## Daily Devotional 1 Year Bible

**JER\_15:13** Thy substance and thy treasures will I give to the spoil without price, and [that] for all thy sins, even in all thy borders.

**JER\_15:14** And I will make [thee] to pass with thine enemies into a land [which] thou knowest not: for a fire is kindled in mine anger, [which] shall burn upon you.

**JER\_15:15** O LORD, thou knowest: remember me, and visit me, and revenge me of my persecutors; take me not away in thy longsuffering: know that for thy sake I have suffered rebuke.

**JER\_15:16** Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts.

**JER\_15:17** I sat not in the assembly of the mockers, nor rejoiced; I sat alone because of thy hand: for thou hast filled me with indignation.

**JER\_15:18** Why is my pain perpetual, and my wound incurable, [which] refuseth to be healed? wilt thou be altogether unto me as a liar, [and as] waters [that] fail?

**JER\_15:19** Therefore thus saith the LORD, If thou return, then will I bring thee again, [and] thou shalt stand before me: and if thou take forth the precious from the vile, thou shalt be as my mouth: let them return unto thee; but return not thou unto them.

**JER\_15:20** And I will make thee unto this people a fenced brazen wall: and they shall fight against thee, but they shall not prevail against thee: for I [am] with thee to save thee and to deliver thee, saith the LORD.

**JER\_15:21** And I will deliver thee out of the hand of the wicked, and I will redeem thee out of the hand of the terrible.

**JER\_16:1** The word of the LORD came also unto me, saying,

**JER\_16:2** Thou shalt not take thee a wife, neither shalt thou have sons or daughters in this place.

**JER\_16:3** For thus saith the LORD concerning the sons and concerning the daughters that are born in this place, and concerning their mothers that bare them, and concerning their fathers that begat them in this land;

**JER\_16:4** They shall die of grievous deaths; they shall not be lamented; neither shall they be buried; [but] they shall be as dung upon the face of the earth: and they shall be consumed by the sword, and by famine; and their carcasses shall be meat for the fowls of heaven, and for the beasts of the earth.

**JER\_16:5 For thus saith the LORD, Enter not into the house of mourning, neither go to lament nor bemoan them: for I have taken away my peace from this people, saith the LORD, [even] lovingkindness and mercies.**

**JER\_16:6 Both the great and the small shall die in this land: they shall not be buried, neither shall [men] lament for them, nor cut themselves, nor make themselves bald for them:**

**JER\_16:7 Neither shall [men] tear [themselves] for them in mourning, to comfort them for the dead; neither shall [men] give them the cup of consolation to drink for their father or for their mother.**

**JER\_16:8 Thou shalt not also go into the house of feasting, to sit with them to eat and to drink.**

**JER\_16:9 For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will cause to cease out of this place in your eyes, and in your days, the voice of mirth, and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom, and the voice of the bride.**

**JER\_16:10 And it shall come to pass, when thou shalt show this people all these words, and they shall say unto thee, Wherefore hath the LORD pronounced all this great evil against us? or what [is] our iniquity? or what [is] our sin that we have committed against the LORD our God?**

**JER\_16:11 Then shalt thou say unto them, Because your fathers have forsaken me, saith the LORD, and have walked after other gods, and have served them, and have worshipped them, and have forsaken me, and have not kept my law;**

**JER\_16:12 And ye have done worse than your fathers; for, behold, ye walk every one after the imagination of his evil heart, that they may not hearken unto me:**

**JER\_16:13 Therefore will I cast you out of this land into a land that ye know not, [neither] ye nor your fathers; and there shall ye serve other gods day and night; where I will not show you favour.**

**JER\_16:14 Therefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that it shall no more be said, The LORD liveth, that brought up the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt;**

**JER\_16:15 But, The LORD liveth, that brought up the children of Israel from the land of the north, and from all the lands whither he had driven them: and I will bring them again into their land that I gave unto their fathers.**

**JER\_16:16 Behold, I will send for many fishers, saith the LORD, and they shall fish them; and after will I send for many hunters, and they shall hunt them from every mountain, and from every hill, and out of the holes of the rocks.**

**JER\_16:17 For mine eyes [are] upon all their ways: they are not hid from my face, neither is their iniquity hid from mine eyes.**

**JER\_16:18 And first I will recompense their iniquity and their sin double; because they have defiled my land, they have filled mine inheritance with the carcasses of their detestable and abominable things.**

**JER\_16:19 O LORD, my strength, and my fortress, and my refuge in the day of affliction, the Gentiles shall come unto thee from the ends of the earth, and shall say, Surely our fathers have inherited lies, vanity, and [things] wherein [there is] no profit.**

**JER\_16:20 Shall a man make gods unto himself, and they [are] no gods?**

**JER\_16:21 Therefore, behold, I will this once cause them to know, I will cause them to know mine hand and my might; and they shall know that my name [is] The LORD.**

**JER\_17:1** The sin of Judah [is] written with a pen of iron, [and] with the point of a diamond: [it is] graven upon the table of their heart, and upon the horns of your altars;

**JER\_17:2** Whilst their children remember their altars and their groves by the green trees upon the high hills.

**JER\_17:3** O my mountain in the field, I will give thy substance [and] all thy treasures to the spoil, [and] thy high places for sin, throughout all thy borders.

**JER\_17:4** And thou, even thyself, shalt discontinue from thine heritage that I gave thee; and I will cause thee to serve thine enemies in the land which thou knowest not: for ye have kindled a fire in mine anger, [which] shall burn for ever.

**JER\_17:5** Thus saith the LORD; Cursed [be] the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the LORD.

**JER\_17:6** For he shall be like the heath in the desert, and shall not see when good cometh; but shall inhabit the parched places in the wilderness, [in] a salt land and not inhabited.

**JER\_17:7** Blessed [is] the man that trusteth in the LORD, and whose hope the LORD is.

**JER\_17:8** For he shall be as a tree planted by the waters, and [that] spreadeth out her roots by the river, and shall not see when heat cometh, but her leaf shall be green; and shall not be careful in the year of drought, neither shall cease from yielding fruit.

**JER\_17:9** The heart [is] deceitful above all [things], and desperately wicked: who can know it?

**JER\_17:10** I the LORD search the heart, [I] try the reins, even to give every man according to his ways, [and] according to the fruit of his doings.

**JER\_17:11** [As] the partridge sitteth [on eggs], and hatcheth [them] not; [so] he that getteth riches, and not by right, shall leave them in the midst of his days, and at his end shall be a fool.

**JER\_17:12** A glorious high throne from the beginning [is] the place of our sanctuary.

**JER\_17:13** O LORD, the hope of Israel, all that forsake thee shall be ashamed, [and] they that depart from me shall be written in the earth, because they have forsaken the LORD, the fountain of living waters.

**JER\_17:14** Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou [art] my praise.

**JER\_17:15** Behold, they say unto me, Where [is] the word of the LORD? let it come now.

**JER\_17:16** As for me, I have not hastened from [being] a pastor to follow thee: neither have I desired the woeful day; thou knowest: that which came out of my lips was [right] before thee.

**JER\_17:17** Be not a terror unto me: thou [art] my hope in the day of evil.

**JER\_17:18** Let them be confounded that persecute me, but let not me be confounded: let them be dismayed, but let not me be dismayed: bring upon them the day of evil, and destroy them with double destruction.

**JER\_17:19** Thus said the LORD unto me; Go and stand in the gate of the children of the people, whereby the kings of Judah come in, and by the which they go out, and in all the gates of Jerusalem;

**EPH\_6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.**

**EPH\_6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places].**

**EPH\_6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.**

**EPH\_6:14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;**

**EPH\_6:15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;**

**EPH\_6:16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.**

**EPH\_6:17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:**

**EPH\_6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;**

**EPH\_6:19 And for me, that utterance may be given unto me, that I may open my mouth boldly, to make known the mystery of the gospel,**

**EPH\_6:20 For which I am an ambassador in bonds: that therein I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.**

**EPH\_6:21 But that ye also may know my affairs, [and] how I do, Tychicus, a beloved brother and faithful minister in the Lord, shall make known to you all things:**

**EPH\_6:22 Whom I have sent unto you for the same purpose, that ye might know our affairs, and [that] he might comfort your hearts.**

**EPH\_6:23 Peace [be] to the brethren, and love with faith, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.**

**EPH\_6:24 Grace [be] with all them that love our Lord Jesus Christ in sincerity. Amen.**

**PHP\_1:1 Paul and Timotheus, the servants of Jesus Christ, to all the saints in Christ Jesus which are at Philippi, with the bishops and deacons:**

**PHP\_1:2 Grace [be] unto you, and peace, from God our Father, and [from] the Lord Jesus Christ.**

**PHP\_1:3 I thank my God upon every remembrance of you,**

**PHP\_1:4 Always in every prayer of mine for you all making request with joy,**

**PHP\_1:5 For your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now;**

**PHP\_1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform [it] until the day of Jesus Christ:**

**PHP\_1:7 Even as it is meet for me to think this of you all, because I have you in my heart; inasmuch as both in my bonds, and in the defence and confirmation of the gospel, ye all are partakers of my grace.**

**PHP\_1:8 For God is my record, how greatly I long after you all in the bowels of Jesus Christ.**

**PHP\_1:9** And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and [in] all judgment;

**PHP\_1:10** That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;

**PHP\_1:11** Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.

**PHP\_1:12** But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the things [which happened] unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel;

**PSA\_115:17** The dead praise not the LORD, neither any that go down into silence.

**PSA\_115:18** But we will bless the LORD from this time forth and for evermore. Praise the LORD.

**PSA\_116:1** I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice [and] my supplications.

**PSA\_116:2** Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon [him] as long as I live.

**PSA\_116:3** The sorrows of death compassed me, and the pains of hell gat hold upon me: I found trouble and sorrow.

**PSA\_116:4** Then called I upon the name of the LORD; O LORD, I beseech thee, deliver my soul.

**PSA\_116:5** Gracious [is] the LORD, and righteous; yea, our God [is] merciful.

**PRO\_25:13** As the cold of snow in the time of harvest, [so is] a faithful messenger to them that send him: for he refresheth the soul of his masters.

**PRO\_25:14** Whoso boasteth himself of a false gift [is like] clouds and wind without rain.

**JOHJ\_5:32** There is another that beareth witness of me; and I know that the witness which he witnesseth of me is true.

**JOHJ\_5:33** Ye sent unto John, and he bare witness unto the truth.

**JOHJ\_5:34** But I receive not testimony from man: but these things I say, that ye might be saved.

**JOHJ\_5:35** He was a burning and a shining light: and ye were willing for a season to rejoice in his light.

**JOHJ\_5:36** But I have greater witness than [that] of John: for the works which the Father hath given me to finish, the same works that I do, bear witness of me, that the Father hath sent me.

**JOHJ\_5:37** And the Father himself, which hath sent me, hath borne witness of me. Ye have neither heard his voice at any time, nor seen his shape.
