Daily Devotional 1 Year Bible

1KI_2:21 And she said, Let Abishag the Shunammite be given to Adonijah thy brother to wife.

1KI_2:22 And king Solomon answered and said unto his mother, And why dost thou ask Abishag the Shunammite for Adonijah? ask for him the kingdom also; for he [is] mine elder brother; even for him, and for Abiathar the priest, and for Joab the son of Zeruiah.

1KI_2:23 Then king Solomon sware by the LORD, saying, God do so to me, and more also, if Adonijah have not spoken this word against his own life.

1KI_2:24 Now therefore, [as] the LORD liveth, which hath established me, and set me on the throne of David my father, and who hath made me an house, as he promised, Adonijah shall be put to death this day.

1KI_2:25 And king Solomon sent by the hand of Benaiah the son of Jehoiada; and he fell upon him that he died.

1KI_2:26 And unto Abiathar the priest said the king, Get thee to Anathoth, unto thine own fields; for thou [art] worthy of death: but I will not at this time put thee to death, because thou barest the ark of the Lord GOD before David my father, and because thou hast been afflicted in all wherein my father was afflicted.

1KI_2:27 So Solomon thrust out Abiathar from being priest unto the LORD; that he might fulfil the word of the LORD, which he spake concerning the house of Eli in Shiloh.

1KI_2:28 Then tidings came to Joab: for Joab had turned after Adonijah, though he turned not after Absalom. And Joab fled unto the tabernacle of the LORD, and caught hold on the horns of the altar.

1KI_2:29 And it was told king Solomon that Joab was fled unto the tabernacle of the LORD; and, behold, [he is] by the altar. Then Solomon sent Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, saying, Go, fall upon him.

1KI_2:30 And Benaiah came to the tabernacle of the LORD, and said unto him, Thus saith the king, Come forth. And he said, Nay; but I will die here. And Benaiah brought the king word again, saying, Thus said Joab, and thus he answered me.

1KI_2:31 And the king said unto him, Do as he hath said, and fall upon him, and bury him; that thou mayest take away the innocent blood, which Joab shed, from me, and from the house of my father.

1KI_2:32 And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing [thereof, to wit], Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah.

1KI_2:33 Their blood shall therefore return upon the head of Joab, and upon the head of his seed for ever: but upon David, and upon his seed, and upon his house, and upon his throne, shall there be peace for ever

from the LORD.

1KI_2:34 So Benaiah the son of Jehoiada went up, and fell upon him, and slew him: and he was buried in his own house in the wilderness.

1KI_2:35 And the king put Benaiah the son of Jehoiada in his room over the host: and Zadok the priest did the king put in the room of Abiathar.

1KI_2:36 And the king sent and called for Shimei, and said unto him, Build thee an house in Jerusalem, and dwell there, and go not forth thence any whither.

1KI_2:37 For it shall be, [that] on the day thou goest out, and passest over the brook Kidron, thou shalt know for certain that thou shalt surely die: thy blood shall be upon thine own head.

1KI_2:38 And Shimei said unto the king, The saying [is] good: as my lord the king hath said, so will thy servant do. And Shimei dwelt in Jerusalem many days.

1KI_2:39 And it came to pass at the end of three years, that two of the servants of Shimei ran away unto Achish son of Maachah king of Gath. And they told Shimei, saying, Behold, thy servants [be] in Gath.

1KI_2:40 And Shimei arose, and saddled his ass, and went to Gath to Achish to seek his servants: and Shimei went, and brought his servants from Gath.

1KI_2:41 And it was told Solomon that Shimei had gone from Jerusalem to Gath, and was come again.

1KI_2:42 And the king sent and called for Shimei, and said unto him, Did I not make thee to swear by the LORD, and protested unto thee, saying, Know for a certain, on the day thou goest out, and walkest abroad any whither, that thou shalt surely die? and thou saidst unto me, The word [that] I have heard [is] good.

1KI_2:43 Why then hast thou not kept the oath of the LORD, and the commandment that I have charged thee with?

1KI_2:44 The king said moreover to Shimei, Thou knowest all the wickedness which thine heart is privy to, that thou didst to David my father: therefore the LORD shall return thy wickedness upon thine own head;

1KI_2:45 And king Solomon [shall be] blessed, and the throne of David shall be established before the LORD for ever.

1KI_2:46 So the king commanded Benaiah the son of Jehoiada; which went out, and fell upon him, that he died. And the kingdom was established in the hand of Solomon.

1KI_3:1 And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

1KI_3:2 Only the people sacrificed in high places, because there was no house built unto the name of the LORD, until those days.

1KI_3:3 And Solomon loved the LORD, walking in the statutes of David his father: only he sacrificed and burnt incense in high places.

1KI_3:4 And the king went to Gibeon to sacrifice there; for that [was] the great high place: a thousand burnt offerings did Solomon offer upon that altar.

1KI_3:5 In Gibeon the LORD appeared to Solomon in a dream by night: and God said, Ask what I shall

give thee.

1KI_3:6 And Solomon said, Thou hast showed unto thy servant David my father great mercy, according as he walked before thee in truth, and in righteousness, and in uprightness of heart with thee; and thou hast kept for him this great kindness, that thou hast given him a son to sit on his throne, as [it is] this day.

1KI_3:7 And now, O LORD my God, thou hast made thy servant king instead of David my father: and I [am but] a little child: I know not [how] to go out or come in.

1KI_3:8 And thy servant [is] in the midst of thy people which thou hast chosen, a great people, that cannot be numbered nor counted for multitude.

1KI_3:9 Give therefore thy servant an understanding heart to judge thy people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this thy so great a people?

1KI_3:10 And the speech pleased the Lord, that Solomon had asked this thing.

1KI_3:11 And God said unto him, Because thou hast asked this thing, and hast not asked for thyself long life; neither hast asked riches for thyself, nor hast asked the life of thine enemies; but hast asked for thyself understanding to discern judgment;

1KI_3:12 Behold, I have done according to thy words: lo, I have given thee a wise and an understanding heart; so that there was none like thee before thee, neither after thee shall any arise like unto thee.

1KI_3:13 And I have also given thee that which thou hast not asked, both riches, and honour: so that there shall not be any among the kings like unto thee all thy days.

1KI_3:14 And if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as thy father David did walk, then I will lengthen thy days.

1KI_3:15 And Solomon awoke; and, behold, [it was] a dream. And he came to Jerusalem, and stood before the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and offered up burnt offerings, and offered peace offerings, and made a feast to all his servants.

1KI_3:16 Then came there two women, [that were] harlots, unto the king, and stood before him.

1KI_3:17 And the one woman said, O my lord, I and this woman dwell in one house; and I was delivered of a child with her in the house.

1KI_3:18 And it came to pass the third day after that I was delivered, that this woman was delivered also: and we [were] together; [there was] no stranger with us in the house, save we two in the house.

1KI_3:19 And this woman's child died in the night; because she overlaid it.

1KI_3:20 And she arose at midnight, and took my son from beside me, while thine handmaid slept, and laid it in her bosom, and laid her dead child in my bosom.

1KI_3:21 And when I rose in the morning to give my child suck, behold, it was dead: but when I had considered it in the morning, behold, it was not my son, which I did bear.

1KI_3:22 And the other woman said, Nay; but the living [is] my son, and the dead [is] thy son. And this said, No; but the dead [is] thy son, and the living [is] my son. Thus they spake before the king.

JOH_13:37 Peter said unto him, Lord, why cannot I follow thee now? I will lay down my life for thy sake.

JOH_13:38 Jesus answered him, Wilt thou lay down thy life for my sake? Verily, verily, I say unto thee, The cock shall not crow, till thou hast denied me thrice.

JOH_14:1 Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

JOH_14:2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if [it were] not [so], I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

JOH_14:3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, [there] ye may be also.

JOH_14:4 And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know.

JOH_14:5 Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way?

JOH_14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

JOH_14:7 If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.

JOH_14:8 Philip saith unto him, Lord, shew us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

JOH_14:9 Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou [then], Shew us the Father?

JOH_14:10 Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.

JOH_14:11 Believe me that I [am] in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake.

JOH_14:12 Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater [works] than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

JOH_14:13 And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

JOH_14:14 If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do [it].

JOH_14:15 If ye love me, keep my commandments.

JOH_14:16 And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

JOH_14:17 [Even] the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you.

JOH_14:18 I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you.

JOH_14:19 Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also.

JOH_14:20 At that day ye shall know that I [am] in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you.

JOH_14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.

PSA_69:22 Let their table become a snare before them: and [that which should have been] for [their] welfare, [let it become] a trap.

PSA_69:23 Let their eyes be darkened, that they see not; and make their loins continually to shake.

PSA_69:24 Pour out thine indignation upon them, and let thy wrathful anger take hold of them.

PSA_69:25 Let their habitation be desolate; [and] let none dwell in their tents.

PSA_69:26 For they persecute [him] whom thou hast smitten; and they talk to the grief of those whom thou hast wounded.

PSA_69:27 Add iniquity unto their iniquity: and let them not come into thy righteousness.

PSA_69:28 Let them be blotted out of the book of the living, and not be written with the righteous.

PRO_15:9 The way of the wicked [is] an abomination unto the LORD: but he loveth him that followeth after righteousness.

PRO_15:10 Correction [is] grievous unto him that forsaketh the way: [and] he that hateth reproof shall die.

MARJ_13:27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.

MARJ_13:28 Now learn a parable of the fig tree; When her branch is yet tender, and putteth forth leaves, ye know that summer is near:

MARJ_13:29 So ye in like manner, when ye shall see these things come to pass, know that it is nigh, [even] at the doors.

MARJ_13:30 Verily I say unto you, that this generation shall not pass, till all these things be done.

MARJ_13:31 Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away.
