## Daily Devotional 1 Year Bible

**JER\_49:37** For I will cause Elam to be dismayed before their enemies, and before them that seek their life: and I will bring evil upon them, [even] my fierce anger, saith the LORD; and I will send the sword after them, till I have consumed them:

**JER\_49:38** And I will set my throne in Elam, and will destroy from thence the king and the princes, saith the LORD.

**JER\_49:39** But it shall come to pass in the latter days, [that] I will bring again the captivity of Elam, saith the LORD.

**JER\_50:1** The word that the LORD spake against Babylon [and] against the land of the Chaldeans by Jeremiah the prophet.

**JER\_50:2** Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, [and] conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.

**JER\_50:3** For out of the north there cometh up a nation against her, which shall make her land desolate, and none shall dwell therein: they shall remove, they shall depart, both man and beast.

**JER\_50:4** In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together, going and weeping: they shall go, and seek the LORD their God.

**JER\_50:5** They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, [saying], Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual covenant [that] shall not be forgotten.

**JER\_50:6** My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away [on] the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their restingplace.

**JER\_50:7** All that found them have devoured them: and their adversaries said, We offend not, because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of justice, even the LORD, the hope of their fathers.

**JER\_50:8** Remove out of the midst of Babylon, and go forth out of the land of the Chaldeans, and be as the he goats before the flocks.

**JER\_50:9** For, lo, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country: and they shall set themselves in array against her; from thence she shall be taken: their arrows [shall be] as of a mighty expert man; none shall return in vain.

**JER\_50:10** And Chaldea shall be a spoil: all that spoil her shall be satisfied, saith the LORD.

**JER\_50:11** Because ye were glad, because ye rejoiced, O ye destroyers of mine heritage, because ye are grown fat as the heifer at grass, and bellow as bulls;

**JER\_50:12** Your mother shall be sore confounded; she that bare you shall be ashamed: behold, the hindermost of the nations [shall be] a wilderness, a dry land, and a desert.

**JER\_50:13** Because of the wrath of the LORD it shall not be inhabited, but it shall be wholly desolate: every one that goeth by Babylon shall be astonished, and hiss at all her plagues.

**JER\_50:14** Put yourselves in array against Babylon round about: all ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no arrows: for she hath sinned against the LORD.

**JER\_50:15** Shout against her round about: she hath given her hand: her foundations are fallen, her walls are thrown down: for it [is] the vengeance of the LORD: take vengeance upon her; as she hath done, do unto her.

**JER\_50:16** Cut off the sower from Babylon, and him that handleth the sickle in the time of harvest: for fear of the oppressing sword they shall turn every one to his people, and they shall flee every one to his own land.

**JER\_50:17** Israel [is] a scattered sheep; the lions have driven [him] away: first the king of Assyria hath devoured him; and last this Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon hath broken his bones.

**JER\_50:18** Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria.

**JER\_50:19** And I will bring Israel again to his habitation, and he shall feed on Carmel and Bashan, and his soul shall be satisfied upon mount Ephraim and Gilead.

**JER\_50:20** In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and [there shall be] none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found: for I will pardon them whom I reserve.

**JER\_50:21** Go up against the land of Merathaim, [even] against it, and against the inhabitants of Pekod: waste and utterly destroy after them, saith the LORD, and do according to all that I have commanded thee.

**JER\_50:22** A sound of battle [is] in the land, and of great destruction.

**JER\_50:23** How is the hammer of the whole earth cut asunder and broken! how is Babylon become a desolation among the nations!

**JER\_50:24** I have laid a snare for thee, and thou art also taken, O Babylon, and thou wast not aware: thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the LORD.

**JER\_50:25** The LORD hath opened his armoury, and hath brought forth the weapons of his indignation: for this [is] the work of the Lord GOD of hosts in the land of the Chaldeans.

**JER\_50:26** Come against her from the utmost border, open her storehouses: cast her up as heaps, and destroy her utterly: let nothing of her be left.

**JER\_50:27** Slay all her bullocks; let them go down to the slaughter: woe unto them! for their day is come, the time of their visitation.

**JER\_50:28** The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of Babylon, to declare in Zion the vengeance of the LORD our God, the vengeance of his temple.

**JER\_50:29** Call together the archers against Babylon: all ye that bend the bow, camp against it round about; let none thereof escape: recompense her according to her work; according to all that she hath done, do unto her: for she hath been proud against the LORD, against the Holy One of Israel.

**JER\_50:30** Therefore shall her young men fall in the streets, and all her men of war shall be cut off in that day, saith the LORD.

**JER\_50:31** Behold, I [am] against thee, [O thou] most proud, saith the Lord GOD of hosts: for thy day is come, the time [that] I will visit thee.

**JER\_50:32** And the most proud shall stumble and fall, and none shall raise him up: and I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him.

**JER\_50:33** Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah [were] oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go.

**JER\_50:34** Their Redeemer [is] strong; the LORD of hosts [is] his name: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.

**JER\_50:35** A sword [is] upon the Chaldeans, saith the LORD, and upon the inhabitants of Babylon, and upon her princes, and upon her wise [men].

**JER\_50:36** A sword [is] upon the liars; and they shall dote: a sword [is] upon her mighty men; and they shall be dismayed.

**JER\_50:37** A sword [is] upon their horses, and upon their chariots, and upon all the mingled people that [are] in the midst of her; and they shall become as women: a sword [is] upon her treasures; and they shall be robbed.

**JER\_50:38** A drought [is] upon her waters; and they shall be dried up: for it [is] the land of graven images, and they are mad upon [their] idols.

**JER\_50:39** Therefore the wild beasts of the desert with the wild beasts of the islands shall dwell [there], and the owls shall dwell therein: and it shall be no more inhabited for ever; neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation.

**JER\_50:40** As God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah and the neighbour [cities] thereof, saith the LORD; [so] shall no man abide there, neither shall any son of man dwell therein.

**JER\_50:41** Behold, a people shall come from the north, and a great nation, and many kings shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.

**JER\_50:42** They shall hold the bow and the lance: they [are] cruel, and will not show mercy: their voice shall roar like the sea, and they shall ride upon horses, [every one] put in array, like a man to the battle, against thee, O daughter of Babylon.

**JER\_50:43** The king of Babylon hath heard the report of them, and his hands waxed feeble: anguish took hold of him, [and] pangs as of a woman in travail.

**JER\_50:44** Behold, he shall come up like a lion from the swelling of Jordan unto the habitation of the strong: but I will make them suddenly run away from her: and who [is] a chosen [man, that] I may appoint over her? for who [is] like me? and who will appoint me the time? and who [is] that shepherd that will

stand before me?

**1TI\_6:11 But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness.**

**1TI\_6:12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses.**

**1TI\_6:13 I give thee charge in the sight of God, who quickeneth all things, and [before] Christ Jesus, who before Pontius Pilate witnessed a good confession;**

**1TI\_6:14 That thou keep [this] commandment without spot, unrebukeable, until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ:**

**1TI\_6:15 Which in his times he shall shew, [who is] the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords;**

**1TI\_6:16 Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom [be] honour and power everlasting. Amen.**

**1TI\_6:17 Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy;**

**1TI\_6:18 That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;**

**1TI\_6:19 Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.**

**1TI\_6:20 O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane [and] vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:**

**1TI\_6:21 Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace [be] with thee. Amen.**

**2TI\_1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, according to the promise of life which is in Christ Jesus,**

**2TI\_1:2 To Timothy, [my] dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, [and] peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.**

**2TI\_1:3 I thank God, whom I serve from [my] forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I have remembrance of thee in my prayers night and day;**

**2TI\_1:4 Greatly desiring to see thee, being mindful of thy tears, that I may be filled with joy;**

**2TI\_1:5 When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.**

**2TI\_1:6 Wherefore I put thee in remembrance that thou stir up the gift of God, which is in thee by the putting on of my hands.**

**2TI\_1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.**

**2TI\_1:8 Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;**

**2TI\_1:9** Who hath saved us, and called [us] with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

**2TI\_1:10** But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel:

**2TI\_1:11** Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles.

**PSA\_119:89** LAMED. For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.

**PSA\_119:90** Thy faithfulness [is] unto all generations: thou hast established the earth, and it abideth.

**PSA\_119:91** They continue this day according to thine ordinances: for all [are] thy servants.

**PSA\_119:92** Unless thy law [had been] my delights, I should then have perished in mine affliction.

**PSA\_119:93** I will never forget thy precepts: for with them thou hast quickened me.

**PSA\_119:94** I [am] thine, save me; for I have sought thy precepts.

**PSA\_119:95** The wicked have waited for me to destroy me: [but] I will consider thy testimonies.

**PSA\_119:96** I have seen an end of all perfection: [but] thy commandment [is] exceeding broad.

**PRO\_26:28** A lying tongue hateth [those that are] afflicted by it; and a flattering mouth worketh ruin.

**PRO\_27:1** Boast not thyself of to morrow; for thou knowest not what a day may bring forth.

**PRO\_27:2** Let another man praise thee, and not thine own mouth; a stranger, and not thine own lips.

**JOHJ\_9:7** Go, wash in the pool of Siloam,

**JOHJ\_9:35** Dost thou believe on the Son of God?

**JOHJ\_9:37** Thou hast both seen him, and it is he that talketh with thee.

**JOHJ\_9:39** For judgment I am come into this world, that they which see not might see; and that they which see might be made blind.

**JOHJ\_9:41** If ye were blind, ye should have no sin: but now ye say, We see; therefore your sin remaineth.

**JOHJ\_10:1** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that entereth not by the door into the sheepfold, but climbeth up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber.

**JOHJ\_10:2** But he that entereth in by the door is the shepherd of the sheep.
