45:21 And the children of Israel did so: and Joseph gave them wagons, according to the commandment of Pharaoh, and gave them provision for the way.
- GEN\_45:22 To all of them he gave each man changes of raiment; but to Benjamin he gave three hundred [pieces] of silver, and five changes of raiment.
- GEN\_45:23 And to his father he sent after this [manner]; ten asses laden with the good things of Egypt, and ten she asses laden with corn and bread and meat for his father by the way.
- GEN\_45:24 So he sent his brethren away, and they departed: and he said unto them, See that ye fall not out by the way.
- GEN\_45:25 And they went up out of Egypt, and came into the land of Canaan unto Jacob their father,
- GEN\_45:26 And told him, saying, Joseph [is] yet alive, and he [is] governor over all the land of Egypt. And Jacob's heart fainted, for he believed them not.
- GEN\_45:27 And they told him all the words of Joseph, which he had said unto them: and when he saw the wagons which Joseph had sent to carry him, the spirit of Jacob their father revived:
- GEN\_45:28 And Israel said, [It is] enough; Joseph my son [is] yet alive: I will go and see him before I die.
- GEN\_46:1 And Israel took his journey with all that he had, and came to Beersheba, and offered sacrifices unto the God of his father Isaac.
- GEN\_46:2 And God spake unto Israel in the visions of the night, and said, Jacob, Jacob. And he said, Here [am] I.
- GEN\_46:3 And he said, I [am] God, the God of thy father: fear not to go down into Egypt; for I will there make of thee a great nation:
- GEN\_46:4 I will go down with thee into Egypt; and I will also surely bring thee up [again]: and Joseph shall put his hand upon thine eyes.
- GEN\_46:5 And Jacob rose up from Beersheba: and the sons of Israel carried Jacob their father, and their little ones, and their wives, in the wagons which Pharaoh had sent to carry him.
- GEN\_46:6 And they took their cattle, and their goods, which they had gotten in the land of Canaan, and came into Egypt, Jacob, and all his seed with him:
- GEN\_46:7 His sons, and his sons' sons with him, his daughters, and his sons' daughters, and all his seed brought he with him into Egypt.
- GEN\_46:8 And these [are] the names of the children of Israel, which came into Egypt, Jacob and his sons:

Reuben, Jacob's firstborn.

GEN\_46:9 And the sons of Reuben; Hanoch, and Phallu, and Hezron, and Carmi.

GEN\_46:10 And the sons of Simeon; Jemuel, and Jamin, and Ohad, and Jachin, and Zohar, and Shaul the son of a Canaanitish woman.

GEN\_46:11 And the sons of Levi; Gershon, Kohath, and Merari.

GEN\_46:12 And the sons of Judah; Er, and Onan, and Shelah, and Pharez, and Zarah: but Er and Onan died in the land of Canaan. And the sons of Pharez were Hezron and Hamul.

GEN\_46:13 And the sons of Issachar; Tola, and Phuvah, and Job, and Shimron.

GEN\_46:14 And the sons of Zebulun; Sered, and Elon, and Jahleel.

GEN\_46:15 These [be] the sons of Leah, which she bare unto Jacob in Padanaram, with his daughter Dinah: all the souls of his sons and his daughters [were] thirty and three.

GEN\_46:16 And the sons of Gad; Ziphion, and Haggi, Shuni, and Ezbon, Eri, and Arodi, and Areli.

GEN\_46:17 And the sons of Asher; Jimnah, and Ishuah, and Isui, and Beriah, and Serah their sister: and the sons of Beriah; Heber, and Malchiel.

GEN\_46:18 These [are] the sons of Zilpah, whom Laban gave to Leah his daughter, and these she bare unto Jacob, [even] sixteen souls.

GEN\_46:19 The sons of Rachel Jacob's wife; Joseph, and Benjamin.

GEN\_46:20 And unto Joseph in the land of Egypt were born Manasseh and Ephraim, which Asenath the daughter of Potipherah priest of On bare unto him.

GEN\_46:21 And the sons of Benjamin [were] Belah, and Becher, and Ashbel, Gera, and Naaman, Ehi, and Rosh, Muppim, and Huppim, and Ard.

GEN\_46:22 These [are] the sons of Rachel, which were born to Jacob: all the souls [were] fourteen.

GEN\_46:23 And the sons of Dan; Hushim.

GEN\_46:24 And the sons of Naphtali; Jahzeel, and Guni, and Jezer, and Shillem.

GEN\_46:25 These [are] the sons of Bilhah, which Laban gave unto Rachel his daughter, and she bare these unto Jacob: all the souls [were] seven.

GEN\_46:26 All the souls that came with Jacob into Egypt, which came out of his loins, besides Jacob's sons' wives, all the souls [were] threescore and six;

GEN\_46:27 And the sons of Joseph, which were born him in Egypt, [were] two souls: all the souls of the house of Jacob, which came into Egypt, [were] threescore and ten.

GEN\_46:28 And he sent Judah before him unto Joseph, to direct his face unto Goshen; and they came into the land of Goshen.

GEN\_46:29 And Joseph made ready his chariot, and went up to meet Israel his father, to Goshen, and presented himself unto him; and he fell on his neck, and wept on his neck a good while.

GEN\_46:30 And Israel said unto Joseph, Now let me die, since I have seen thy face, because thou [art] yet alive.

GEN\_46:31 And Joseph said unto his brethren, and unto his father's house, I will go up, and show Pharaoh, and say unto him, My brethren, and my father's house, which [were] in the land of Canaan, are come unto me;

GEN\_46:32 And the men [are] shepherds, for their trade hath been to feed cattle; and they have brought their flocks, and their herds, and all that they have.

GEN\_46:33 And it shall come to pass, when Pharaoh shall call you, and shall say, What [is] your occupation?

GEN\_46:34 That ye shall say, Thy servants' trade hath been about cattle from our youth even until now, both we, [and] also our fathers: that ye may dwell in the land of Goshen; for every shepherd [is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

GEN\_47:1 Then Joseph came and told Pharaoh, and said, My father and my brethren, and their flocks, and their herds, and all that they have, are come out of the land of Canaan; and, behold, they [are] in the land of Goshen.

GEN\_47:2 And he took some of his brethren, [even] five men, and presented them unto Pharaoh.

MAT\_14:23 And when he had sent the multitudes away, he went up into a mountain apart to pray: and when the evening was come, he was there alone.

MAT\_14:24 But the ship was now in the midst of the sea, tossed with waves: for the wind was contrary.

MAT\_14:25 And in the fourth watch of the night Jesus went unto them, walking on the sea.

MAT\_14:26 And when the disciples saw him walking on the sea, they were troubled, saying, It is a spirit; and they cried out for fear.

MAT\_14:27 But straightway Jesus spake unto them, saying, Be of good cheer; it is I; be not afraid.

MAT\_14:28 And Peter answered him and said, Lord, if it be thou, bid me come unto thee on the water.

MAT\_14:29 And he said, Come. And when Peter was come down out of the ship, he walked on the water, to go to Jesus.

MAT\_14:30 But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.

MAT\_14:31 And immediately Jesus stretched forth [his] hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?

MAT\_14:32 And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased.

MAT\_14:33 Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.

MAT\_14:34 And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret.

MAT\_14:35 And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country

round about, and brought unto him all that were diseased;

MAT\_14:36 And besought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.

MAT\_15:1 Then came to Jesus scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying,

MAT\_15:2 Why do thy disciples transgress the tradition of the elders? for they wash not their hands when they eat bread.

MAT\_15:3 But he answered and said unto them, Why do ye also transgress the commandment of God by your tradition?

MAT\_15:4 For God commanded, saying, Honour thy father and mother: and, He that curseth father or mother, let him die the death.

MAT\_15:5 But ye say, Whosoever shall say to [his] father or [his] mother, [It is] a gift, by whatsoever thou mightest be profited by me;

MAT\_15:6 And honour not his father or his mother, [he shall be free]. Thus have ye made the commandment of God of none effect by your tradition.

MAT\_15:7 [Ye] hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying,

MAT\_15:8 This people draweth nigh unto me with their mouth, and honoureth me with [their] lips; but their heart is far from me.

MAT\_15:9 But in vain they do worship me, teaching [for] doctrines the commandments of men.

MAT\_15:10 And he called the multitude, and said unto them, Hear, and understand:

MAT\_15:11 Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man; but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man.

PSA\_13:5 But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation.

PSA 13:6 I will sing unto the LORD, because he hath dealt bountifully with me.

PSA\_14:1 To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, [there is] none that doeth good.

PSA\_14:2 The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, [and] seek God.

PSA\_14:3 They are all gone aside, they are [all] together become filthy: [there is] none that doeth good, no, not one.

PSA\_14:4 Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people [as] they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.

PRO\_3:5 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.

PRO\_3:6 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

PRO\_3:7 Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.

MATJ\_8:12 But the children of the kingdom shall be cast out into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

MATJ\_8:13 Go thy way; and as thou hast believed, [so] be it done unto thee.

MATJ\_8:20 The foxes have holes, and the birds of the air [have] nests; but the Son of man hath not where to lay [his] head.

MATJ\_8:22 Follow me; and let the dead bury their dead.

MATJ\_8:26 Why are ye fearful, O ye of little faith?

MATJ\_9:2 Son, be of good cheer; thy sins be forgiven thee.

MATJ\_9:4 Wherefore think ye evil in your hearts?

MATJ\_9:5 For whether is easier, to say, [Thy] sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and walk?
