Daily Devotional 1 Year Bible

1KI_10:25 And they brought every man his present, vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and garments, and armour, and spices, horses, and mules, a rate year by year.

1KI_10:26 And Solomon gathered together chariots and horsemen: and he had a thousand and four hundred chariots, and twelve thousand horsemen, whom he bestowed in the cities for chariots, and with the king at Jerusalem.

1KI_10:27 And the king made silver [to be] in Jerusalem as stones, and cedars made he [to be] as the sycamore trees that [are] in the vale, for abundance.

1KI_10:28 And Solomon had horses brought out of Egypt, and linen yarn: the king's merchants received the linen yarn at a price.

1KI_10:29 And a chariot came up and went out of Egypt for six hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, did they bring [them] out by their means.

1KI_11:1 But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

1KI_11:2 Of the nations [concerning] which the LORD said unto the children of Israel, Ye shall not go in to them, neither shall they come in unto you: [for] surely they will turn away your heart after their gods: Solomon clave unto these in love.

1KI_11:3 And he had seven hundred wives, princesses, and three hundred concubines: and his wives turned away his heart.

1KI_11:4 For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, [that] his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as [was] the heart of David his father.

1KI_11:5 For Solomon went after Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, and after Milcom the abomination of the Ammonites.

1KI_11:6 And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as [did] David his father.

1KI_11:7 Then did Solomon build an high place for Chemosh, the abomination of Moab, in the hill that [is] before Jerusalem, and for Molech, the abomination of the children of Ammon.

1KI_11:8 And likewise did he for all his strange wives, which burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods.

1KI_11:9 And the LORD was angry with Solomon, because his heart was turned from the LORD God of Israel, which had appeared unto him twice,

1KI_11:10 And had commanded him concerning this thing, that he should not go after other gods: but he kept not that which the LORD commanded.

1KI_11:11 Wherefore the LORD said unto Solomon, Forasmuch as this is done of thee, and thou hast not kept my covenant and my statutes, which I have commanded thee, I will surely rend the kingdom from thee, and will give it to thy servant.

1KI_11:12 Notwithstanding in thy days I will not do it for David thy father's sake: [but] I will rend it out of the hand of thy son.

1KI_11:13 Howbeit I will not rend away all the kingdom; [but] will give one tribe to thy son for David my servant's sake, and for Jerusalem's sake which I have chosen.

1KI_11:14 And the LORD stirred up an adversary unto Solomon, Hadad the Edomite: he [was] of the king's seed in Edom.

1KI_11:15 For it came to pass, when David was in Edom, and Joab the captain of the host was gone up to bury the slain, after he had smitten every male in Edom;

1KI_11:16 (For six months did Joab remain there with all Israel, until he had cut off every male in Edom:)

1KI_11:17 That Hadad fled, he and certain Edomites of his father's servants with him, to go into Egypt; Hadad [being] yet a little child.

1KI_11:18 And they arose out of Midian, and came to Paran: and they took men with them out of Paran, and they came to Egypt, unto Pharaoh king of Egypt; which gave him an house, and appointed him victuals, and gave him land.

1KI_11:19 And Hadad found great favour in the sight of Pharaoh, so that he gave him to wife the sister of his own wife, the sister of Tahpenes the queen.

1KI_11:20 And the sister of Tahpenes bare him Genubath his son, whom Tahpenes weaned in Pharaoh's house: and Genubath was in Pharaoh's household among the sons of Pharaoh.

1KI_11:21 And when Hadad heard in Egypt that David slept with his fathers, and that Joab the captain of the host was dead, Hadad said to Pharaoh, Let me depart, that I may go to mine own country.

1KI_11:22 Then Pharaoh said unto him, But what hast thou lacked with me, that, behold, thou seekest to go to thine own country? And he answered, Nothing: howbeit let me go in any wise.

1KI_11:23 And God stirred him up [another] adversary, Rezon the son of Eliadah, which fled from his lord Hadadezer king of Zobah:

1KI_11:24 And he gathered men unto him, and became captain over a band, when David slew them [of Zobah]: and they went to Damascus, and dwelt therein, and reigned in Damascus.

1KI_11:25 And he was an adversary to Israel all the days of Solomon, beside the mischief that Hadad [did]: and he abhorred Israel, and reigned over Syria.

1KI_11:26 And Jeroboam the son of Nebat, an Ephrathite of Zereda, Solomon's servant, whose mother's name [was] Zeruah, a widow woman, even he lifted up [his] hand against the king.

1KI_11:27 And this [was] the cause that he lifted up [his] hand against the king: Solomon built Millo, [and] repaired the breaches of the city of David his father.

1KI_11:28 And the man Jeroboam [was] a mighty man of valour: and Solomon seeing the young man that he was industrious, he made him ruler over all the charge of the house of Joseph.

1KI_11:29 And it came to pass at that time when Jeroboam went out of Jerusalem, that the prophet Ahijah the Shilonite found him in the way; and he had clad himself with a new garment; and they two [were] alone in the field:

1KI_11:30 And Ahijah caught the new garment that [was] on him, and rent it [in] twelve pieces:

1KI_11:31 And he said to Jeroboam, Take thee ten pieces: for thus saith the LORD, the God of Israel, Behold, I will rend the kingdom out of the hand of Solomon, and will give ten tribes to thee:

1KI_11:32 (But he shall have one tribe for my servant David's sake, and for Jerusalem's sake, the city which I have chosen out of all the tribes of Israel:)

1KI_11:33 Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do [that which is] right in mine eyes, and [to keep] my statutes and my judgments, as [did] David his father.

1KI_11:34 Howbeit I will not take the whole kingdom out of his hand: but I will make him prince all the days of his life for David my servant's sake, whom I chose, because he kept my commandments and my statutes:

1KI_11:35 But I will take the kingdom out of his son's hand, and will give it unto thee, [even] ten tribes.

1KI_11:36 And unto his son will I give one tribe, that David my servant may have a light always before me in Jerusalem, the city which I have chosen me to put my name there.

1KI_11:37 And I will take thee, and thou shalt reign according to all that thy soul desireth, and shalt be king over Israel.

1KI_11:38 And it shall be, if thou wilt hearken unto all that I command thee, and wilt walk in my ways, and do [that is] right in my sight, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as David my servant did; that I will be with thee, and build thee a sure house, as I built for David, and will give Israel unto thee.

1KI_11:39 And I will for this afflict the seed of David, but not for ever.

1KI_11:40 Solomon sought therefore to kill Jeroboam. And Jeroboam arose, and fled into Egypt, unto Shishak king of Egypt, and was in Egypt until the death of Solomon.

1KI_11:41 And the rest of the acts of Solomon, and all that he did, and his wisdom, [are] they not written in the book of the acts of Solomon?

1KI_11:42 And the time that Solomon reigned in Jerusalem over all Israel [was] forty years.

1KI_11:43 And Solomon slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David his father: and Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.

1KI_12:1 And Rehoboam went to Shechem: for all Israel were come to Shechem to make him king.

1KI_12:2 And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who was yet in Egypt, heard [of it], (for he

was fled from the presence of king Solomon, and Jeroboam dwelt in Egypt;)

1KI_12:3 That they sent and called him. And Jeroboam and all the congregation of Israel came, and spake unto Rehoboam, saying,

1KI_12:4 Thy father made our yoke grievous: now therefore make thou the grievous service of thy father, and his heavy yoke which he put upon us, lighter, and we will serve thee.

JOH_18:11 Then said Jesus unto Peter, Put up thy sword into the sheath: the cup which my Father hath given me, shall I not drink it?

JOH_18:12 Then the band and the captain and officers of the Jews took Jesus, and bound him,

JOH_18:13 And led him away to Annas first; for he was father in law to Caiaphas, which was the high priest that same year.

JOH_18:14 Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die for the people.

JOH_18:15 And Simon Peter followed Jesus, and [so did] another disciple: that disciple was known unto the high priest, and went in with Jesus into the palace of the high priest.

JOH_18:16 But Peter stood at the door without. Then went out that other disciple, which was known unto the high priest, and spake unto her that kept the door, and brought in Peter.

JOH_18:17 Then saith the damsel that kept the door unto Peter, Art not thou also [one] of this man's disciples? He saith, I am not.

JOH_18:18 And the servants and officers stood there, who had made a fire of coals; for it was cold: and they warmed themselves: and Peter stood with them, and warmed himself.

JOH_18:19 The high priest then asked Jesus of his disciples, and of his doctrine.

JOH_18:20 Jesus answered him, I spake openly to the world; I ever taught in the synagogue, and in the temple, whither the Jews always resort; and in secret have I said nothing.

JOH_18:21 Why askest thou me? ask them which heard me, what I have said unto them: behold, they know what I said.

JOH_18:22 And when he had thus spoken, one of the officers which stood by struck Jesus with the palm of his hand, saying, Answerest thou the high priest so?

JOH_18:23 Jesus answered him, If I have spoken evil, bear witness of the evil: but if well, why smitest thou me?

JOH_18:24 Now Annas had sent him bound unto Caiaphas the high priest.

JOH_18:25 And Simon Peter stood and warmed himself. They said therefore unto him, Art not thou also [one] of his disciples? He denied [it], and said, I am not.

JOH_18:26 One of the servants of the high priest, being [his] kinsman whose ear Peter cut off, saith, Did not I see thee in the garden with him?

JOH_18:27 Peter then denied again: and immediately the cock crew.

JOH_18:28 Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be defiled; but that they might eat the passover.

JOH_18:29 Pilate then went out unto them, and said, What accusation bring ye against this man?

JOH_18:30 They answered and said unto him, If he were not a malefactor, we would not have delivered him up unto thee.

JOH_18:31 Then said Pilate unto them, Take ye him, and judge him according to your law. The Jews therefore said unto him, It is not lawful for us to put any man to death:

PSA_71:20 [Thou], which hast showed me great and sore troubles, shalt quicken me again, and shalt bring me up again from the depths of the earth.

PSA_71:21 Thou shalt increase my greatness, and comfort me on every side.

PSA_71:22 I will also praise thee with the psaltery, [even] thy truth, O my God: unto thee will I sing with the harp, O thou Holy One of Israel.

PSA_71:23 My lips shall greatly rejoice when I sing unto thee; and my soul, which thou hast redeemed.

PSA_71:24 My tongue also shall talk of thy righteousness all the day long: for they are confounded, for they are brought unto shame, that seek my hurt.

PSA_72:1 [A Psalm] for Solomon. Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son.

PRO_15:24 The way of life [is] above to the wise, that he may depart from hell beneath.

PRO_15:25 The LORD will destroy the house of the proud: but he will establish the border of the widow.

PRO_15:26 The thoughts of the wicked [are] an abomination to the LORD: but [the words] of the pure [are] pleasant words.

MARJ_14:48 Are ye come out, as against a thief, with swords and [with] staves to take me?

MARJ_14:49 I was daily with you in the temple teaching, and ye took me not: but the scriptures must be fulfilled.

MARJ_14:62 I am: and ye shall see the Son of man sitting on the right hand of power, and coming in the clouds of heaven.

MARJ_15:2 Thou sayest [it].

MARJ_15:34 Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?

MARJ_16:15 Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

MARJ_16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

MARJ_16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;
