Daily Devotional 1 Year Bible

JER_7:13 And now, because ye have done all these works, saith the LORD, and I spake unto you, rising up early and speaking, but ye heard not; and I called you, but ye answered not;

JER_7:14 Therefore will I do unto [this] house, which is called by my name, wherein ye trust, and unto the place which I gave to you and to your fathers, as I have done to Shiloh.

JER_7:15 And I will cast you out of my sight, as I have cast out all your brethren, [even] the whole seed of Ephraim.

JER_7:16 Therefore pray not thou for this people, neither lift up cry nor prayer for them, neither make intercession to me: for I will not hear thee.

JER_7:17 Seest thou not what they do in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem?

JER_7:18 The children gather wood, and the fathers kindle the fire, and the women knead [their] dough, to make cakes to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto other gods, that they may provoke me to anger.

JER_7:19 Do they provoke me to anger? saith the LORD: [do they] not [provoke] themselves to the confusion of their own faces?

JER_7:20 Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, mine anger and my fury shall be poured out upon this place, upon man, and upon beast, and upon the trees of the field, and upon the fruit of the ground; and it shall burn, and shall not be quenched.

JER_7:21 Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Put your burnt offerings unto your sacrifices, and eat flesh.

JER_7:22 For I spake not unto your fathers, nor commanded them in the day that I brought them out of the land of Egypt, concerning burnt offerings or sacrifices:

JER_7:23 But this thing commanded I them, saying, Obey my voice, and I will be your God, and ye shall be my people: and walk ye in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well unto you.

JER_7:24 But they hearkened not, nor inclined their ear, but walked in the counsels [and] in the imagination of their evil heart, and went backward, and not forward.

JER_7:25 Since the day that your fathers came forth out of the land of Egypt unto this day I have even sent unto you all my servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending [them]:

JER_7:26 Yet they hearkened not unto me, nor inclined their ear, but hardened their neck: they did worse

than their fathers.

JER_7:27 Therefore thou shalt speak all these words unto them; but they will not hearken to thee: thou shalt also call unto them; but they will not answer thee.

JER_7:28 But thou shalt say unto them, This [is] a nation that obeyeth not the voice of the LORD their God, nor receiveth correction: truth is perished, and is cut off from their mouth.

JER_7:29 Cut off thine hair, [O Jerusalem], and cast [it] away, and take up a lamentation on high places; for the LORD hath rejected and forsaken the generation of his wrath.

JER_7:30 For the children of Judah have done evil in my sight, saith the LORD: they have set their abominations in the house which is called by my name, to pollute it.

JER_7:31 And they have built the high places of Tophet, which [is] in the valley of the son of Hinnom, to burn their sons and their daughters in the fire; which I commanded [them] not, neither came it into my heart.

JER_7:32 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that it shall no more be called Tophet, nor the valley of the son of Hinnom, but the valley of slaughter: for they shall bury in Tophet, till there be no place.

JER_7:33 And the carcases of this people shall be meat for the fowls of the heaven, and for the beasts of the earth; and none shall fray [them] away.

JER_7:34 Then will I cause to cease from the cities of Judah, and from the streets of Jerusalem, the voice of mirth, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride: for the land shall be desolate.

JER_8:1 At that time, saith the LORD, they shall bring out the bones of the kings of Judah, and the bones of his princes, and the bones of the priests, and the bones of the prophets, and the bones of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, out of their graves:

JER_8:2 And they shall spread them before the sun, and the moon, and all the host of heaven, whom they have loved, and whom they have served, and after whom they have walked, and whom they have sought, and whom they have worshipped: they shall not be gathered, nor be buried; they shall be for dung upon the face of the earth.

JER_8:3 And death shall be chosen rather than life by all the residue of them that remain of this evil family, which remain in all the places whither I have driven them, saith the LORD of hosts.

JER_8:4 Moreover thou shalt say unto them, Thus saith the LORD; Shall they fall, and not arise? shall he turn away, and not return?

JER_8:5 Why [then] is this people of Jerusalem slidden back by a perpetual backsliding? they hold fast deceit, they refuse to return.

JER_8:6 I hearkened and heard, [but] they spake not aright: no man repented him of his wickedness, saying, What have I done? every one turned to his course, as the horse rusheth into the battle.

JER_8:7 Yea, the stork in the heaven knoweth her appointed times; and the turtle and the crane and the swallow observe the time of their coming; but my people know not the judgment of the LORD.

JER_8:8 How do ye say, We [are] wise, and the law of the LORD [is] with us? Lo, certainly in vain made he [it]; the pen of the scribes [is] in vain.

JER_8:9 The wise [men] are ashamed, they are dismayed and taken: lo, they have rejected the word of the LORD; and what wisdom [is] in them?

JER_8:10 Therefore will I give their wives unto others, [and] their fields to them that shall inherit [them]: for every one from the least even unto the greatest is given to covetousness, from the prophet even unto the priest every one dealeth falsely.

JER_8:11 For they have healed the hurt of the daughter of my people slightly, saying, Peace, peace; when [there is] no peace.

JER_8:12 Were they ashamed when they had committed abomination? nay, they were not at all ashamed, neither could they blush: therefore shall they fall among them that fall: in the time of their visitation they shall be cast down, saith the LORD.

JER_8:13 I will surely consume them, saith the LORD: [there shall be] no grapes on the vine, nor figs on the fig tree, and the leaf shall fade; and [the things that] I have given them shall pass away from them.

JER_8:14 Why do we sit still? assemble yourselves, and let us enter into the defenced cities, and let us be silent there: for the LORD our God hath put us to silence, and given us water of gall to drink, because we have sinned against the LORD.

JER_8:15 We looked for peace, but no good [came; and] for a time of health, and behold trouble!

JER_8:16 The snorting of his horses was heard from Dan: the whole land trembled at the sound of the neighing of his strong ones; for they are come, and have devoured the land, and all that is in it; the city, and those that dwell therein.

JER_8:17 For, behold, I will send serpents, cockatrices, among you, which [will] not [be] charmed, and they shall bite you, saith the LORD.

JER_8:18 [When] I would comfort myself against sorrow, my heart [is] faint in me.

JER_8:19 Behold the voice of the cry of the daughter of my people because of them that dwell in a far country: [Is] not the LORD in Zion? [is] not her king in her? Why have they provoked me to anger with their graven images, [and] with strange vanities?

JER_8:20 The harvest is past, the summer is ended, and we are not saved.

JER_8:21 For the hurt of the daughter of my people am I hurt; I am black; astonishment hath taken hold on me.

JER_8:22 [Is there] no balm in Gilead; [is there] no physician there? why then is not the health of the daughter of my people recovered?

JER_9:1 Oh that my head were waters, and mine eyes a fountain of tears, that I might weep day and night for the slain of the daughter of my people!

JER_9:2 Oh that I had in the wilderness a lodging place of wayfaring men; that I might leave my people, and go from them! for they [be] all adulterers, an assembly of treacherous men.

JER_9:3 And they bend their tongues [like] their bow [for] lies: but they are not valiant for the truth upon the earth; for they proceed from evil to evil, and they know not me, saith the LORD.

JER_9:4 Take ye heed every one of his neighbour, and trust ye not in any brother: for every brother will utterly supplant, and every neighbour will walk with slanders.

EPH_2:9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

EPH_2:10 For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them.

EPH_2:11 Wherefore remember, that ye [being] in time past Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands;

EPH_2:12 That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:

EPH_2:13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

EPH_2:14 For he is our peace, who hath made both one, and hath broken down the middle wall of partition [between us];

EPH_2:15 Having abolished in his flesh the enmity, [even] the law of commandments [contained] in ordinances; for to make in himself of twain one new man, [so] making peace;

EPH_2:16 And that he might reconcile both unto God in one body by the cross, having slain the enmity thereby:

EPH_2:17 And came and preached peace to you which were afar off, and to them that were nigh.

EPH_2:18 For through him we both have access by one Spirit unto the Father.

EPH_2:19 Now therefore ye are no more strangers and foreigners, but fellowcitizens with the saints, and of the household of God;

EPH_2:20 And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner [stone];

EPH_2:21 In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord:

EPH_2:22 In whom ye also are builded together for an habitation of God through the Spirit.

EPH_3:1 For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles,

EPH_3:2 If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward:

EPH_3:3 How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

EPH_3:4 Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ)

EPH_3:5 Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;

EPH_3:6 That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel:

EPH_3:7 Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power.

EPH_3:8 Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among

the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

EPH_3:9 And to make all [men] see what [is] the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

EPH_3:10 To the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly [places] might be known by the church the manifold wisdom of God,

EPH_3:11 According to the eternal purpose which he purposed in Christ Jesus our Lord:

PSA_113:2 Blessed be the name of the LORD from this time forth and for evermore.

PSA_113:3 From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same the LORD's name [is] to be praised.

PSA_113:4 The LORD [is] high above all nations, [and] his glory above the heavens.

PSA_113:5 Who [is] like unto the LORD our God, who dwelleth on high,

PSA_113:6 Who humbleth [himself] to behold [the things that are] in heaven, and in the earth!

PSA_113:7 He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, [and] lifteth the needy out of the dunghill;

PSA_113:8 That he may set [him] with princes, [even] with the princes of his people.

PSA_113:9 He maketh the barren woman to keep house, [and to be] a joyful mother of children. Praise ye the LORD.

PRO_25:4 Take away the dross from the silver, and there shall come forth a vessel for the finer.

PRO_25:5 Take away the wicked [from] before the king, and his throne shall be established in righteousness.

JOHJ_4:36 And he that reapeth receiveth wages, and gathereth fruit unto life eternal: that both he that soweth and he that reapeth may rejoice together.

JOHJ_4:37 And herein is that saying true, One soweth, and another reapeth.

JOHJ_4:38 I sent you to reap that whereon ye bestowed no labour: other men laboured, and ye are entered into their labours.

JOHJ_4:48 Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe.

JOHJ_4:50 Go thy way; thy son liveth.

JOHJ_5:6 Wilt thou be made whole?

JOHJ_5:8 Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.

JOHJ_5:14 Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee.
